Hazard		Impacts	Location	Timing
Moderate Snow	**	Hazardous travel due to snow covered roadways, impacting the Monday morning commute	Litchfield County CT, mid-Hudson Valley, eastern Catskills, southern/central Taconics, and Berkshires	Late this afternoon through early Monday morning
Light Snow	**	Slippery driving due to snow covered roadways, impacting the Monday morning commute	Southern Adirondacks, Lake George - Saratoga Region, southern Vermont, Mohawk Valley, Schoharie Valley, Capital District and northern Taconics	Late this afternoon through early Monday morning












Most likely time of winter precipitation onset









Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast

High End Amount








Low End Amount



Event Summary



- >WHAT: Moderate snow expected (3-8 inches). Snowfall rates could reach 1 inch per hour at some locations. Snow density 10-12:1.
- >WHERE: NW Connecticut, the mid-Hudson Valley, eastern Catskills, southern/central Taconics, and Berkshires.

Lighter snow expected elsewhere (1-4 inches)

- **WHEN**: Late this afternoon to early Monday morning, impacting the Monday morning commute.
- >CONFIDENCE: High that snow will occur, and high on snow amounts.

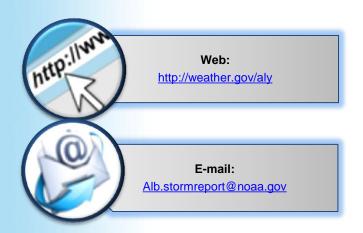
