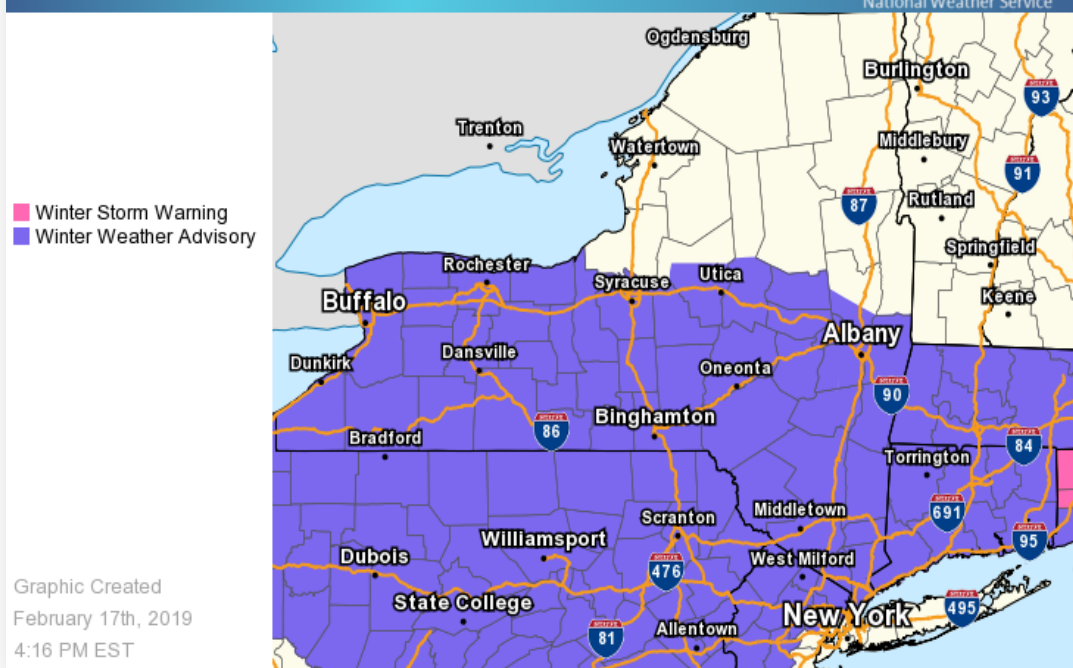

- ✓ Chance of freezing rain added to southern portions of Ulster, Dutchess, & Litchfield Counties for Monday morning

<b>Moderate Snow</b> 	<b>3 to 6 inches of snow accumulation is expected. Hazardous traveling conditions with reduced visibilities</b>	<b>Mainly along and south of Interstate 90</b>	<b>Tonight through Monday afternoon</b>
<b>Light Snow</b> 	<b>2 to 4 inches of snow accumulation is expected. Partially snow covered roads with some reduction to visibility</b>	<b>Mainly north of Interstate 90</b>	<b>Tonight into Monday afternoon</b>
<b>Light Freezing Rain</b> 	<b>A light glaze of ice possible. Slippery roads and walking surfaces.</b>	<b>Southern parts of Ulster, Dutchess &amp; Litchfield Counties</b>	<b>Monday morning</b>

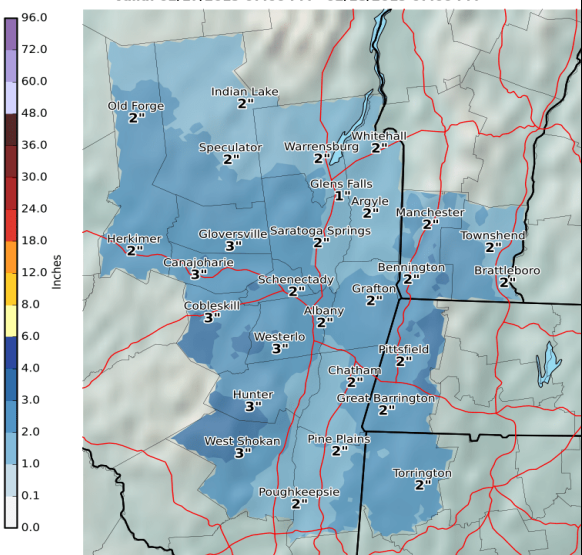

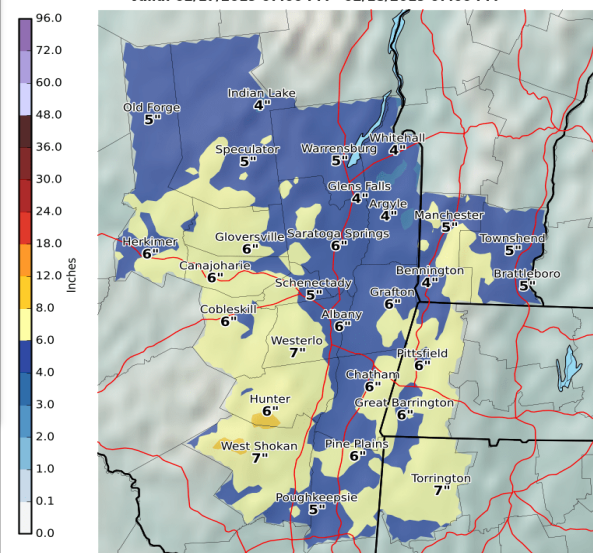

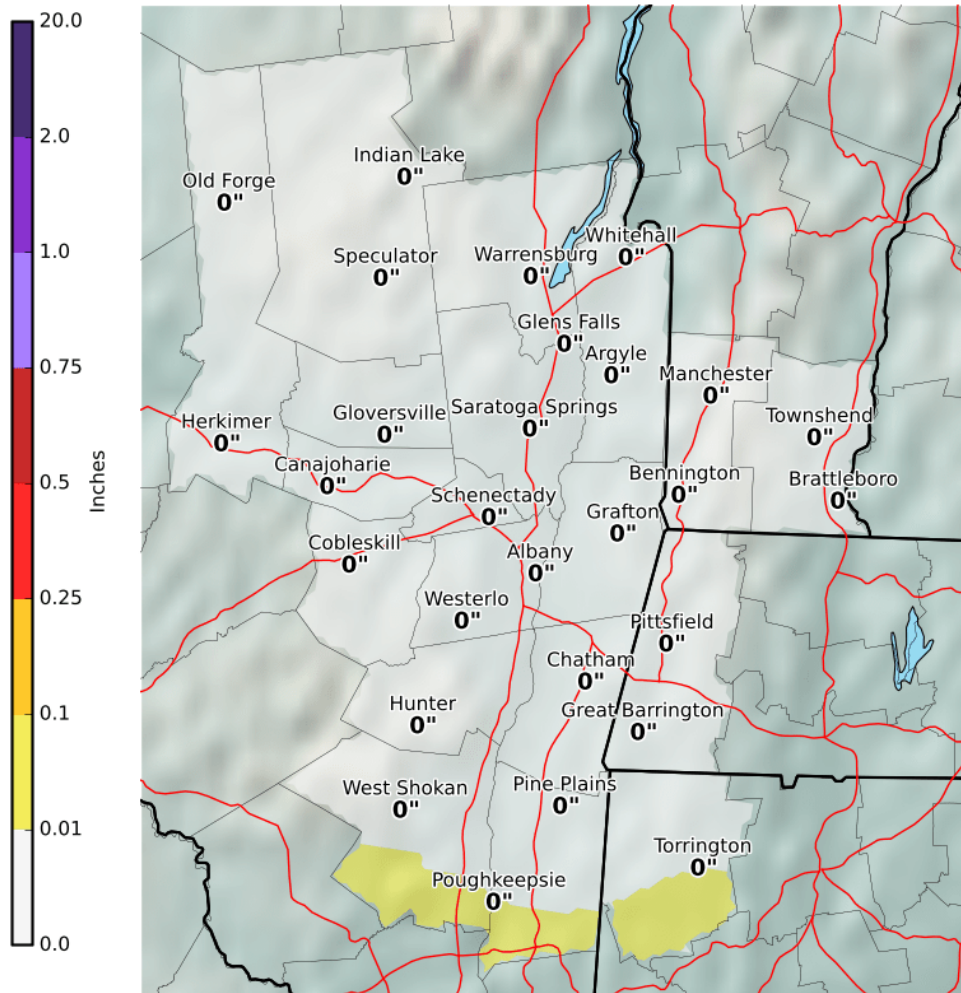

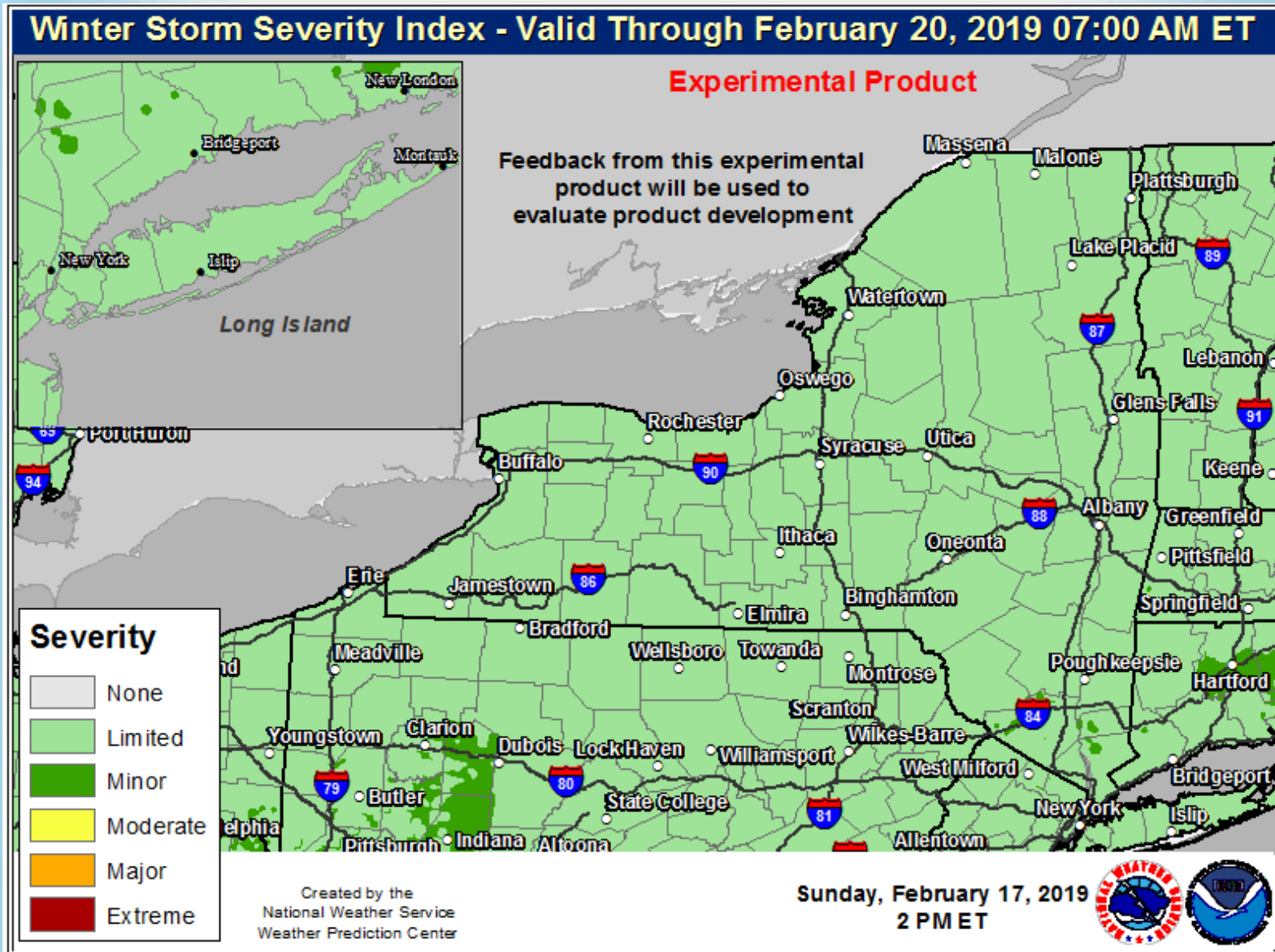

## Event Summary

### Winter Weather Advisory from 9 PM this evening to 4 PM Monday....

- ✓ Confidence is **Moderate** that these events will occur and **Moderate** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact
  - ✓ Tonight as snow develops from southwest to northeast
  - ✓ Monday morning commute will be impacted



3 to 6 inches of snow accumulation is expected in the advisory area.  
Hazardous traveling conditions with reduced visibilities mainly along and south of Interstate 90.



2 to 4 inches of snow accumulation is expected north of the advisory area.  
Partially snow covered roads with some reduction to visibility to the north of Interstate 90.



A light glaze of ice is possible from freezing rain Monday morning across southern parts of Ulster, Dutchess and Litchfield Counties.

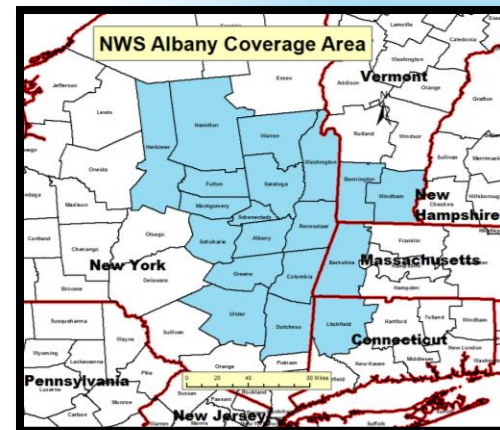
