





Impacts and Timing:

- Precipitation will change over to sleet and freezing rain for southern areas late in the day Tuesday and continuing into Tuesday night.
- Ice accretion of up to two tenths of an inch may make for hazardous travel and slippery walking conditions.

Event Summary

Winter Storm Possible Tuesday into Wednesday....

✓ Confidence is HIGH that this event will occur and MODERATE on expected impacts

Period of greatest impact: Tuesday Afternoon – Wednesday morning

Winter Storm Watch in Effect for Mohawk Valley, southern & western Adirondacks, Lake George Saratoga Region & Southern Vermont for Tuesday afternoon through Wednesday afternoon



Snow will overspread the region on Tuesday and become heavy Tuesday afternoon. Southern areas may see a changeover to sleet and freezing rain late in the day, while northern areas continue to see heavy snow into Tuesday night. A moderate to heavy accumulation may occur before snow tapers off on Wednesday.

This storm has the potential to result in hazardous to dangerous travel conditions, including during the evening commute on Tuesday.


