



Snow & Ice		Slippery road conditions due to snow accumulating 1 to 3 inches and a glaze to less than a tenth of an inch of ice from freezing rain.	Glaze of ice expected across eastern New York and western New England	Tonight into Tuesday Morning







Winter Weather Advisory in effect for all of eastern New York and western New England


