







Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast – Wed-Wed Night



Event Summary

...Light to moderate snowfall accumulation Wednesday afternoon and night...

Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts

ONAL WEATHER SERVICE

Period of greatest impact: The Wednesday evening commute will likely be the time of greatest impact with light-to-moderate snow overspreading the region from west to east beginning during the early afternoon hours Wednesday and continuing through the overnight hours.



Winter Weather Advisory (12PM Wednesday – 6AM Thursday):

- WHERE: Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Helderbergs, eastern Catskills and western Adirondacks
- WHAT: Light-to-moderate snow will impact the Wednesday evening commute and continue overnight, likely ending before the Thursday morning commute



Winter Weather Advisory (3PM Wednesday – 6AM Thursday):

- WHERE: Capital and Lake George Saratoga Regions, Taconics, Mid-Hudson Valley, Berkshires, northwest Connecticut and southern Vermont
- > WHAT: Light-to-moderate snow *could* impact the Wednesday evening commute and continue overnight. Some lingering light snow showers are possible through the Thursday morning commute.


