

Main Points

Snow	Moderate to heavy snowfall, with snowfall rates of 1 to 2 inches per hour this afternoon into early evening. Dangerous travel conditions expected, especially the evening commute today.	All of eastern New York and western New England.	Today into this evening.
Sleet *:	Slippery roads and sidewalks. Combined snow and sleet will make consistency heavy and dense	All of eastern New York and western New England.	Late this afternoon into tonight. Wintry mix changes back to snow showers all areas Wednesday morning.
Freezing Rain	lcy roads and sidewalks.	All areas except southern Adirondacks	This evening into tonight.
Wind	Winds gusts may lead to downed large tree limbs and some trees, resulting in isolated power outages.	Southern Green Mountains, northern and central Taconics and Berkshires	Late this afternoon through early Wednesday morning.












Most likely time of winter precipitation onset









Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast

Expected Snowfall



















Impacts and Timing:

- ✓ Snow will change to sleet late this afternoon into this evening. Sleet will mix with or change to freezing rain tonight.
- ✓ Ice accretion of up to two tenths of an inch will lead to hazardous travel and icy walking conditions.
- Ice accumulations combined with strong winds in the southern Green Mountains, Berkshires, Litchfield Hills and Taconics, may lead to isolated power outages.



Impacts and Timing:

- Strong east to southeast winds will gust up to 55 mph from 4 PM this afternoon trough 7 AM Wednesday morning across the southern Green Mountains, northern and central Taconics and Berkshires.
- Strong winds may down large tree limbs and some trees, resulting in isolated power outages.











Event Summary

Winter Storm today into Wednesday....

- Confidence is **HIGH** that this event will occur and **HIGH** on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: This Afternoon into Wednesday morning

Winter Storm Warning: All of eastern NY and western New England **Wind Advisory**: southern Green Mountains, northern & central Taconics, and Berkshires.



Snow will begin late this morning into early afternoon and become heavy this afternoon with 1 to 2 inch per hour snowfall rates expected. Dangerous travel conditions are expected during the evening commute today. Much of the area will change over to sleet late today into thus evening, with some freezing rain overnight. Southern Adirondacks likely continues as snow and sleet tonight.



Strong east to southeast winds will may result in isolated power outages (higher terrain areas east of the Hudson Valley).
