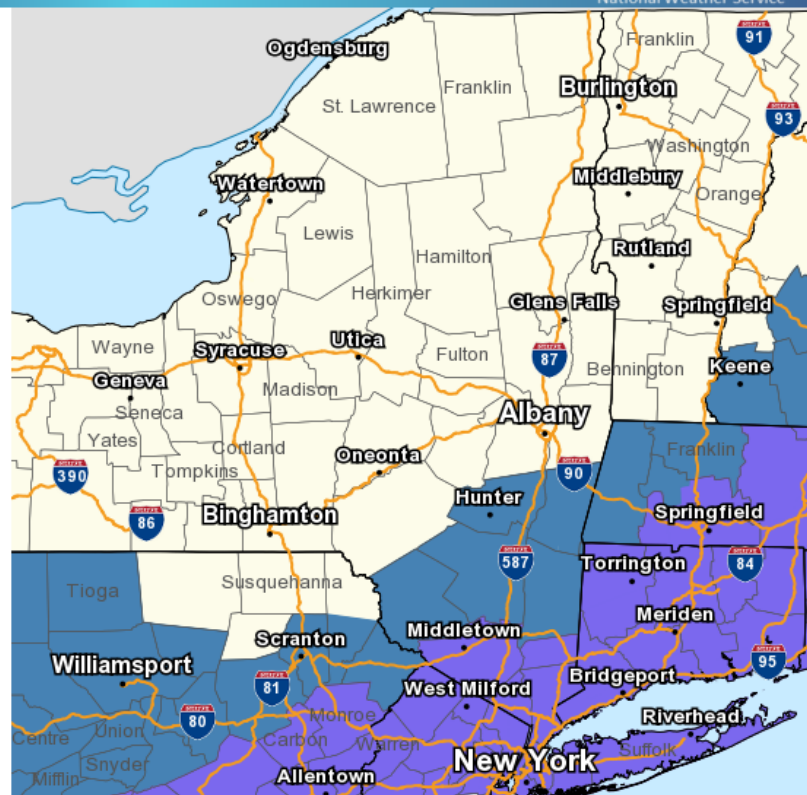

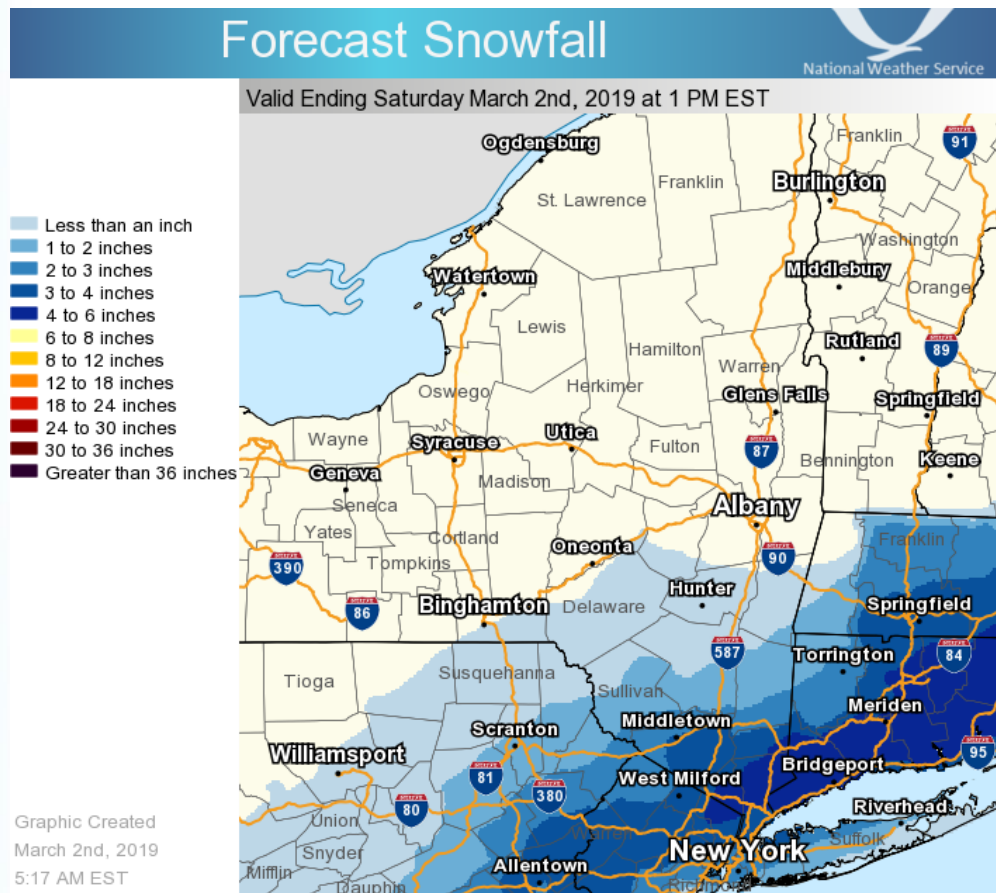

Expected total snowfall through this morning

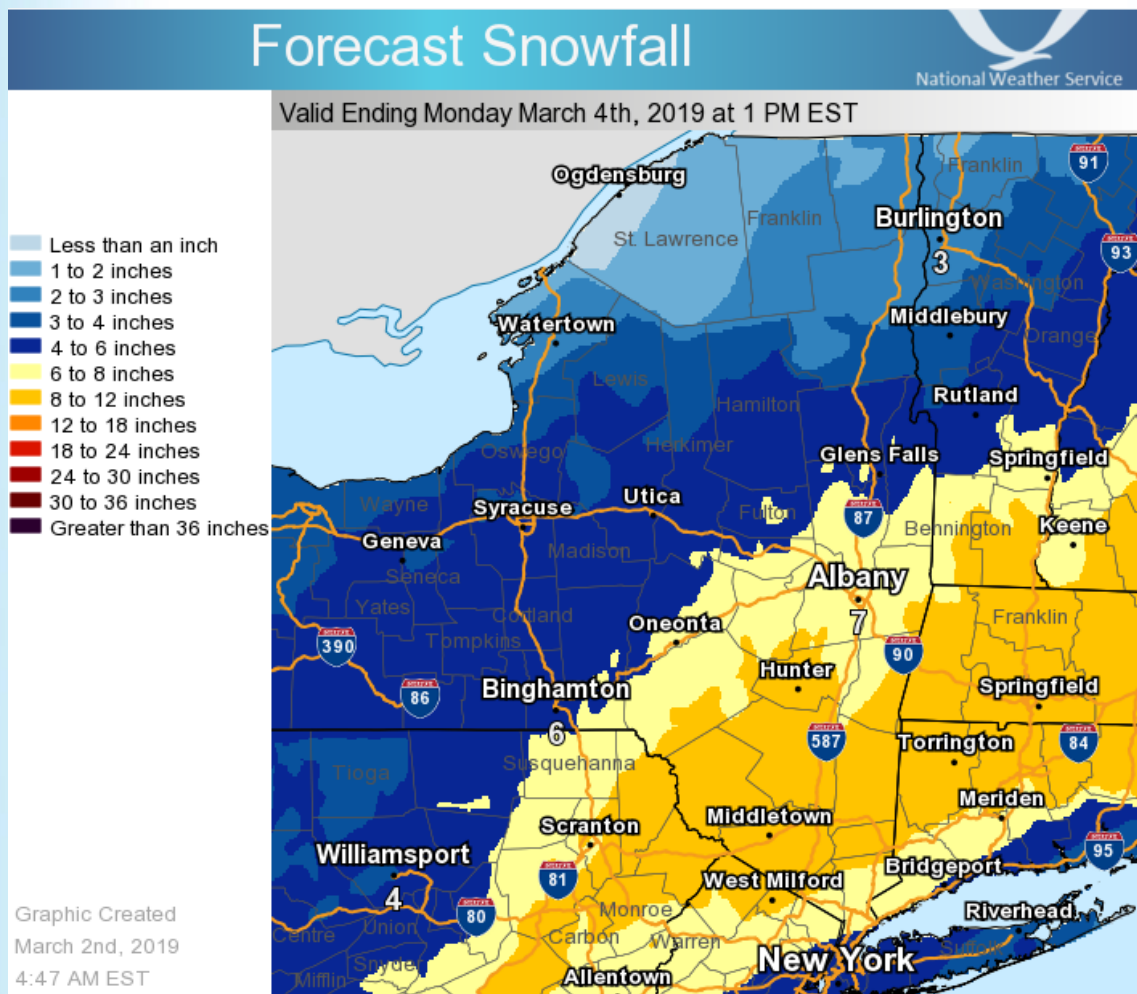

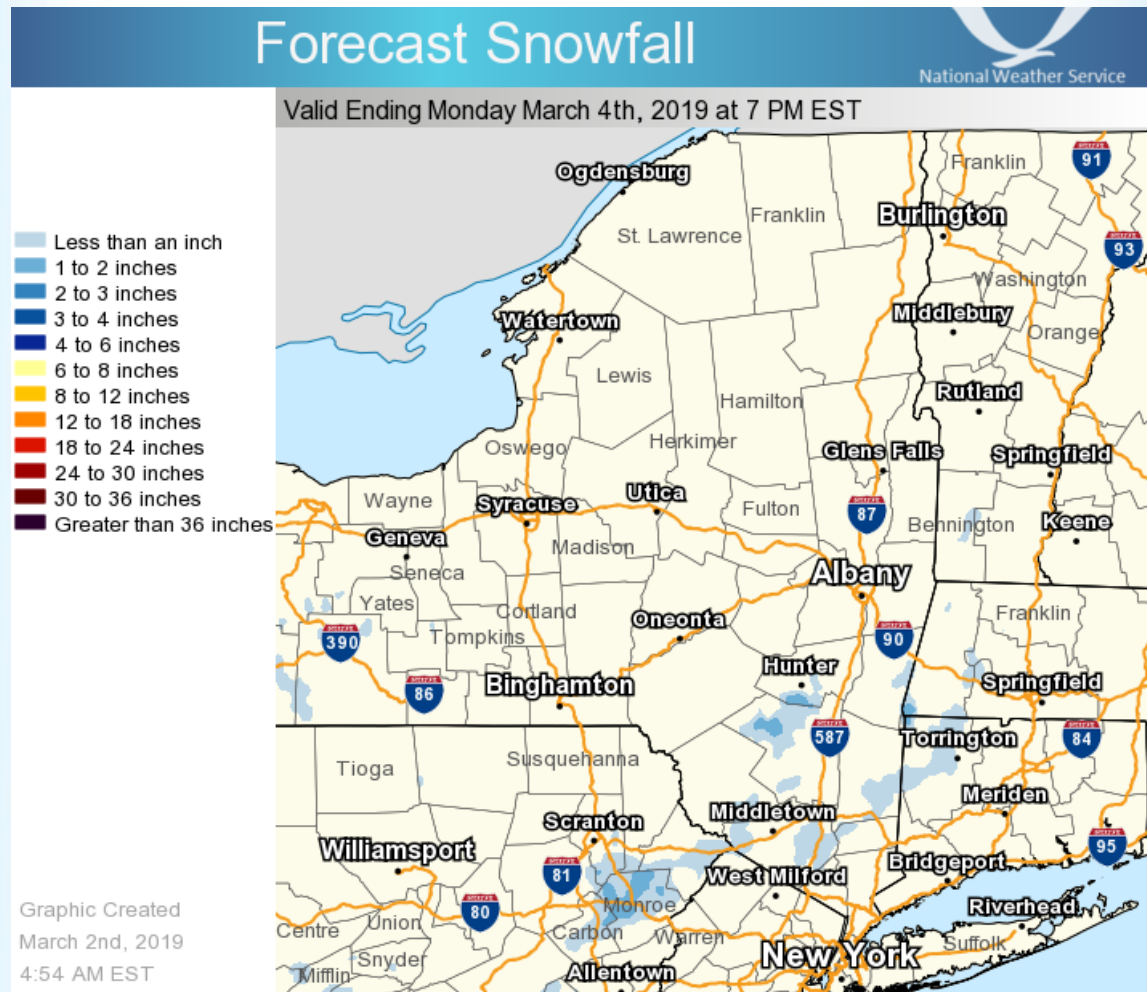
Main Points – Sunday Afternoon through Monday

 Heavy snow possible	Hazardous travel due to snow covered roadways	Litchfield County CT, mid-Hudson Valley, eastern Catskills and Berkshires	Late Sunday afternoon through Monday morning

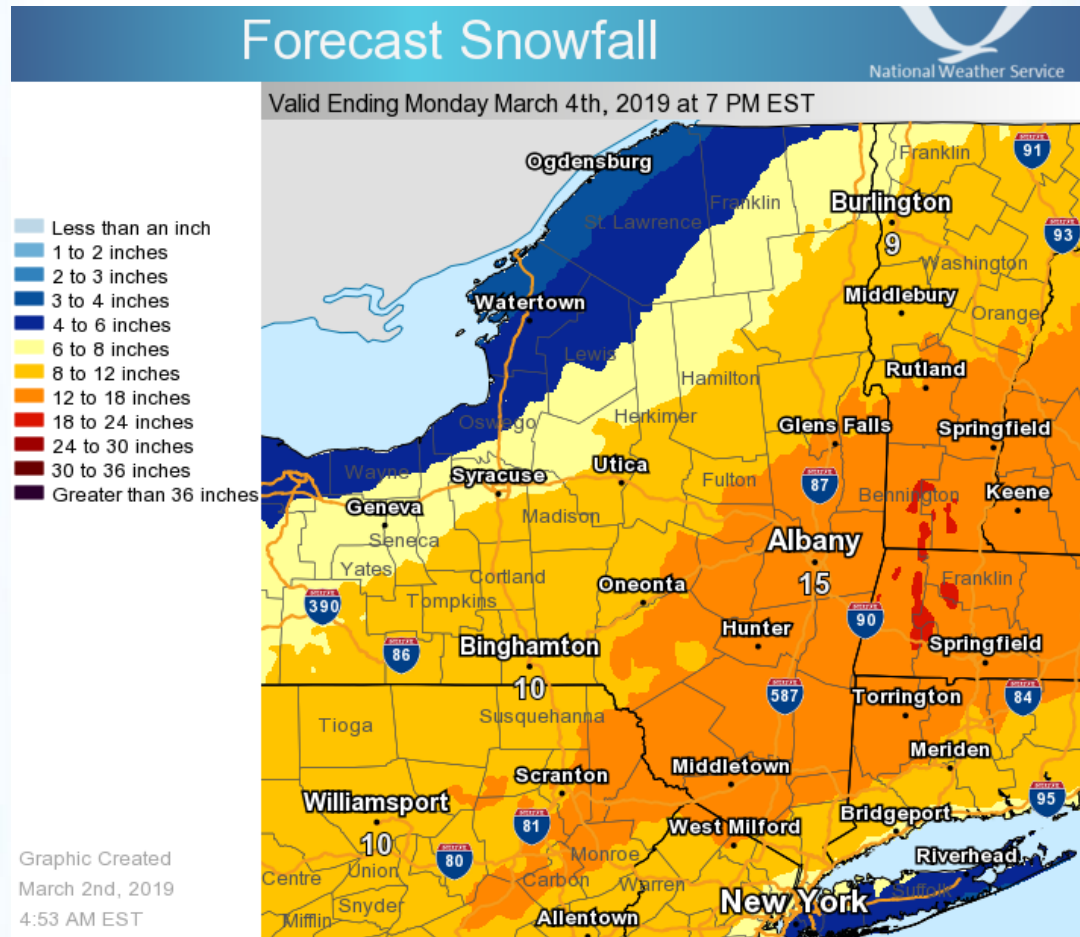
Snowfall late Sunday afternoon through Monday morning

High End Snowfall (10% chance of higher amounts) – Sunday through Monday



Event Summary – This morning

...Light snow this morning...

- ✓ Period of greatest impact: This morning through 1 PM.

Winter Weather Advisory through 1PM Saturday:



- **WHERE:** Litchfield County in Connecticut
- **WHAT:** Light snow. Slippery road conditions are expected.

Event Summary – Late Sunday through Monday

...Heavy snow possible late Sunday through Monday morning...

- ✓ Period of greatest impact: Sunday night through Monday morning

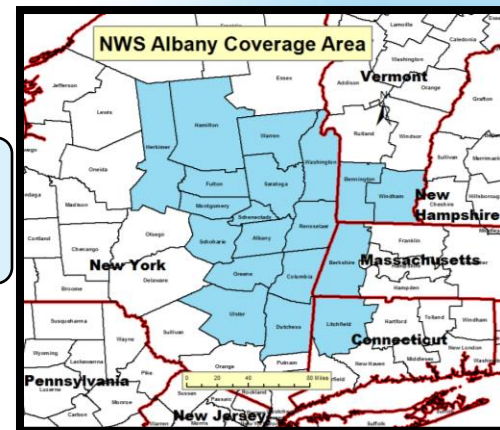


- **WHERE:** NW Connecticut, the mid-Hudson Valley, eastern Catskills and Berkshires
- **WHAT:** Heavy snow possible. Snowfall rates could exceed 1 inch per hour at some locations. There is potential for 7 or more inches across the region.
- **CONFIDENCE:** **High** that snow will occur, and **moderate** on snow amounts. There is still a fairly large range of possible outcomes with respect to snow amounts, but at least some snow is expected to fall.
