



Heavy Snow & Blowing Snow	Hazardous travel due to heavy snow and blowing snow with additional accumulations of up to 4 inches.	Northern Herkimer, Bennington and western Windham Counties for elevations above 1000 feet	Through tonight
Snow & Blowing Snow	Slippery road conditions due to moderate snow and blowing snow with <u>additional</u> accumulations of up to 3 inches.	Southern Herkimer, Hamilton, Eastern Windham, Eastern Rensselaer, and Berkshire Counties	Through 7 PM this evening
Strong Gusty Winds	Strong winds may bring down tree limbs and some trees, resulting in isolated power outages	Mohawk Valley, Saratoga Region, Schoharie Valley, Capital District, Helderbergs, eastern Catskills, mid Hudson Valley, Taconics, southern Greens, Berkshires &	Through 8 PM this evening





Impacts and Timing:


- ✓ Sustained winds of 15 to 25 mph are possible with gusts up to 50 mph through 8 PM this evening.
- ✓ The strong winds could bring down tree limbs and some trees, resulting in isolated power outages.
- ✓ Winds should begin to gradually weaken throughout the evening.



















Event Summary

Winter Storm Warning/Winter Weather Advisory and Wind Advisory....

Period of greatest impact: Through this evening for strong winds and through tonight for moderate to heavy snow.



Moderate to heavy snowfall is expected in the Warning area across northern Herkimer, Bennington and eastern Windham counties where up to an additional 4 inches of snowfall is possible through tonight.

Light to Moderate snowfall is expected in the Advisory area across southern Herkimer, Hamilton, eastern Rensselaer, and Berkshire Counties where additional snowfall up to 3 inches is possible through tonight.



Northwesterly winds will gust up to 50 mph through about 8 PM this evening.













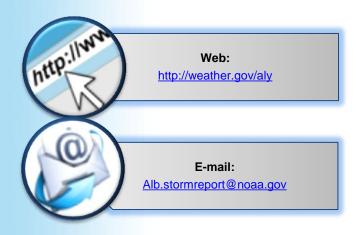
