What Has Changed?

- ✓ No changes to the Advisory area.
- Chance of freezing rain and freezing drizzle expanded to include all areas along and south of Interstate 90

















Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Light to Moderate Snow	Up to 2 inches of additional snow accumulation is expected. Hazardous traveling conditions with reduced visibilities	Mainly along and south of Interstate 90	Through this afternoon
Light Freezing Rain/Drizzle	A light glaze of ice possible. Slippery roads and walking surfaces.	Mainly along and south of Interstate 90	This morning












Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast








Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast





A light glaze of ice is possible from freezing rain and freezing drizzle this morning in the advisory area.














