

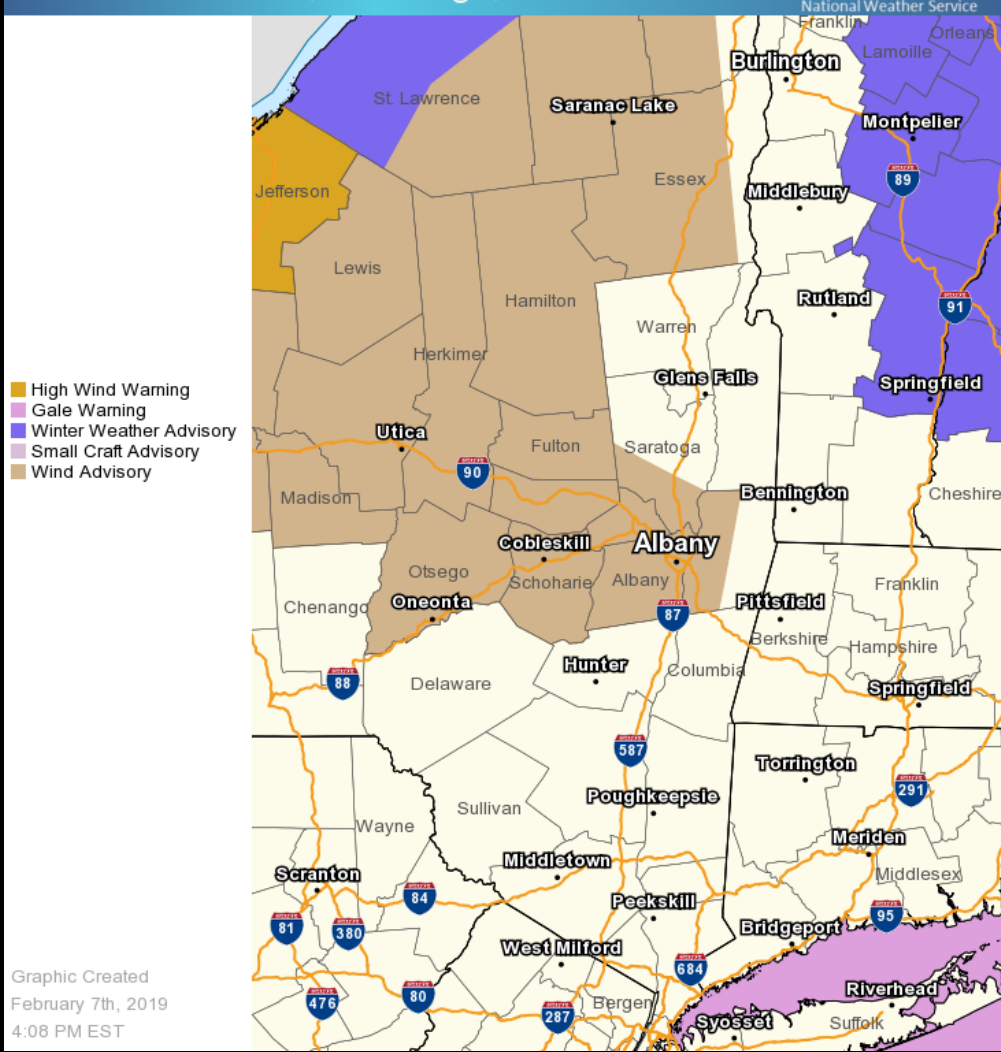

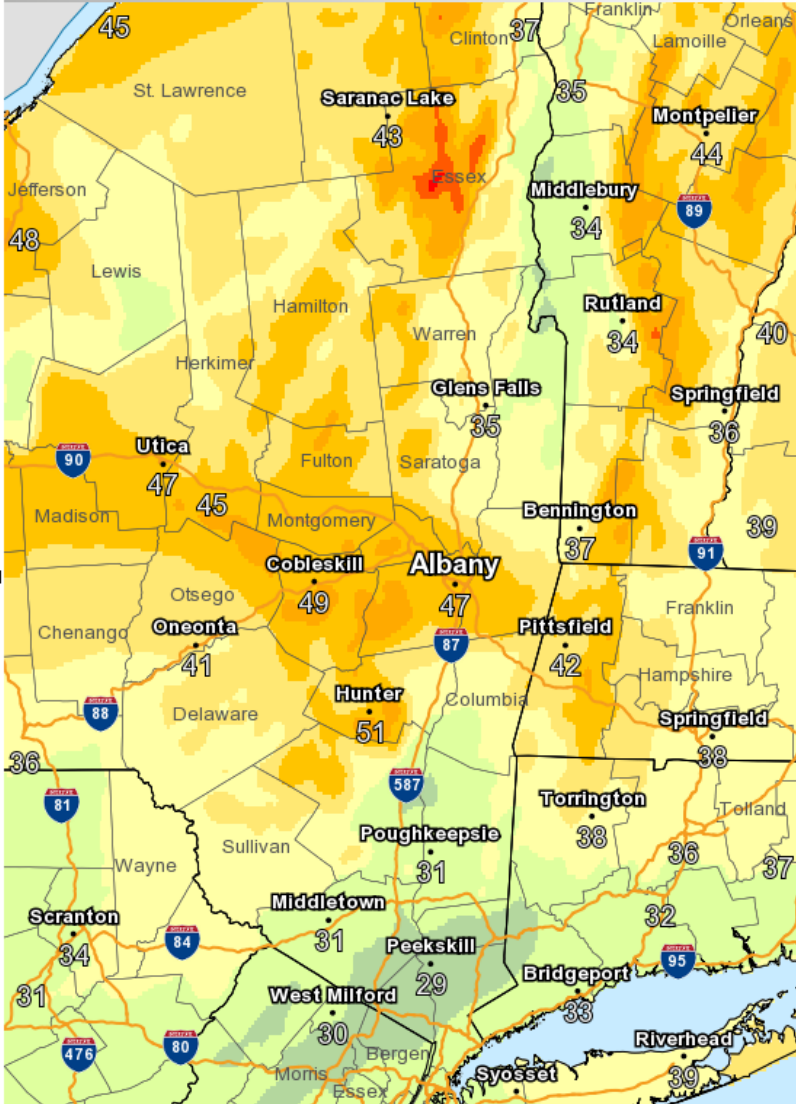
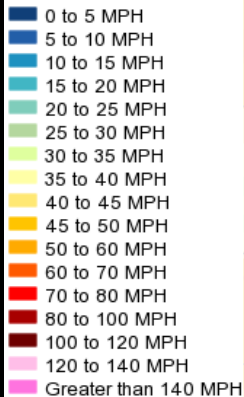

Impacts and Timing:

- ✓ Wind gusts of 45 to 55 mph could down large tree limbs, a few large trees and produce isolated power outages
- ✓ Strongest winds expected Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon

Strong Winds Event Summary

- ✓ Confidence is **HIGH** that winds gusting above 45 mph will occur
- ✓ West winds are expected to gust to 45-55 mph Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon in the southern Adirondacks, Mohawk Valley, Capital District, Schoharie Valley, Schoharie Valley and Helderbergs. A Wind Advisory has been issued for these areas. The Wind Advisory may need to be expanded if confidence increases for wind advisory gusts outside the current advisory area.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: **Friday 1 PM to Saturday 1 PM**. Downed large tree limbs and a few trees are possible. Some isolated power outages may occur.

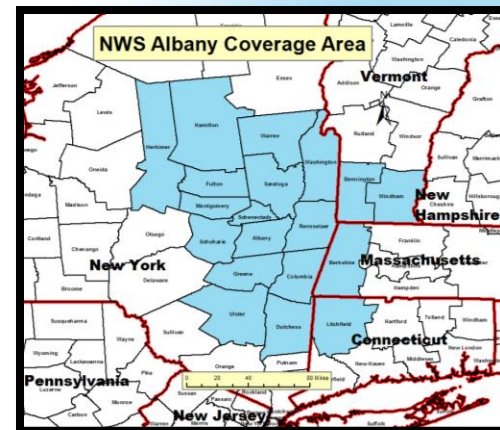
