Impacts and Timing:

- Wind gusts of 40 to 50 mph could down large tree limbs, a few large trees and produce isolated power outages.
- ✓ Strongest winds expected Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon.

Wind and Winter Weather Advisories – Event Summary

- Confidence is HIGH that winds will gust greater than 45 MPH across eastern New York and western New England
- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that snow will accumulate 3-6 inches over Herkimer county
- West winds are expected to gust to 40-50 mph Friday afternoon into early Saturday afternoon across eastern New York and western New England. A Wind Advisory has been issued for these regions.
- Period of greatest impact (*wind*): Friday 1 PM to Saturday 3 PM. Downed large tree limbs and a few trees are possible. Some isolated power outages may occur.
- Period of greatest impact (*snow*): Friday 5 PM to Saturday 1 PM. 3-6 inches of snow expected with difficult travel conditions in some areas.


