



What Has Changed?

Winter Weather Advisory issued for western Greene and western Ulster Counties in eastern New York and Berkshire County in Massachusetts from 3 AM until noon Saturday










Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast

Event Summary

Patchy Light Freezing Rain Expected Late Tonight Through Saturday Morning...

- Confidence is HIGH that this event will occur and MODERATE on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: 3 AM until noon Saturday



- ✓ A trace to a few hundredths of an inch of ice is possible in western Greene and western Ulster Counties in eastern New York and Berkshire County in Massachusetts
- ✓ Ice accretion may lead to hazardous travel conditions late tonight through Saturday morning
