

# **Main Points**

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Heavy Snow	Snowfall of 12 to 20 inches will result in difficult to impossible travel conditions. High snowfall rates of 1 – 3 inches per hour possible.	Eastern New York and western New England (except Ulster, Dutchess and Litchfield counties)	4 PM Saturday to 4 PM Sunday
Heavy Snow & Wintry Mix	Snowfall of 6 to 12 inches plus up to a tenth of an inch of ice accumulations. Snowfall rates of 1 to 2 inches per hour possible. Ice accretion could result in isolated power outages.	Eastern Ulster, Dutchess and Litchfield counties	4 PM Saturday to 4 PM Sunday
Blowing Snow	Drifting snow that may re-cover cleared roadways and sidewalks. Also, reduced visibility possible.	Eastern New York and western New England	Sunday evening into Monday
Wind Chill	Increased risk for frostbite and hypothermia.	Eastern New York and western New England	Sunday night through Monday night







### **Event Summary – Major Winter Storm this Weekend**

- Confidence is HIGH that this event will occur and MODERATE on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: Saturday afternoon into Sunday evening

ONAL WEATHER SERVICE



Light snow is expected to begin Saturday afternoon, becoming heavy at times Saturday evening into Sunday with snowfall rates up to 1-3 inches per hour. Totals of 12 to 20 inches will make travel difficult to impossible.



Snow totals of 6 to 12 inches are possible before mixing with sleet and freezing rain across eastern Ulster, Dutchess and Litchfield counties Saturday night into Sunday morning. The ice accretions could result in isolated power outages.



Gusty winds Sunday evening into Sunday night may lead to areas of blowing and drifting snow resulting in reduced visibilities and snow covered roadways.

Life-threatening wind chills expected Sunday night through Monday night which would result in increased risk of hypothermia and frostbite.








