Minor Ice Accumulation		lcy roads/sidewalks.	Capital Region, eastern Green and western Columbia counties, north/central Taconics.	Wednesday mid-afternoon through early Thursday morning.
Moderate Ice Accumulation		Isolated power outages, downed trees, icy roads/sidewalks.	Southern Adirondacks, western Mohawk Valley, Schoharie Valley, Helderbergs, eastern Catskills, southern VT, Berkshire county in MA, and Litchfield county in CT	Wednesday early afternoon through Thursday morning.












Onset Times of Freezing Rain










Total Ice Accumulation Forecast

Valid: Wednesday 1 PM - Thursday 1 PM EST





- Isolated power outages, downed trees, icy roads/sidewalks.










