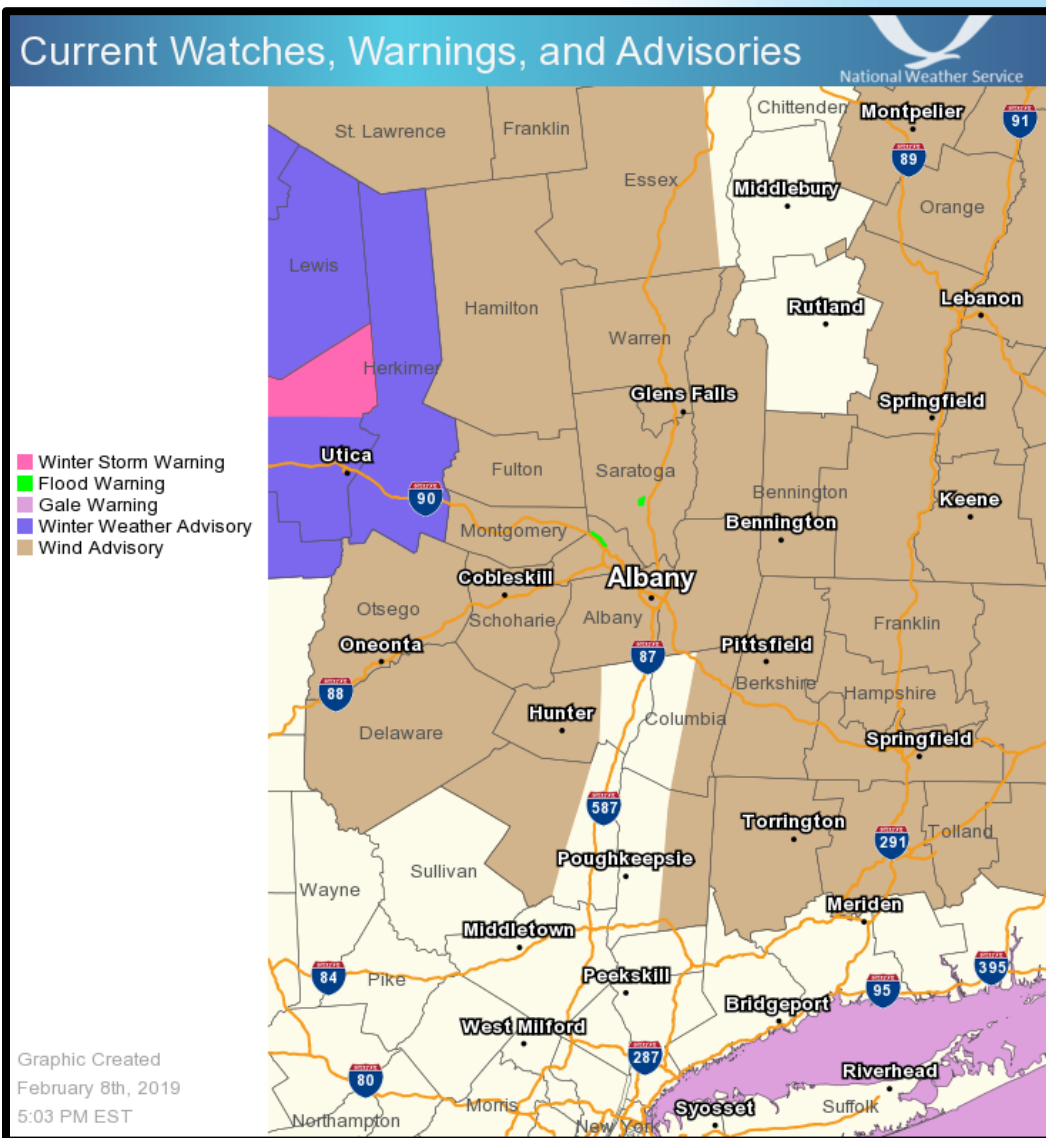

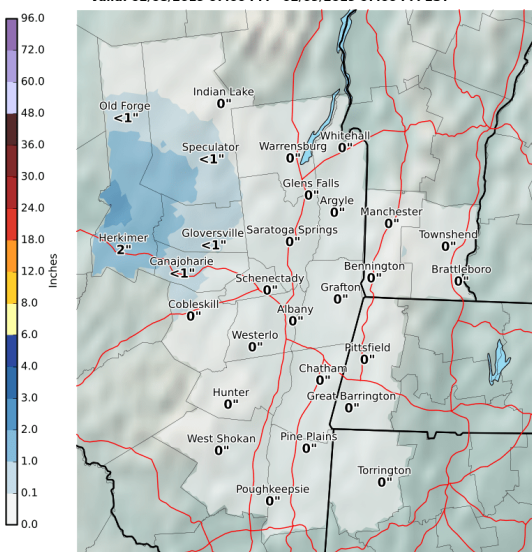
Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Wind 	<p>Downed large tree limbs and a few trees. Isolated to scattered power outages are possible.</p>	<p>Most of eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>Until 3 PM Saturday</p>
Snow 	<p>Slippery road conditions due to 2-5 inches of snow. Blowing snow due to gusty winds 40 to 50 mph</p>	<p>Northern Herkimer County</p>	<p>Until 1 PM Saturday</p>
Snow 	<p>Slippery road conditions due to 3 to 6 inches of snow. Blowing snow due to gusty winds 40 to 50 mph</p>	<p>Southern Herkimer County</p>	<p>7 pm Friday to 1 pm Saturday</p>

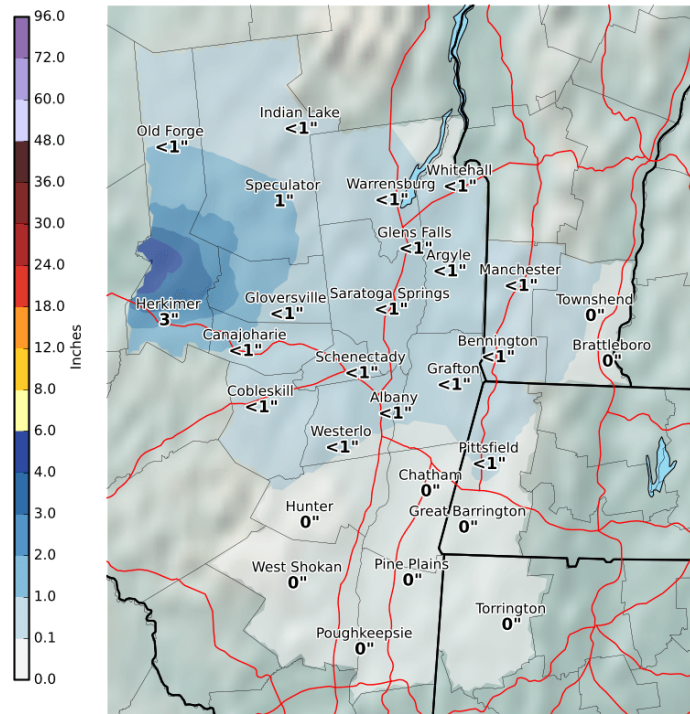

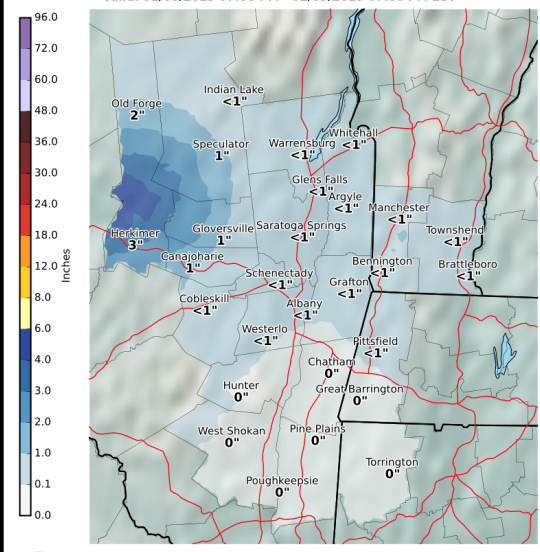

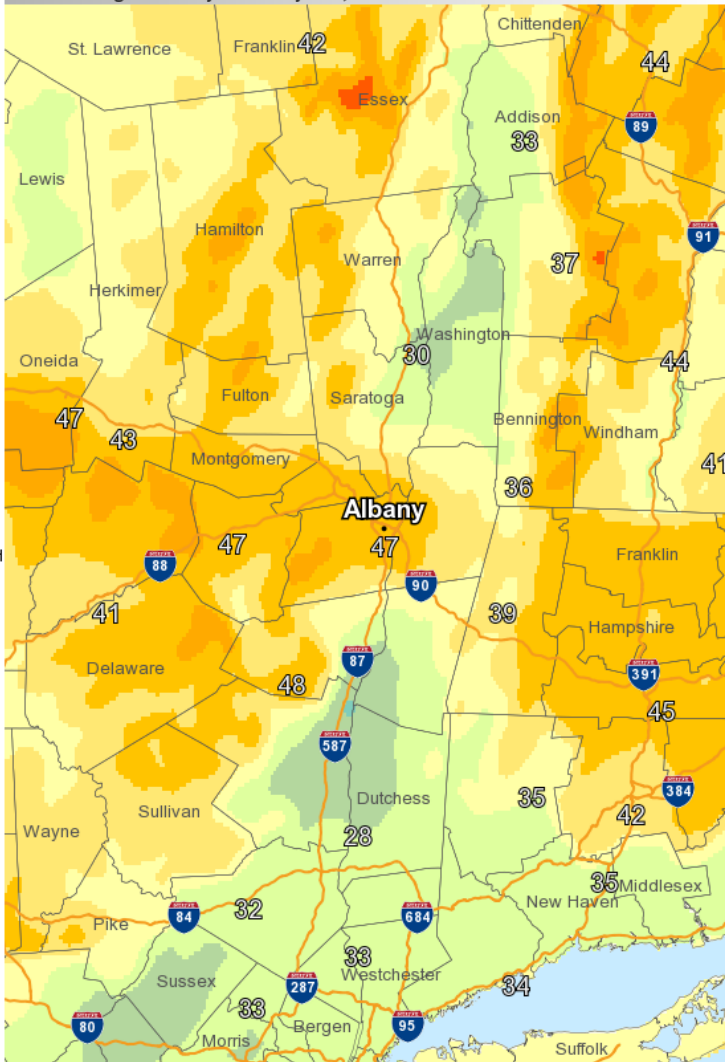

Impacts and Timing:

- ✓ Wind gusts of 40 to 50 mph could down large tree limbs, a few large trees and produce isolated to scattered power outages.
- ✓ Strongest winds expected tonight into early Saturday afternoon.

Wind and Winter Weather Advisories – Event Summary

- ✓ Confidence is **HIGH** that winds will gust greater than 45 MPH across most of eastern New York and western New England
- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that snow will accumulate 3-6 inches over Herkimer county
- ✓ West winds are expected to gust to 40-50 mph tonight into Saturday afternoon across eastern New York (excluding the Mid Hudson Valley) and western New England.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact (*wind*): **Tonight to Saturday 3 PM**. Downed large tree limbs and a few trees are possible. Some isolated to scattered power outages may occur.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact (*snow*): **Tonight to Saturday 1 PM**. 3-6 inches of snow expected with difficult travel conditions due to snow and blowing snow in some areas.

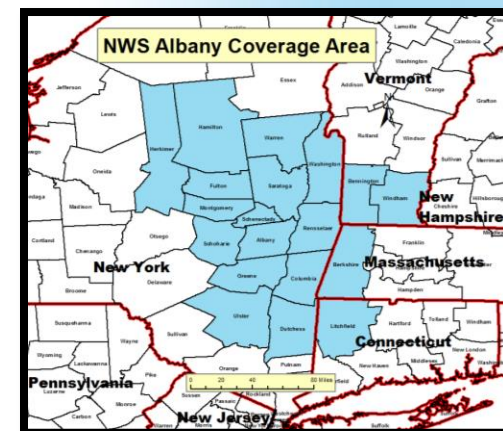
