




Snow, Sleet & Freezing Rain

What Has Changed?

No changes to the area but Advisories north of the Mohawk Valley and into southern Vermont have been extended until 10 AM Thursday






Most likely onset of snow Wednesday


Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast










High End Amount








Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast









Snow Forecast



Event Summary

- Confidence is **HIGH** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: This evening through Thursday morning



A light snowfall will overspread the local area from southwest to northeast late this afternoon into the evening hours with a transition to sleet and freezing rain occurring late in the evening into the overnight hours.



Hazardous travel conditions especially on untreated surfaces. Most of the precipitation is expected to occur late this afternoon through tonight. However, snow could impact evening commute across the eastern Catskills, Schoharie Valley, mid-Hudson Valley, southern Taconics and northwestern Connecticut. Lingering sleet and freezing rain could impact the Thursday morning commute across east central New York and adjacent western New England.
