




# Wind Advisory 6 AM to 4 PM today

#### What Has Changed?

Wind Advisory expanded to include northern Fulton County in New York and eastern Windham County in Vermont














### **Main Points**


Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Wind	Downed trees and tree limbs, possibly resulting in isolated to scattered power outages	Mohawk Valley, Capital District, the Schoharie Valley, eastern Catskills, Helderbergs, Mid- Hudson Valley, Taconics, southern Vermont, Litchfield Hills and Berkshires	6 AM to 4 PM Today











#### Impacts and Timing:

✓ Wind gusts 45-55 mph Today could result in downed trees, tree limbs and isolated to scattered power outages









# **Strong Winds Event Summary**

- ✓ Winds are expected to gust 45-55 mph Today in the Mohawk Valley, Capital District, Schoharie Valley, eastern Catskills, Helderbergs, Mid-Hudson Valley, Taconics, southern Vermont, Litchfield Hills and Berkshires. A Wind Advisory has been issued for these areas.
- Period of greatest impact: **Tuesday 6 AM to 4 PM**. Downed trees and tree limbs, possibly resulting in isolated to scattered power outages.
- Confidence is **HIGH** that winds gusting above 45 mph will occur.
