

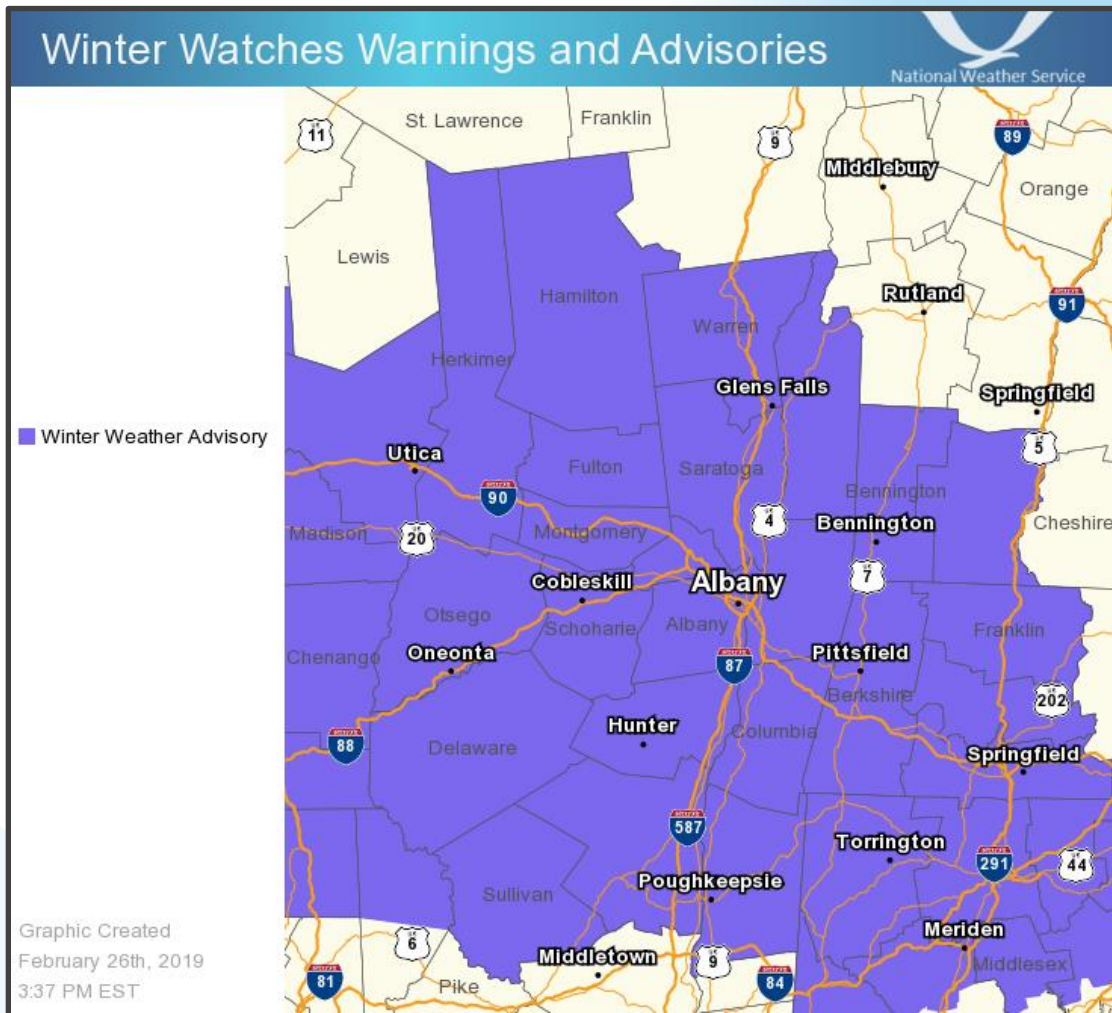

- ✓ Winter Weather Advisory issued for much of eastern New York and western New England

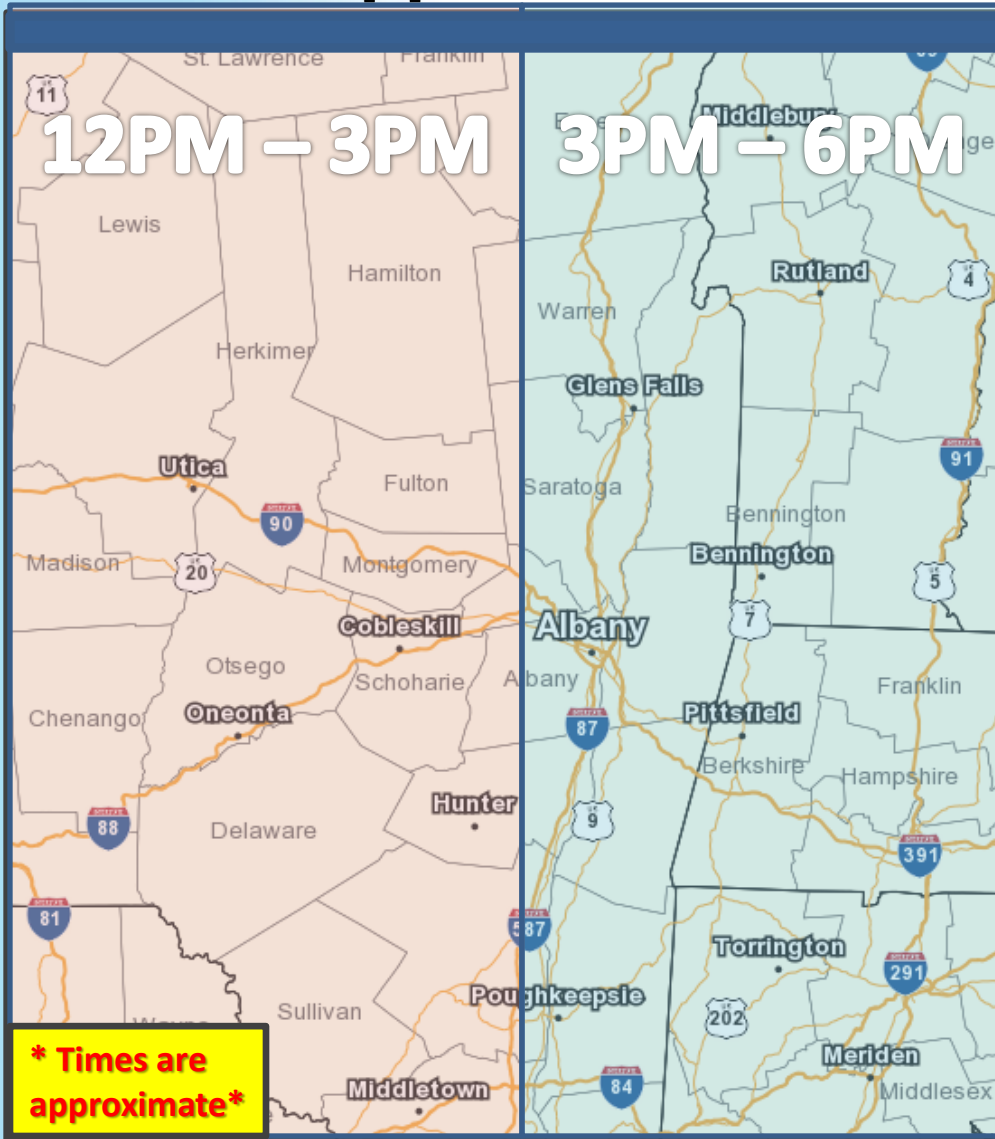

<b>Snow</b> 	Light-to-moderate snow accumulation will make for hazardous travel due to snow covered roadways and low visibility	Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Helderbergs, eastern Catskills and western Adirondacks	Early Wednesday afternoon through early Thursday morning. Will impact Wednesday evening commute.
<b>Snow</b> 	Light-to-moderate snow accumulation will make for hazardous travel due to snow covered roadways and low visibility	Capital and Lake George Saratoga Regions, Taconics, Mid-Hudson Valley, Berkshires, northwest Connecticut and southern Vermont	Mid-to-late Wednesday afternoon through early Thursday morning. Could impact Wednesday evening commute.



# Approximate Onset Times for Snow



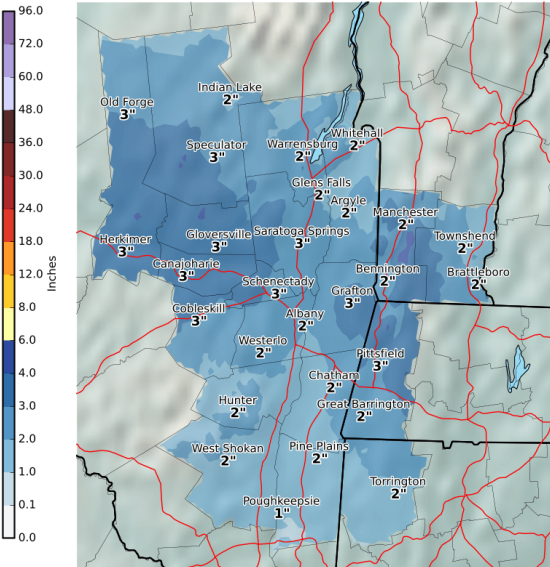
- Impacts and Timing:**
- ✓ Snow *will* likely impact the Wednesday evening commute west of the Hudson Valley, and *could* impact the Wednesday evening commute along and east of the Hudson Valley into western New England
  - ✓ Snow will continue through the overnight hours

# Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast – Wed-Wed Night

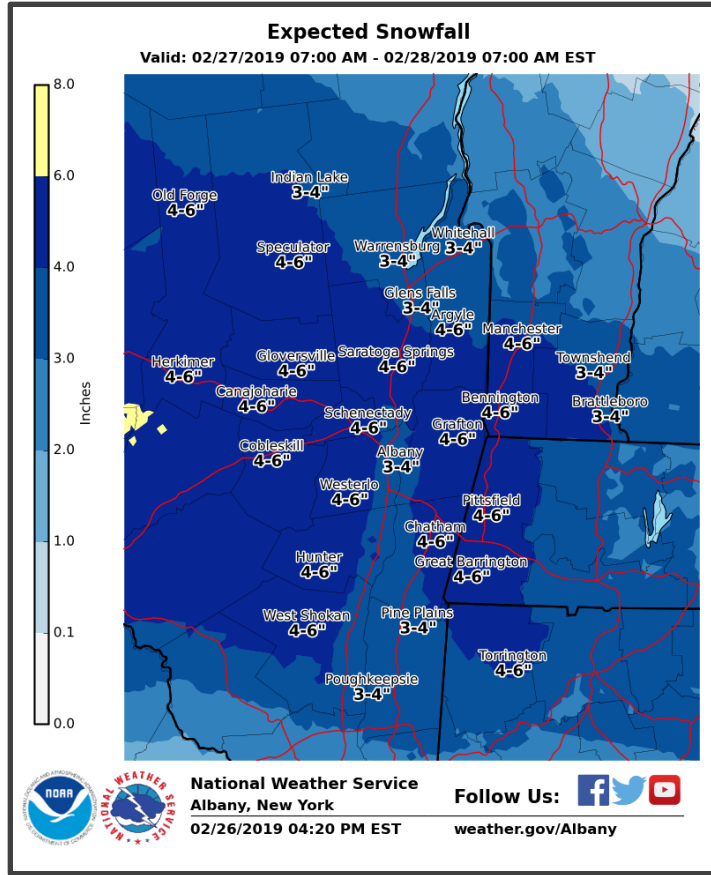

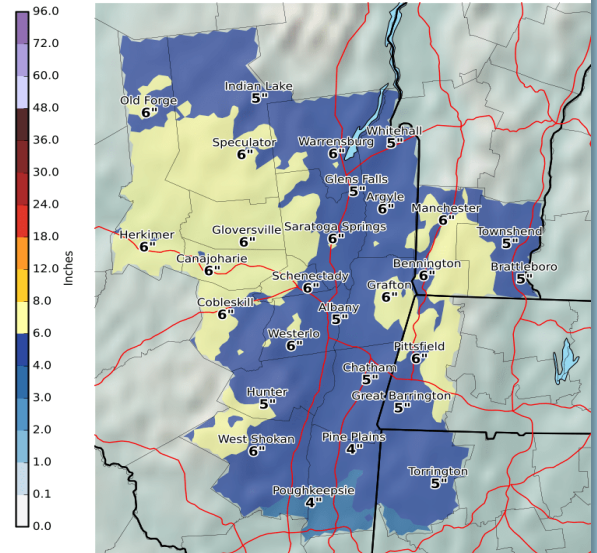

# Event Summary

**...Light to moderate snowfall accumulation Wednesday afternoon and night...**

- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: The Wednesday evening commute will likely be the time of greatest impact with light-to-moderate snow overspreading the region from west to east beginning during the early afternoon hours Wednesday and continuing through the overnight hours.



**Winter Weather Advisory (12PM Wednesday – 6AM Thursday):**

- **WHERE:** Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Helderbergs, eastern Catskills and western Adirondacks
- **WHAT:** Light-to-moderate snow **will** impact the Wednesday evening commute and continue overnight, likely ending before the Thursday morning commute



**Winter Weather Advisory (3PM Wednesday – 6AM Thursday):**

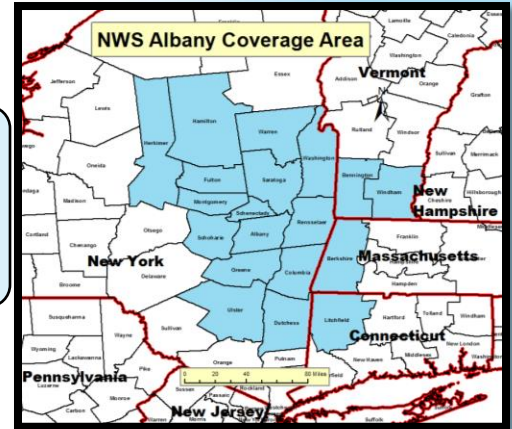
- **WHERE:** Capital and Lake George Saratoga Regions, Taconics, Mid-Hudson Valley, Berkshires, northwest Connecticut and southern Vermont
- **WHAT:** Light-to-moderate snow **could** impact the Wednesday evening commute and continue overnight. Some lingering light snow showers are possible through the Thursday morning commute.
