




Light Snow Tonight Through Saturday and Potential Coastal Storm Sunday through Monday

Light Snow	Slippery Road Conditions	Litchfield County CT	Midnight through early Saturday afternoon















Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast – Late tonight through early Saturday afternoon


Main Points – Sunday through Monday

Hazard		Impacts	Location	Timing
	Moderate to heavy snow	Hazardous travel due to snow covered roadways	East central New York, southern Vermont, Berkshires, northwest Connecticut	Late Sunday afternoon through Monday morning





















Low End Snowfall (90% chance of higher amounts) Sunday through Monday














High End Snowfall (10% chance of higher amounts) Sunday through Monday









Event Summary – Tonight through Saturday

...Light snow late tonight through early Saturday afternoon...

Period of greatest impact: Overnight through early Saturday morning



Winter Weather Advisory midnight through 1PM Saturday:

- ➤ WHERE: Litchfield County in Connecticut
- WHAT: Light snow. Slippery road conditions are expected.

Event Summary – Late Sunday through Monday

... Moderate to heavy snow possible late Sunday through Monday morning...

- Period of greatest impact: Late Sunday through Monday morning
 - > WHERE: East-central New York, southern Vermont, Berkshires, NW Connecticut



- > WHAT: Moderate to heavy snow possible. Snowfall rates could exceed 1 inch per hour at some locations, but it is too early to determine exactly where. There is potential for 7 or more inches across much of the region, but confidence is not high enough to issue a Winter Storm Watch yet.
- > CONFIDENCE: Moderate that snow will occur, and low on snow amounts. There is a large range of possible outcomes with respect to snow amounts, but at least some snow is expected to fall.
