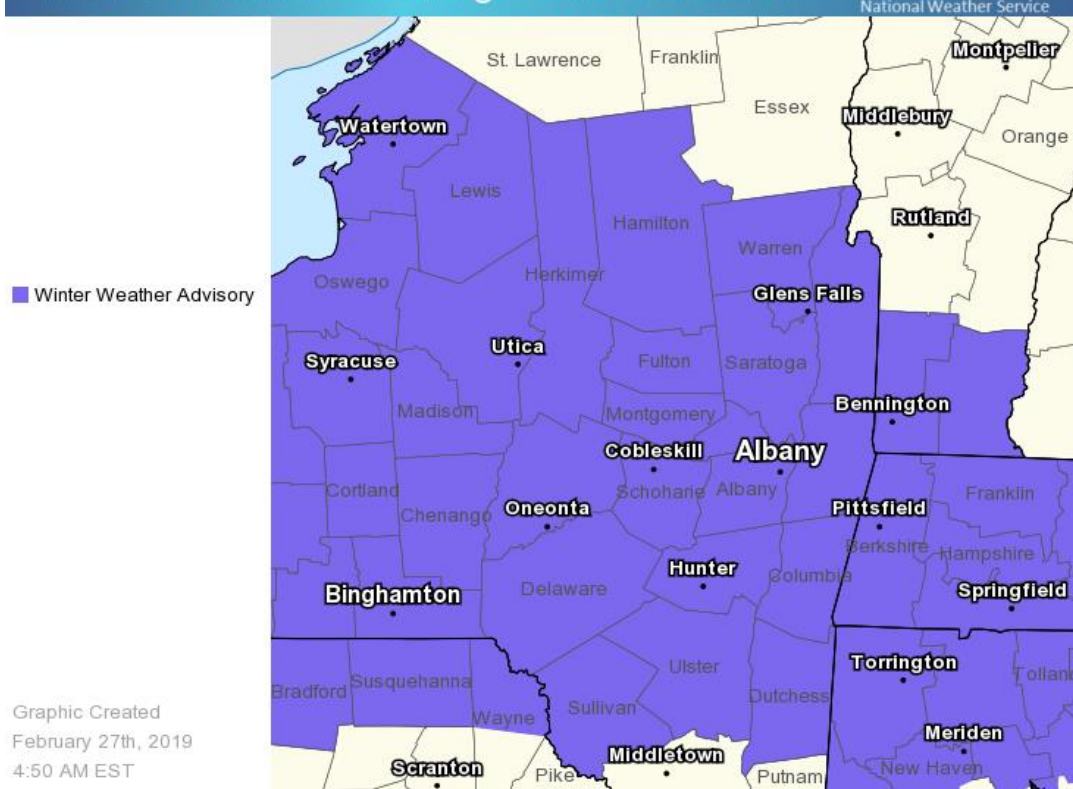

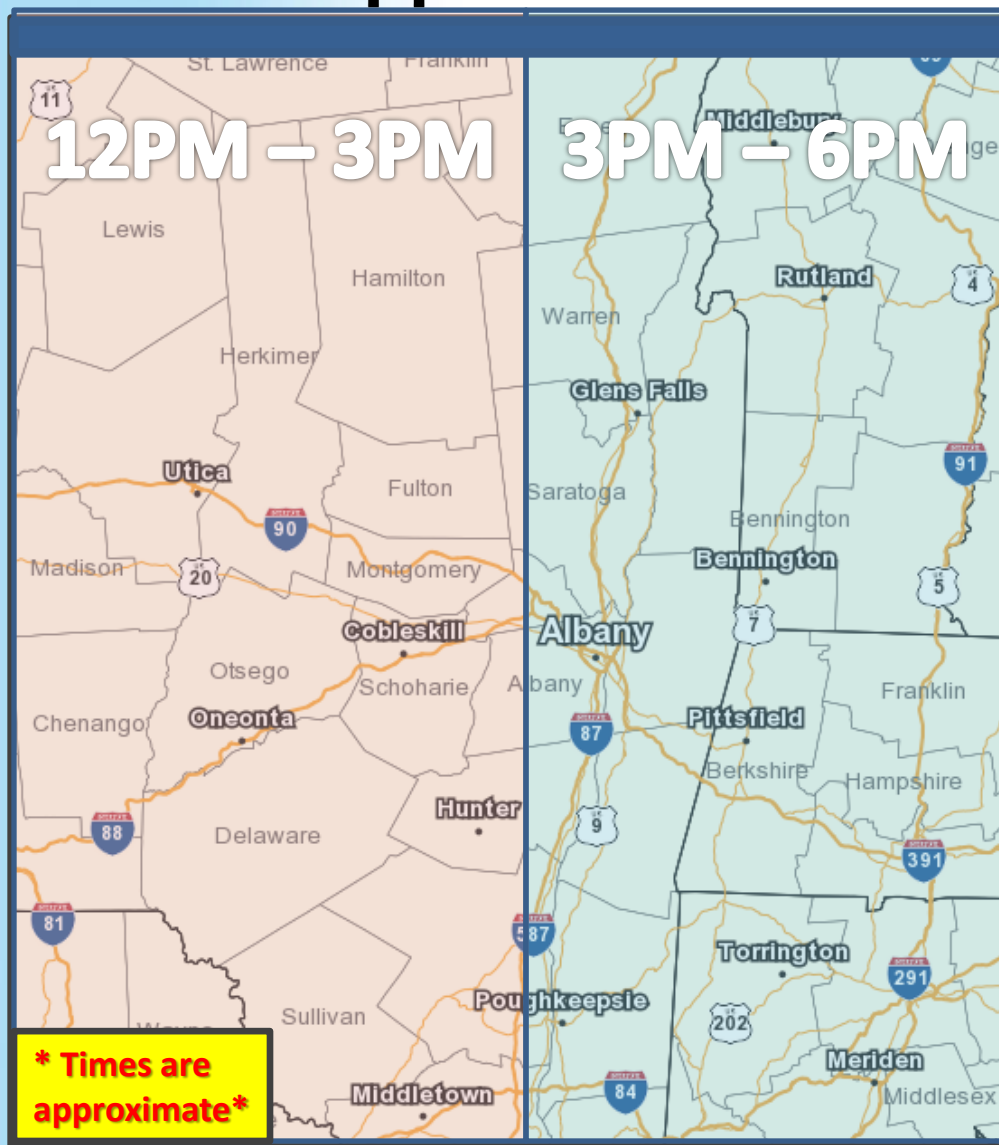
Winter Watches Warnings and Advisories



Main Points

Approximate Onset Times for Snow



Impacts and Timing:

- ✓ Snow *will* likely impact the commute this evening west of the Hudson Valley, and *could* impact the commute this evening along and east of the Hudson Valley into western New England
- ✓ Snow will continue through the overnight hours

Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast – this afternoon through early Thursday morning

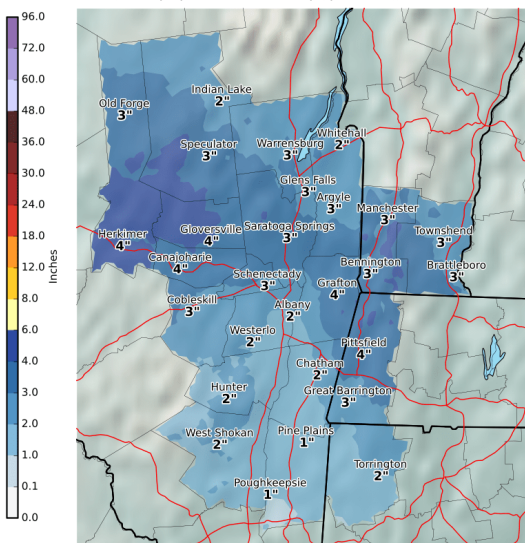

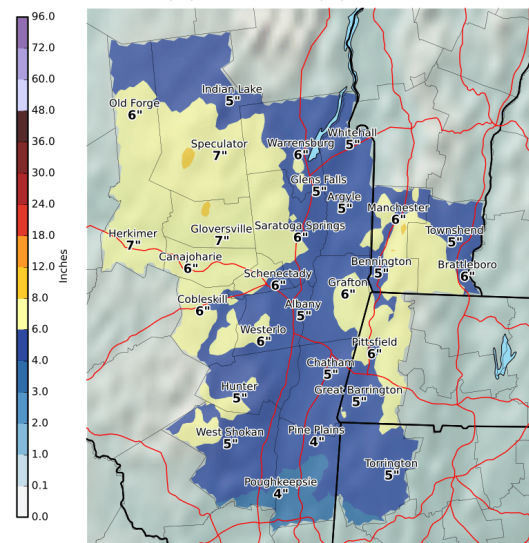

Event Summary

...Light to moderate snowfall accumulation this afternoon and night...

- ✓ Confidence is **HIGH** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: The commute this evening will likely be the time of greatest impact with light-to-moderate snow overspreading the region from west to east beginning this afternoon and continuing through the overnight hours.



Winter Weather Advisory (12PM Today – 6AM Thursday):

- **WHERE:** Mohawk and Schoharie Valleys, Helderbergs, eastern Catskills and western Adirondacks
- **WHAT:** Light-to-moderate snow **will** impact the commute this evening and continue overnight, likely ending before the Thursday morning commute



Winter Weather Advisory (3PM This afternoon – 6AM Thursday):

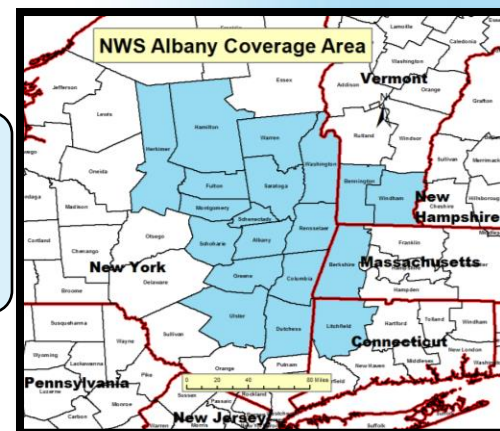
- **WHERE:** Capital and Lake George Saratoga Regions, Taconics, Mid-Hudson Valley, Berkshires, northwest Connecticut and southern Vermont
- **WHAT:** Light-to-moderate snow **could** impact the commute this evening and continue overnight. Some lingering light snow showers are possible through the Thursday morning commute.
