



Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Wind	Downed large tree limbs and a few trees. Isolated to scattered power outages are possible.	Most of eastern New York and western New England	Until 3 PM Today
Snow	Slippery road conditions due to snow. Additional snow will be around an inch, with storm tota amounts of 3 to 6 inches of snow. Blowing snow due to gusty winds 40 to 50 mph	Southern Herkimer	Until 1 PM Today




Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast



Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast







Impacts and Timing:

- Wind gusts of 40 to 50 mph could down large tree limbs, a few large trees and produce isolated to scattered power outages.
- ✓ Strongest winds expected through this afternoon.

Wind and Winter Weather Advisories – Event Summary

- Confidence is HIGH that winds will gust greater than 45 MPH across most of eastern New York and western New England
- Confidence is MODERATE that storm total snow will accumulate 3-6 inches over southern Herkimer county
- West winds are expected to gust to up to 50 mph through this afternoon across eastern New York (excluding the Mid Hudson Valley) and western New England.
- Period of greatest impact (*wind*): Through 3 PM. Downed large tree limbs and a few trees are possible. Some isolated to scattered power outages may occur.
- Period of greatest impact (*snow*): Through 1 PM. Around an inch of additional snow, allowing for a storm total amount of 3 to 6 inches of snow across southern Herkimer
 County. Slippery travel conditions are expected due to snow and blowing snow.




NWS Albany Coverage Area
