



### **Impacts and Timing:**

- Wind gusts of 45 to 55  $\checkmark$ mph could down large tree limbs, a few large trees and produce isolated power outages
- ✓ Strongest winds expected Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon

### **Strong Winds Event Summary**

Confidence is HIGH that winds gusting above 45 mph will occur

ONAL WEATHER SERVICE

- West winds are expected to gust to 45-55 mph Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon in the southern Adirondacks, Mohawk Valley, Capital District, Schoharie Valley, Schoharie Valley and Helderbergs. A Wind Advisory has been issued for these areas. The Wind Advisory may need to be expanded if confidence increases for wind advisory gusts outside the current advisory area.
- Period of greatest impact: Friday 1 PM to Saturday 1 PM. Downed large tree limbs and a few trees are possible. Some isolated power outages may occur.


