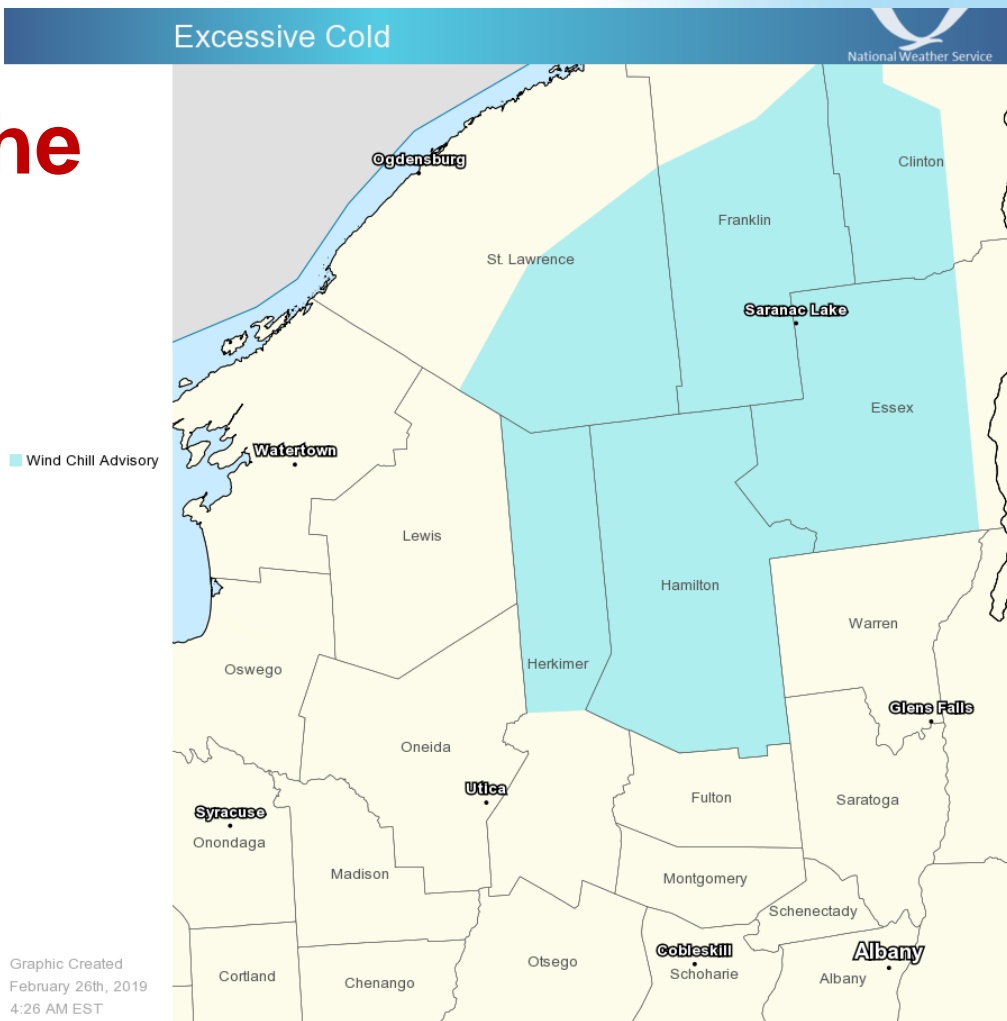

- ✓ *More snow in the forecast Wednesday into Wednesday night*

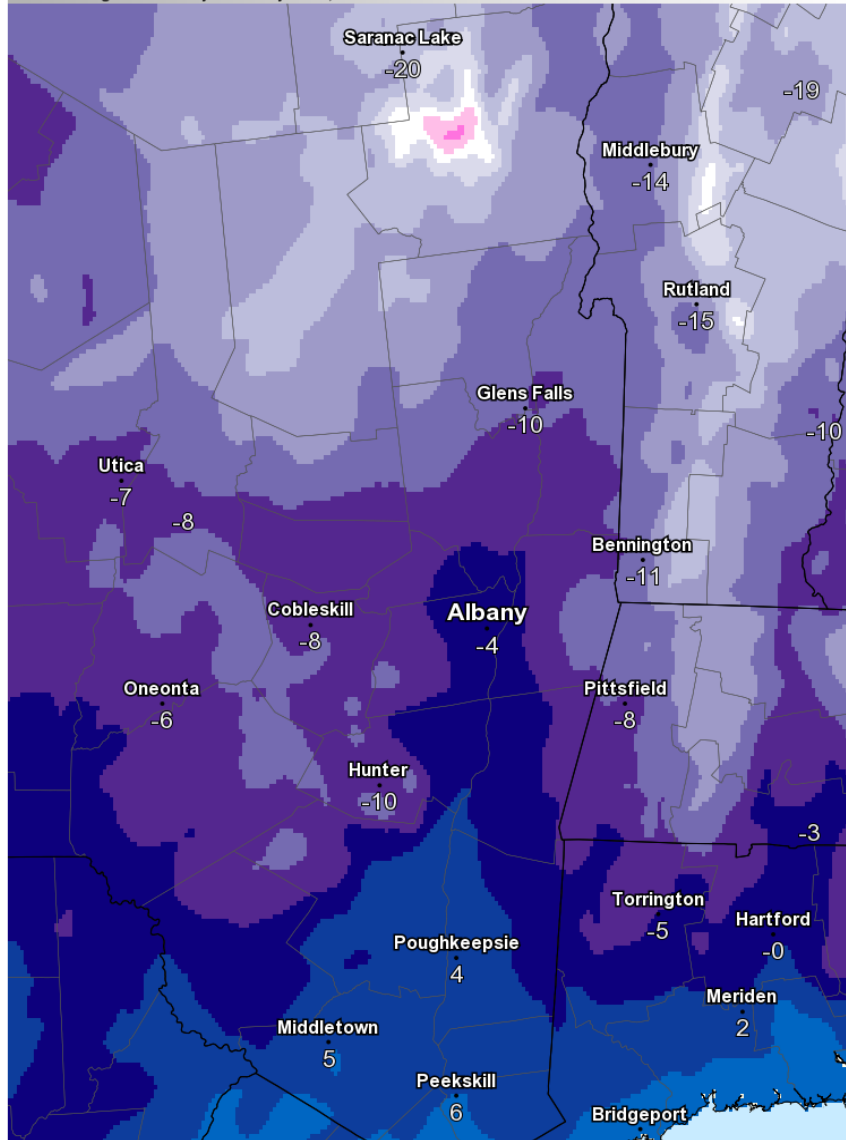
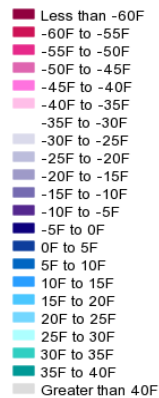

Wind Chill Advisory 	<p>Cold wind chill values of 20 below zero could cause frostbite on exposed skin in as little as 30 minutes</p>	<p>Northern Herkimer & Hamilton Counties</p>	<p>Until 8 AM This Morning</p>
Snow 	<p>Light to moderate snow accumulation will make for hazardous travel due to snow covered roadways and low visibility</p>	<p>All of eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>Wednesday afternoon and night</p>

Impacts and Timing:

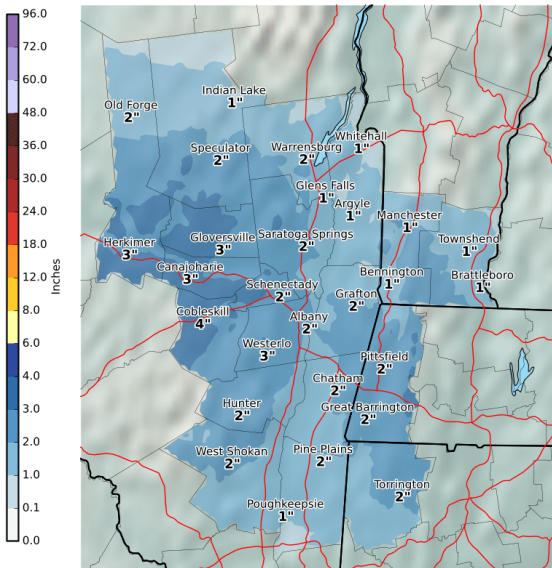
- ✓ Wind Chills will reach dangerously low values around 20 below zero across the western Adirondacks into this morning.
- ✓ These dangerously low chill values will allow for frostbite on exposed skin in as little as 30 minutes.

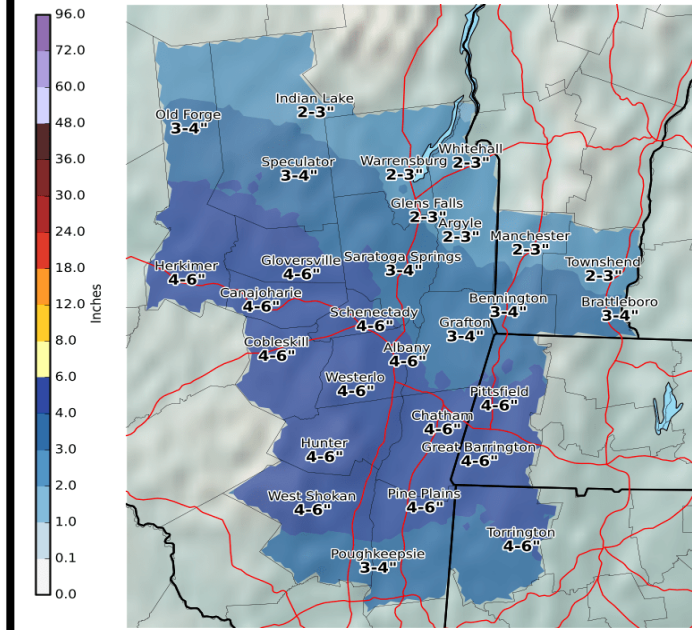

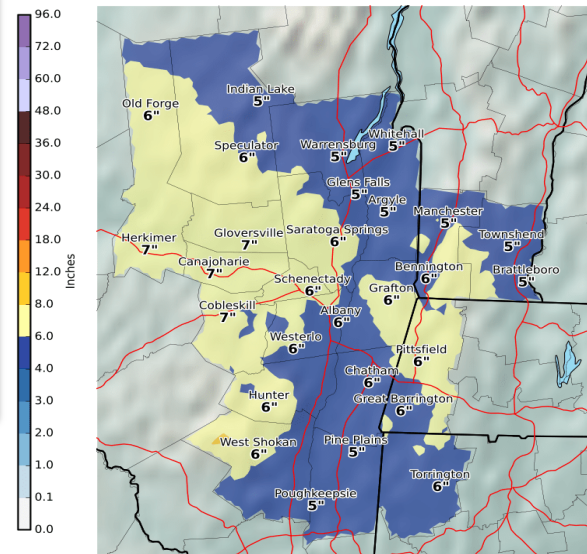
Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast

...Light to moderate snowfall accumulation Wednesday afternoon and night...

- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: This morning for wind chills. Snowfall Wednesday afternoon and night.



Wind Chill Advisory (Into This Morning): northern Herkimer & Hamilton Counties
Cold wind chill values of 20 below zero can cause frostbite in less than 30 minutes.

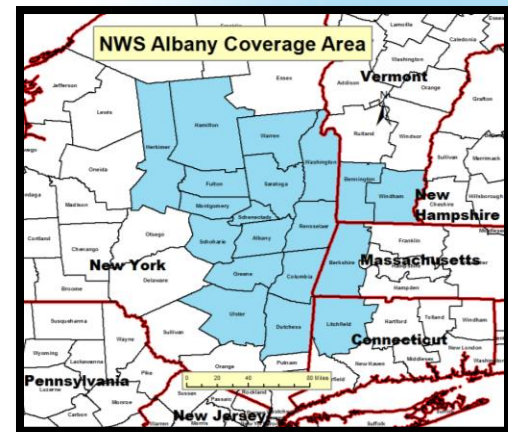


Light to moderate snowfall accumulation is expected Wednesday afternoon and Wednesday night across all of eastern New York and western New England.
