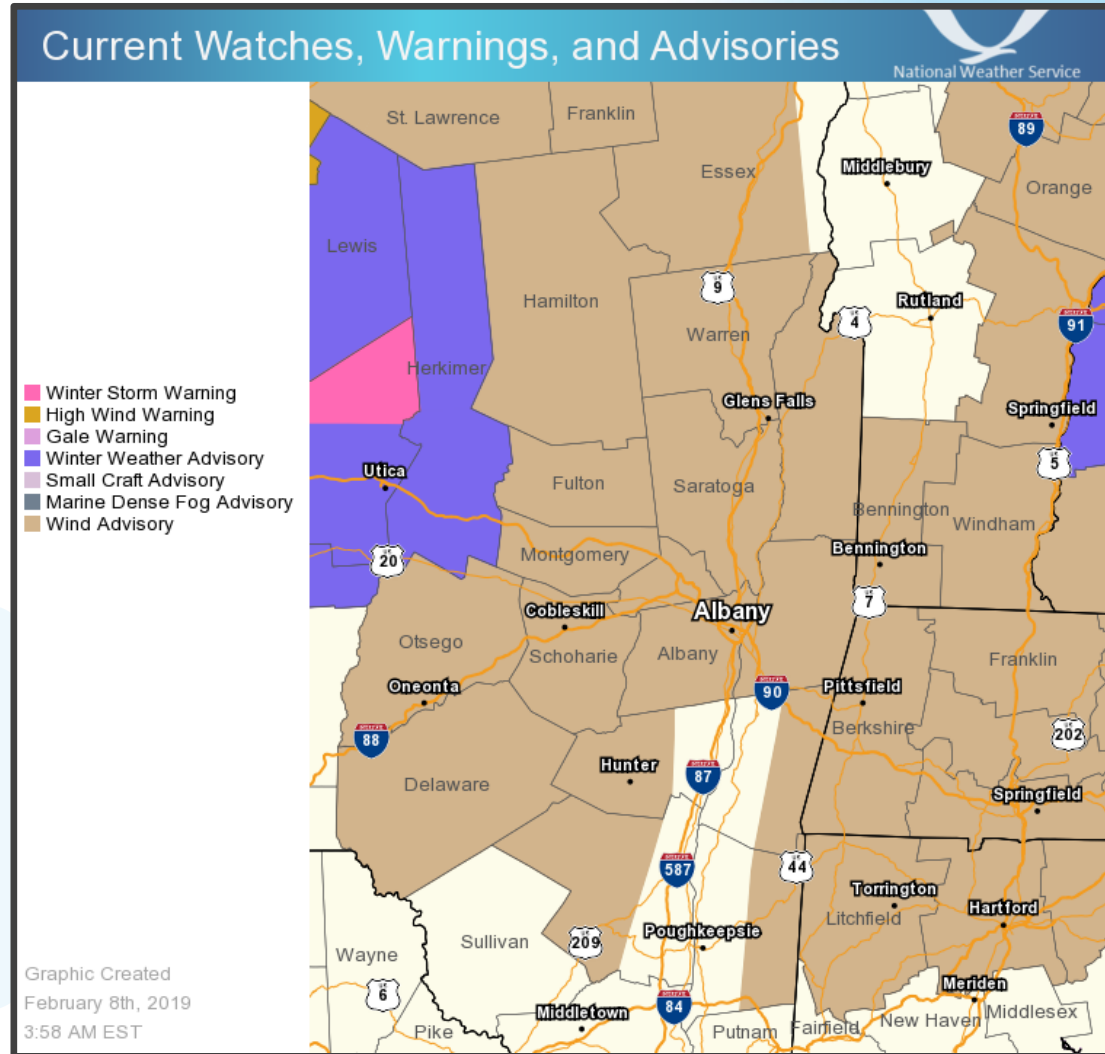

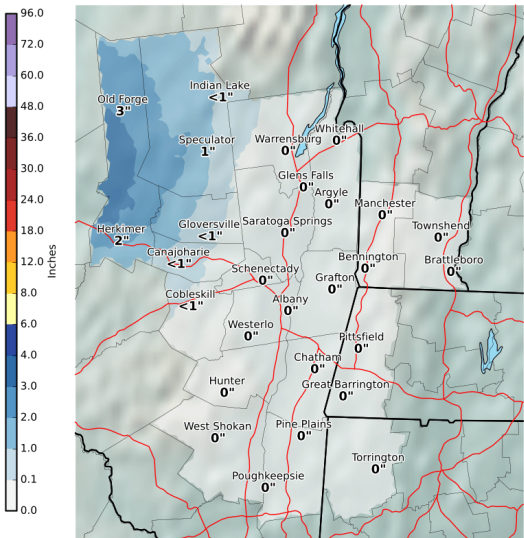

<b>Wind</b> 	<p>Downed large tree limbs and a few trees. Isolated power outages are possible.</p>	<p>Eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>1 PM Friday to 3 PM Saturday</p>
<b>Snow</b> 	<p>Slippery road conditions due to 3-6 inches of snow</p>	<p>Herkimer County</p>	<p>5 PM Friday to 1 PM Saturday</p>

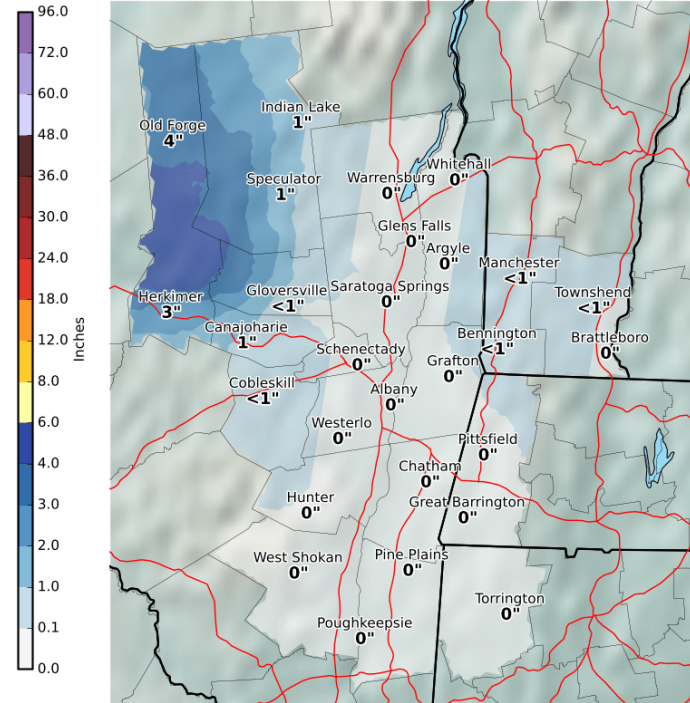

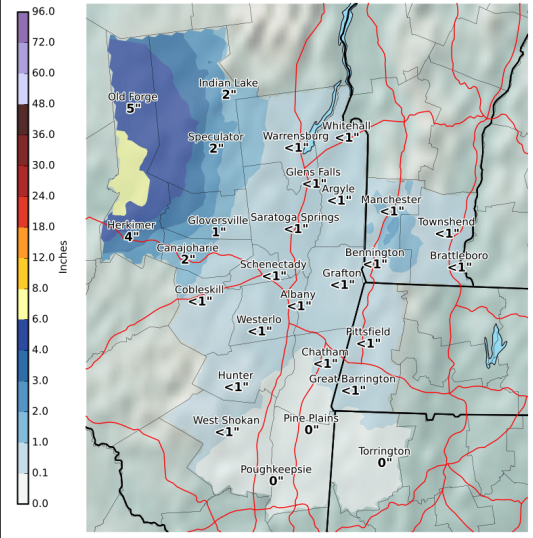

Valid: 02/08/2019 07:00 AM - 02/09/2019 01:00 PM

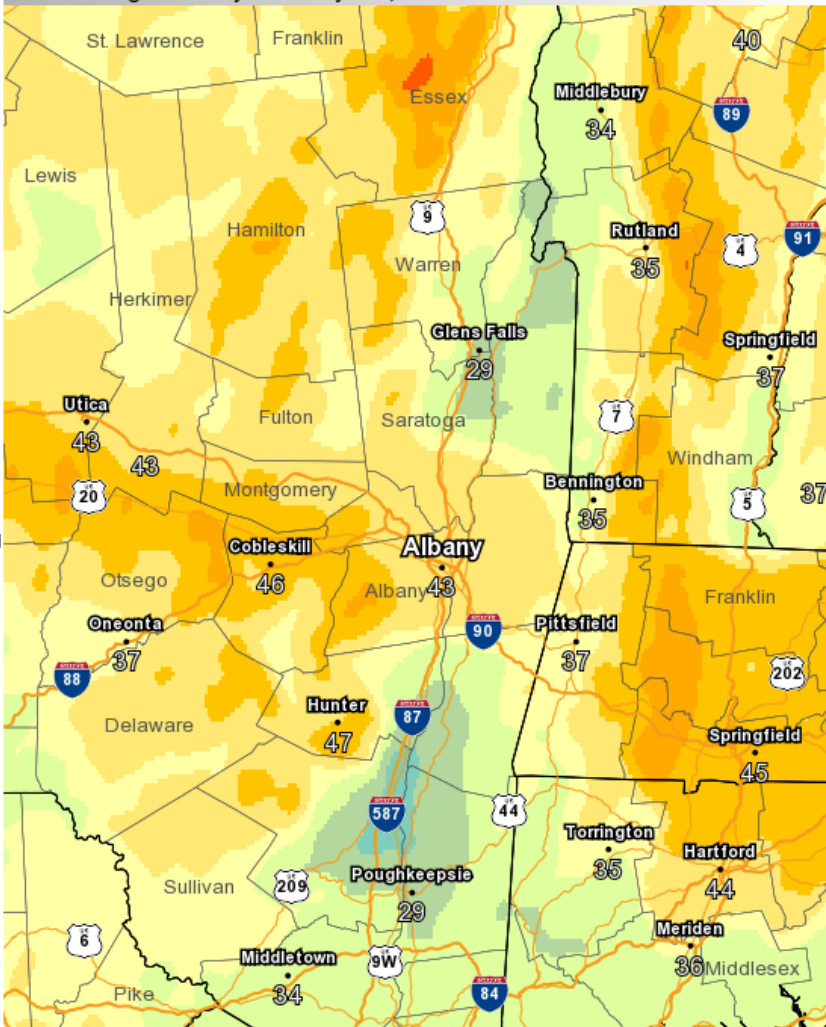
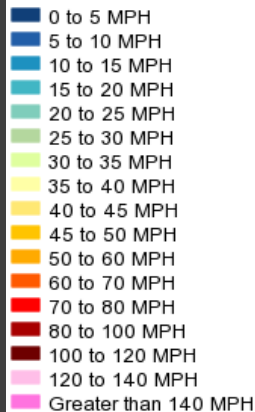

## Impacts and Timing:

- ✓ Wind gusts of 40 to 50 mph could down large tree limbs, a few large trees and produce isolated power outages.
- ✓ Strongest winds expected Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon.



# Wind and Winter Weather Advisories – Event Summary

- ✓ Confidence is **HIGH** that winds will gust greater than 45 MPH across eastern New York and western New England
- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that snow will accumulate 3-6 inches over Herkimer county
- ✓ West winds are expected to gust to 40-50 mph Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon across eastern New York and western New England. A Wind Advisory has been issued for these regions.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact (*wind*): **Friday 1 PM to Saturday 3 PM**. Downed large tree limbs and a few trees are possible. Some isolated power outages may occur.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact (*snow*): **Friday 5 PM to Saturday 1 PM**. 3-6 inches of snow expected with difficult travel conditions in some areas.

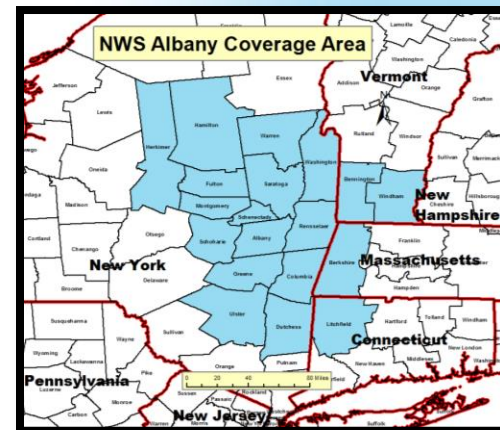
