What Has Changed?

Winter Weather Advisories have been issued along and south of the I-90 corridor















Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Light to moderate Snow	2 to 5 inches of snow accumulation is expected. Hazardous traveling conditions with reduced visibilities	Along and south of Interstate 90	Tonight through Monday morning
Light Snow	1 to 3 inches of snow accumulation is expected. Partially snow covered roads with some reduction to visibility	To the north of Interstate 90	Overnight into Monday morning













Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast


Expected Snowfall



Event Summary

Winter Weather Advisory from 9 PM this evening to 1 PM Monday....

- Confidence is **Moderate** that these events will occur and **Moderate** on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact
 - Tonight as snow spreads from southwest to northeast
 - Monday morning commute will be impacted



2 to 5 inches of snow accumulation is expected in the advisory area. Hazardous traveling conditions with reduced visibilities along and south of Interstate 90.



1 to 3 inches of snow accumulation is expected north of the advisory area. Partially snow covered roads with some reduction to visibility to the north of Interstate 90.












