














Most likely time frame of snow to end









Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast














Impacts and Timing:


- Dangerous to Life **Threatening Wind Chills** Wednesday night into Thursday morning, and also Thursday night into Friday morning
- ✓ Frostbite and hypothermia could occur in 10 to 30 minutes





















Event Summary

Winter Storm Expected....

- Confidence is **HIGH** that this event will occur and **Moderate to High** on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact for snow: This Evening daybreak Wednesday
- Wind Chill threat: Wednesday night Thursday morning & Thursday night Friday morning



Snow will increase in coverage and intensity through this evening. Snow will be heavy at times tonight.

Snow will end from west to east overnight.



Frigid air will move into the region Wednesday night through Friday. Dangerous to life threatening wind chills are expected Wednesday night - Friday morning.
