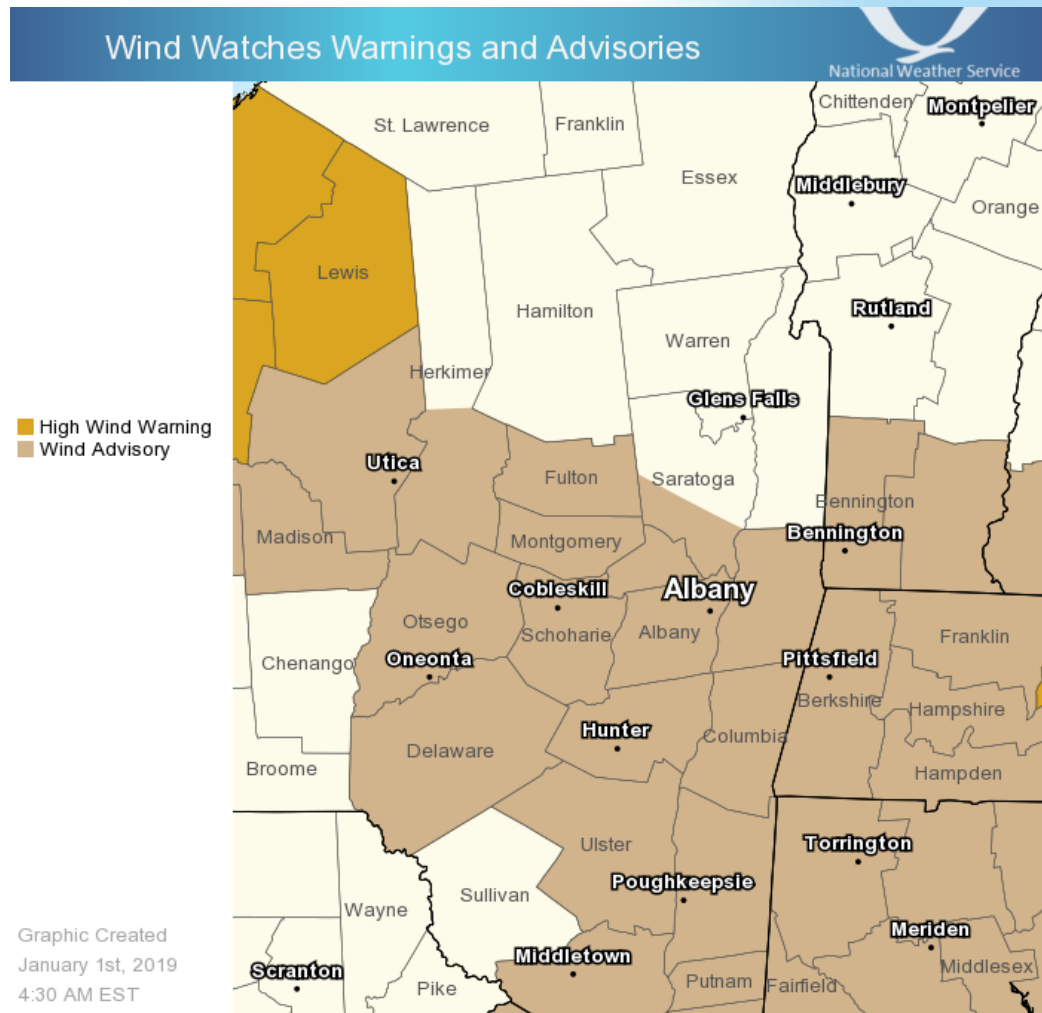

- ✓ *Wind Advisory expanded to include northern Fulton County in New York and eastern Windham County in Vermont*



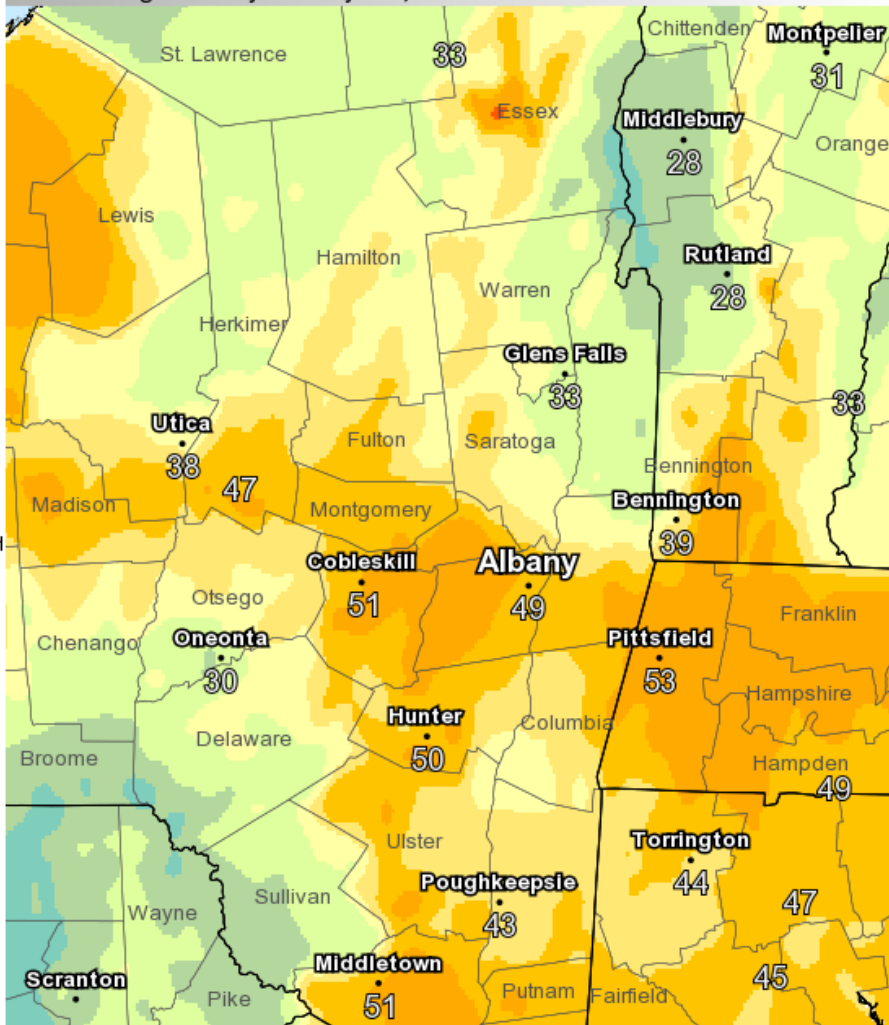

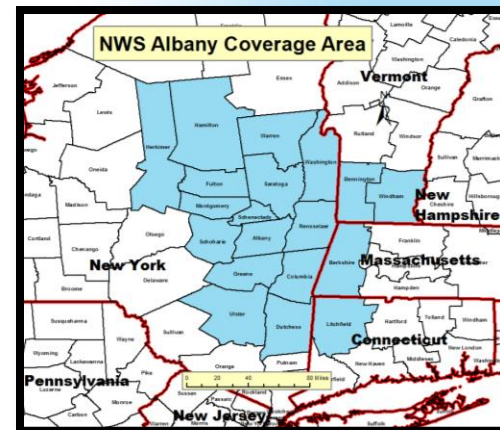
Strong Winds Event Summary

- ✓ Winds are expected to gust 45-55 mph Today in the Mohawk Valley, Capital District, Schoharie Valley, eastern Catskills, Helderbergs, Mid-Hudson Valley, Taconics, southern Vermont, Litchfield Hills and Berkshires. A Wind Advisory has been issued for these areas.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: **Tuesday 6 AM to 4 PM**. Downed trees and tree limbs, possibly resulting in isolated to scattered power outages.
- ✓ Confidence is **HIGH** that winds gusting above 45 mph will occur.
