

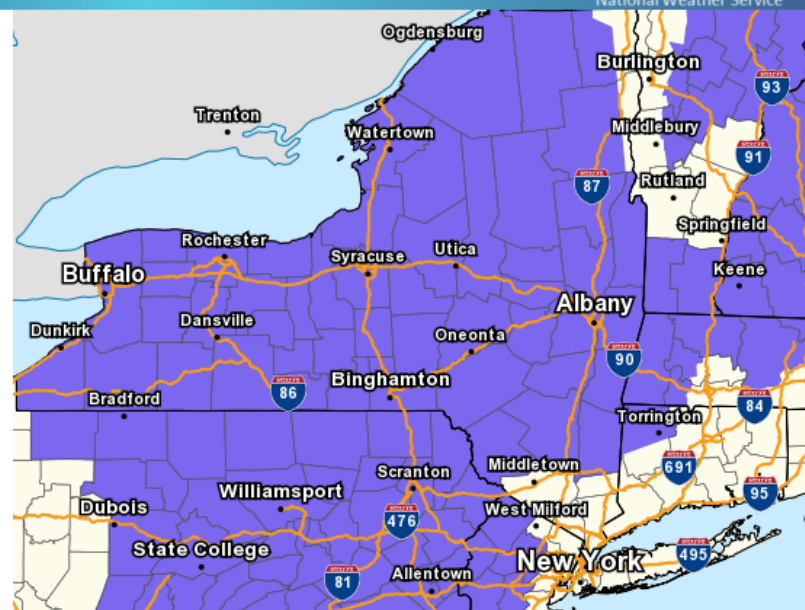

- ✓ Winter Weather Advisory expanded to include all of eastern New York and western New England.

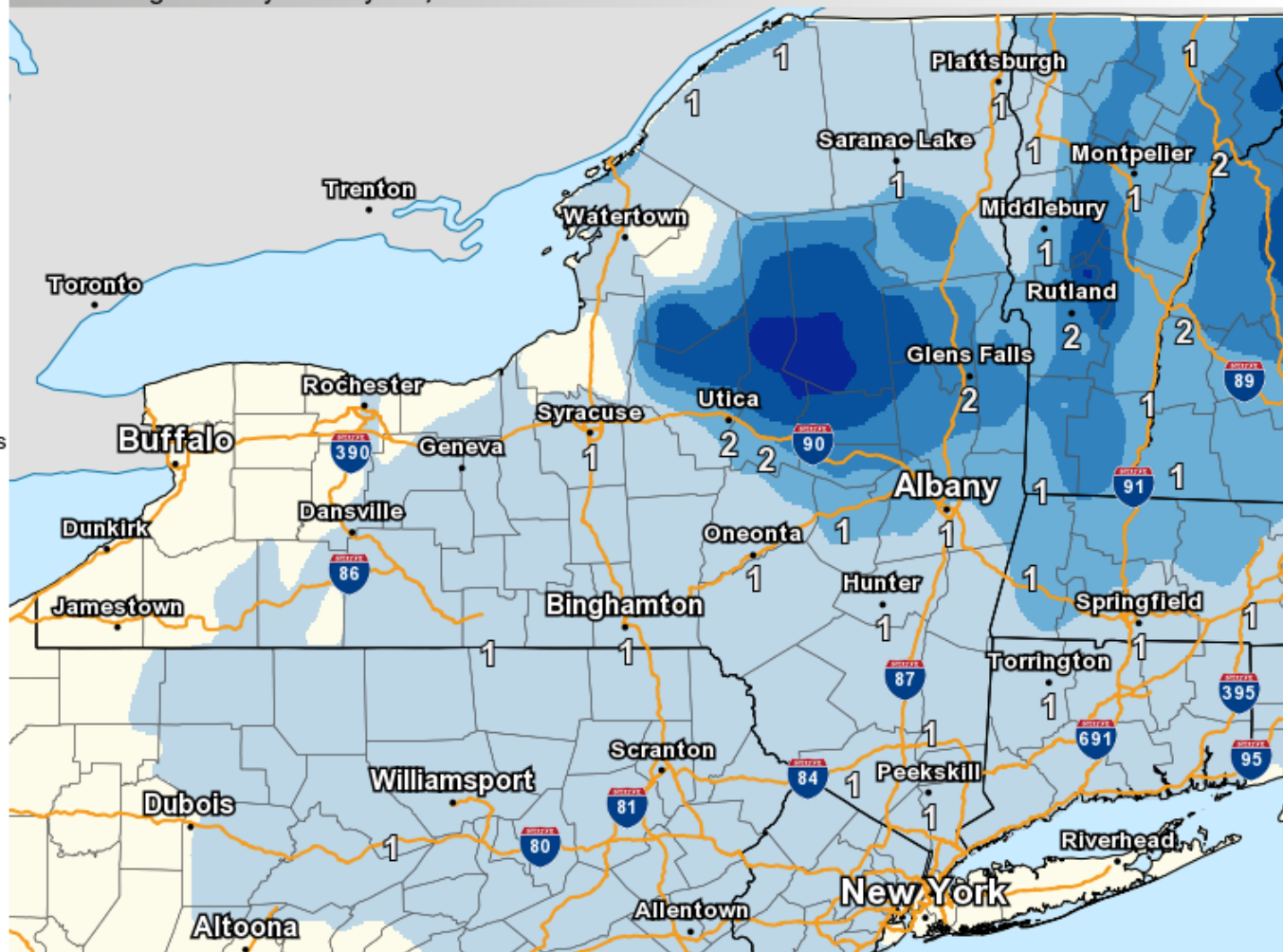

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
<b>Snow</b> 	Slippery road conditions due to snow accumulations ranging from 3 to 6 inches.	Northern Herkimer, Northern Fulton, Hamilton and western portion of Warren County	Tonight into Tuesday Morning
<b>Snow</b> 	Slippery road conditions due to snow accumulations ranging from 2 to 3 inches.	The southern Green Mountains of Vermont	Tonight into Tuesday Morning
<b>Snow &amp; Ice</b> 	Slippery road conditions due to snow accumulating 1 to 3 inches and a glaze to less than a tenth of an inch of ice from freezing rain.	Glaze of ice expected across eastern New York and western New England	Tonight into Tuesday Morning

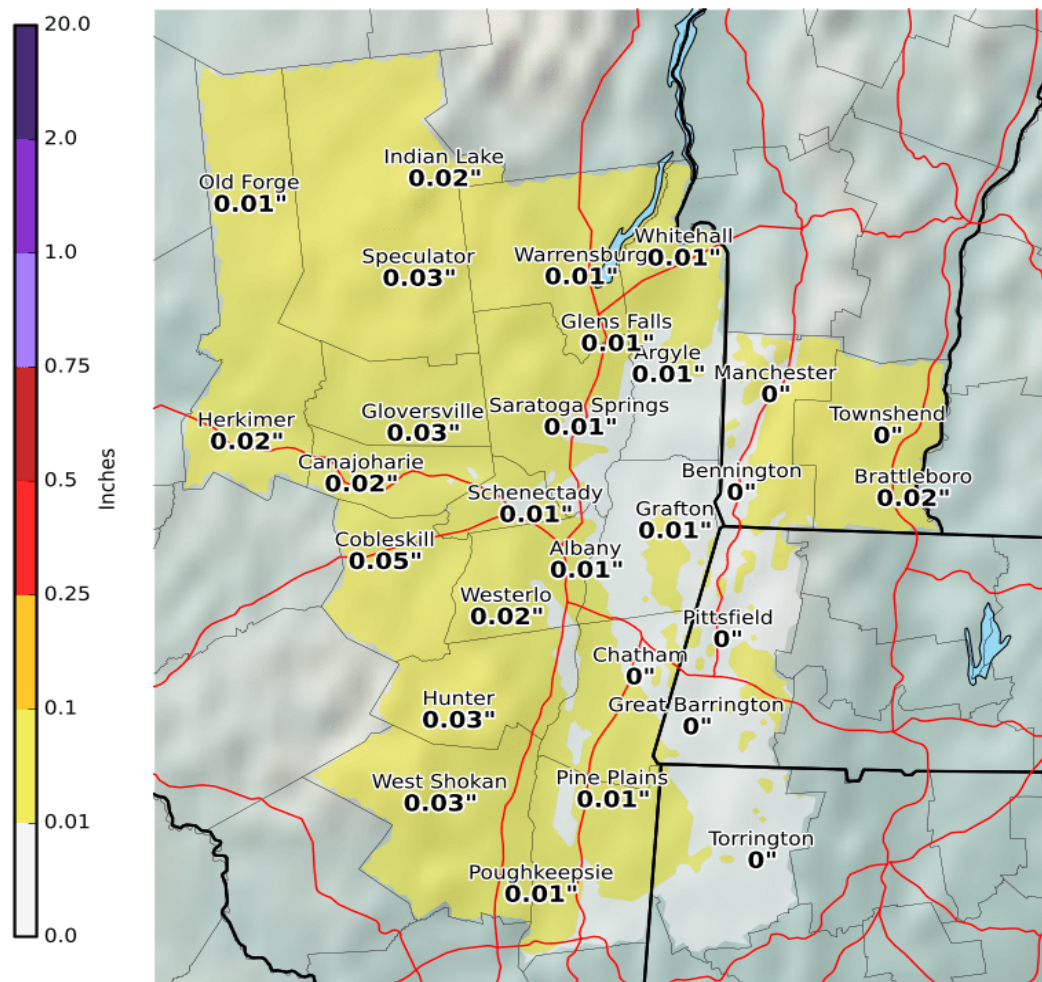

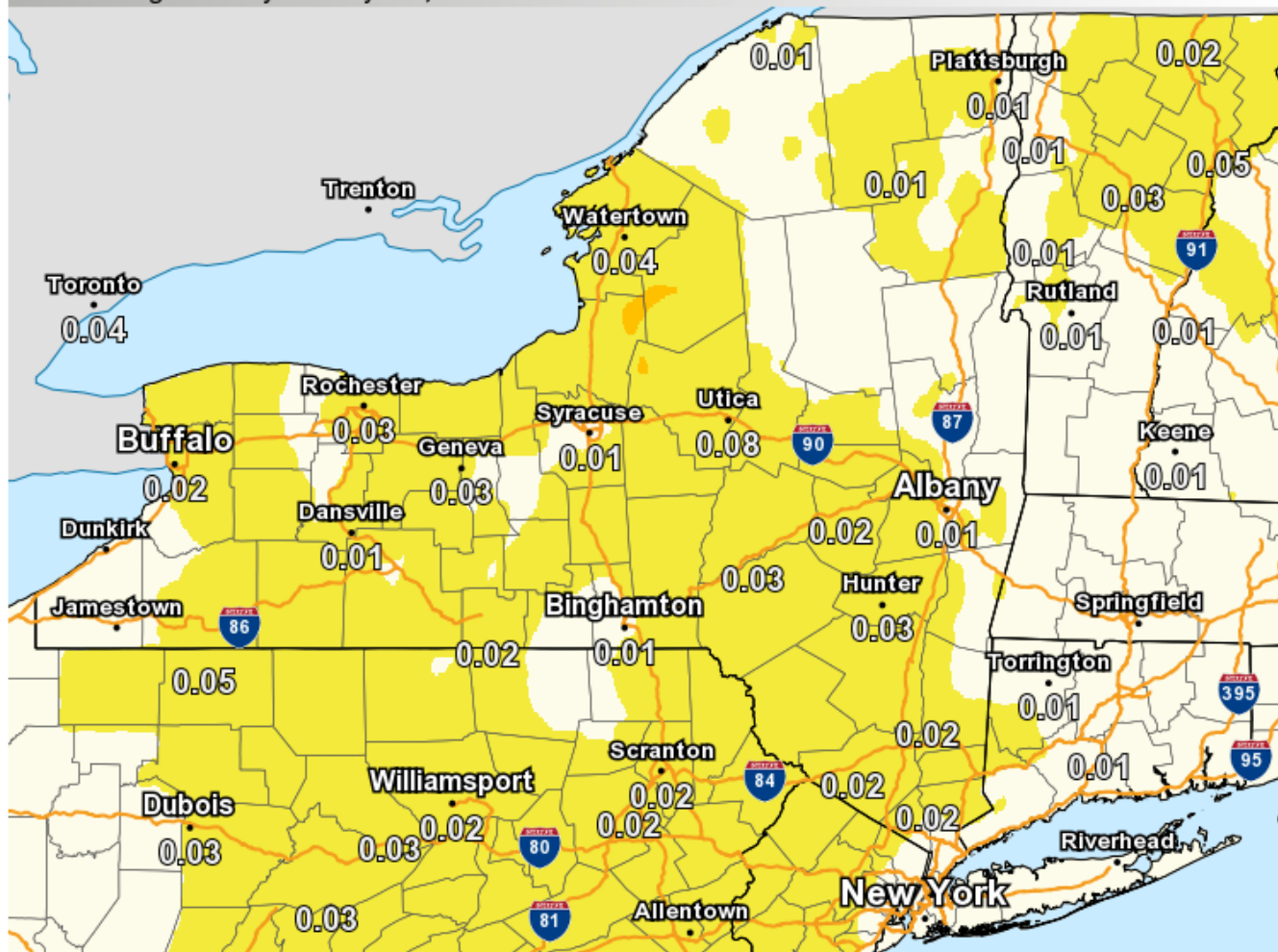


## Ice Accumulation Forecast

- Greater than 2.0 inch

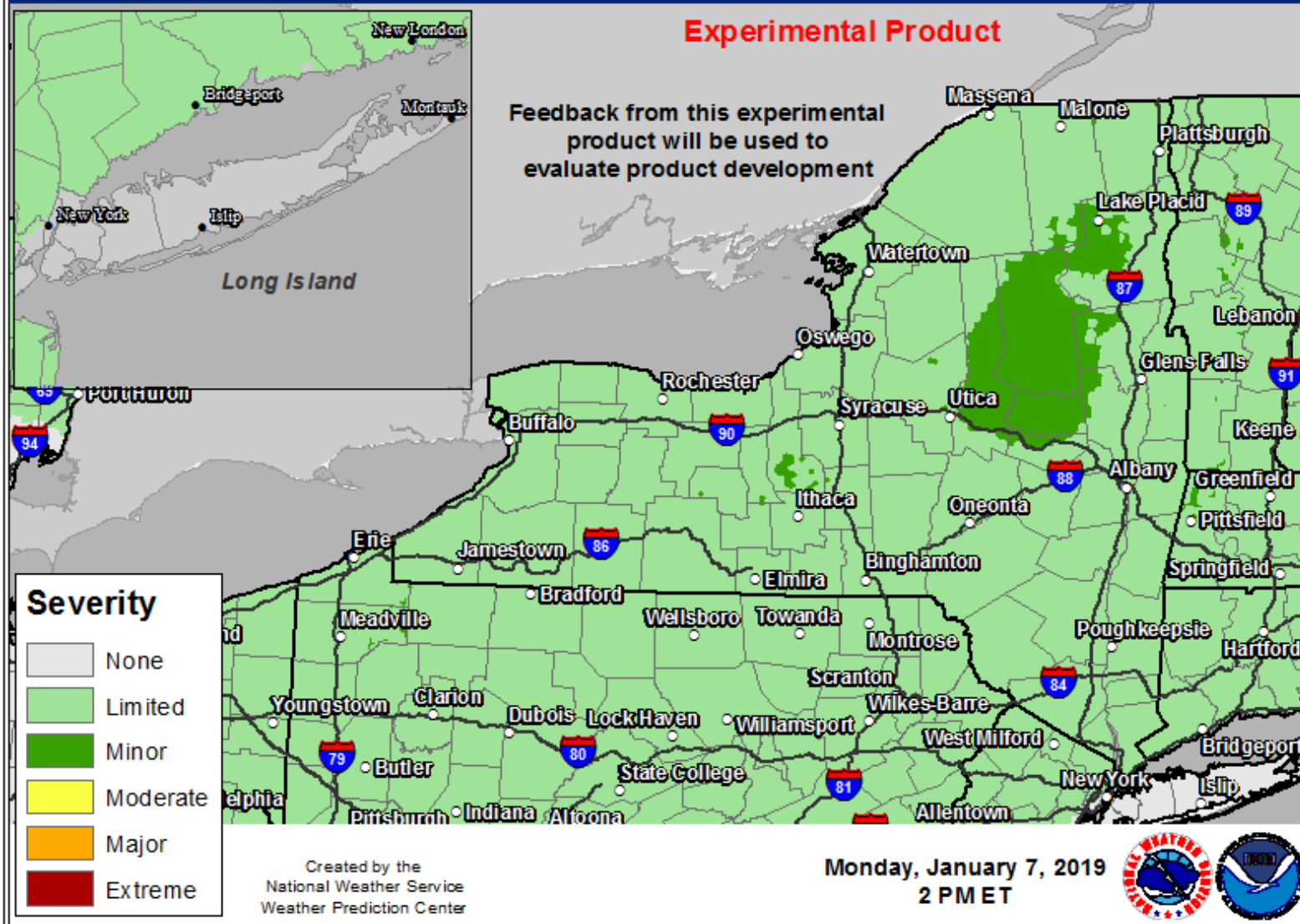

### Winter Weather Advisory in effect for all of eastern New York and western New England

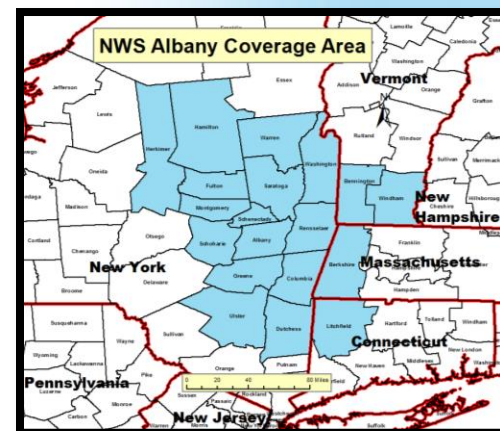
