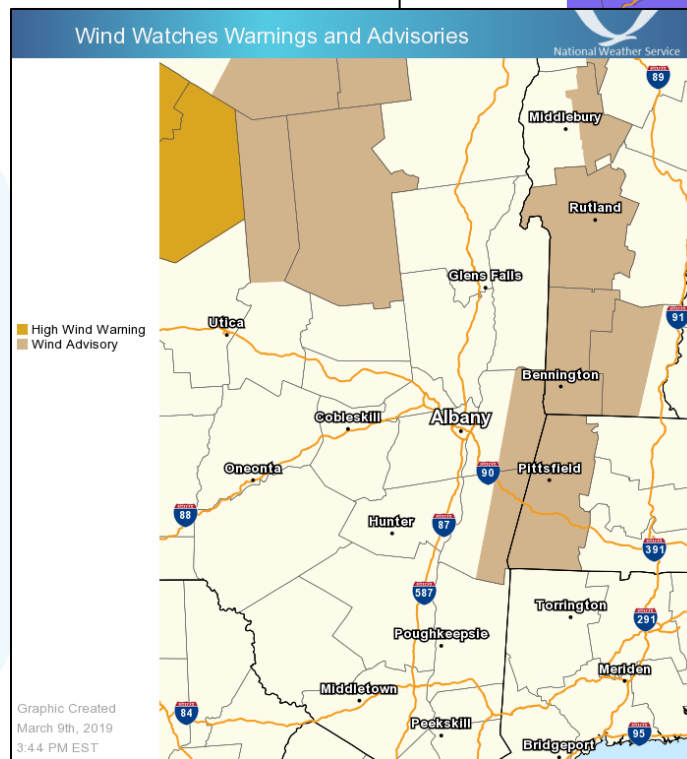
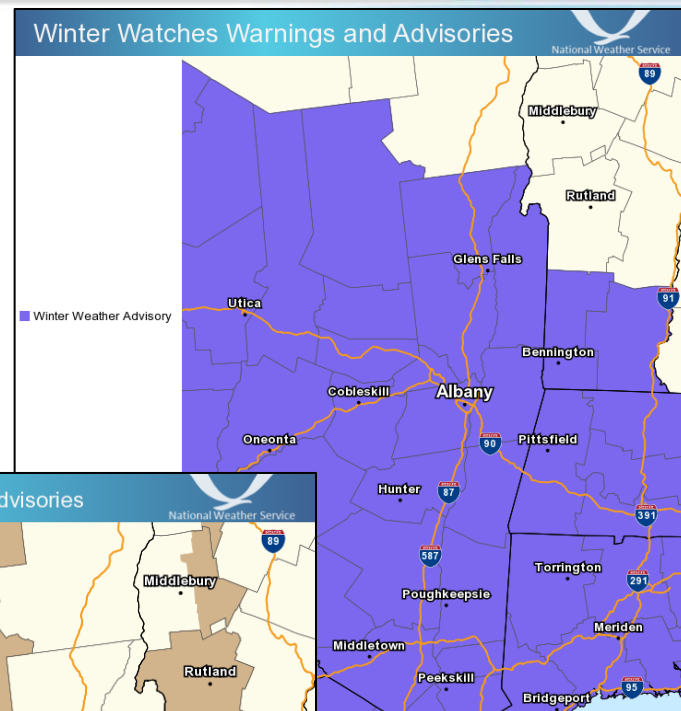


Light Wintry Mix and High Terrain Strong Winds Late Tonight into Sunday

What Has Changed?

- ✓ *Winter Weather Advisory expanded to all of eastern New York and western New England for late tonight into Sunday*
- ✓ *Wind Advisory issued for the western Adirondacks, southern Greens, Berkshires, and northern/central Taconics Sunday morning and afternoon*



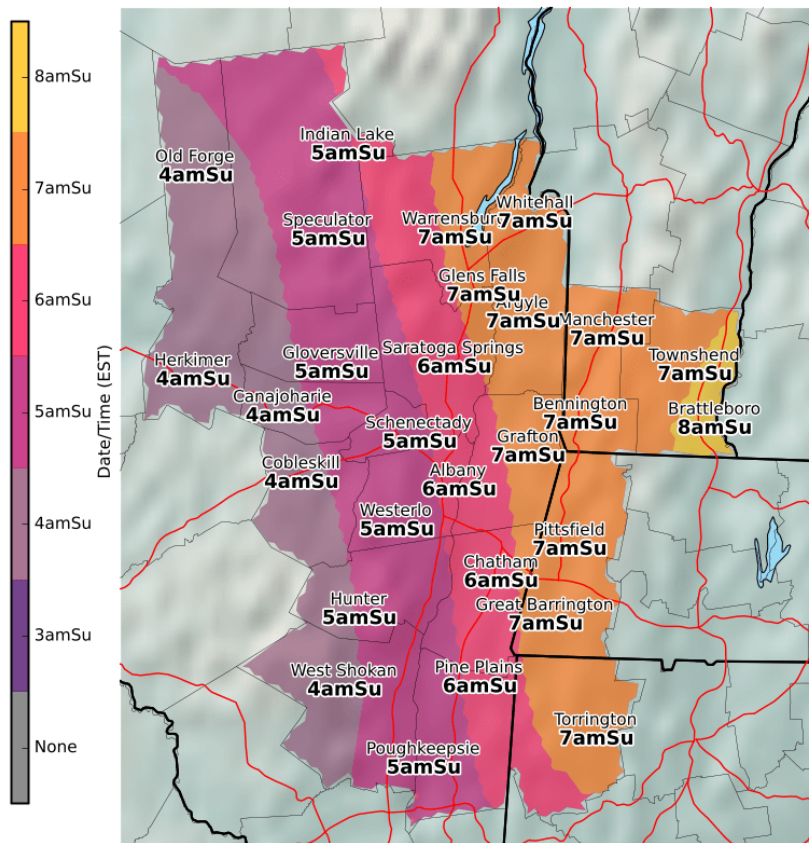

Light Snow→ Sleet/Freezing Rain  	Hazardous travel due to light snow and ice	Capital District, Helderbergs, Schoharie Valley, eastern Catskills, Mid Hudson Valley, Taconics, Litchfield County, and the southern Berkshires	4 am to 1 pm Sunday
Light Snow→ Sleet/Freezing Rain  	Hazardous travel due to light snow and ice	Southern Vermont and the southern Adirondacks, Mohawk Valley, Lake George Saratoga Region, and northern Berkshires	4 am to 5 pm Sunday
Wind 	Downed trees, large limbs, and powerlines leading to isolated power outages	Western Adirondacks, northern and central Taconics, southern Green Mountains, and Berkshires	6 am to 4 pm Sunday

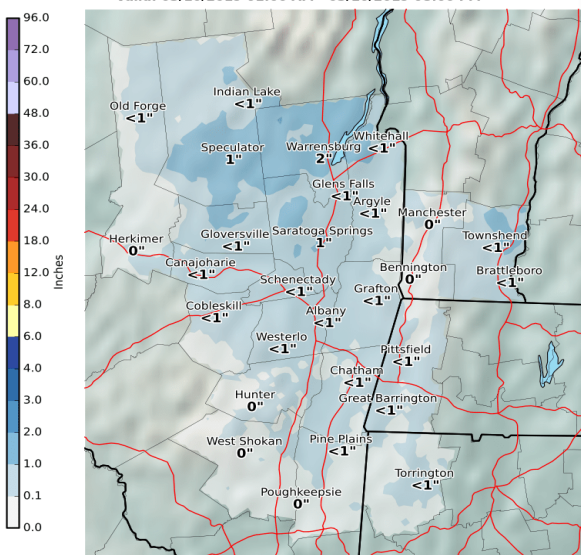


Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast

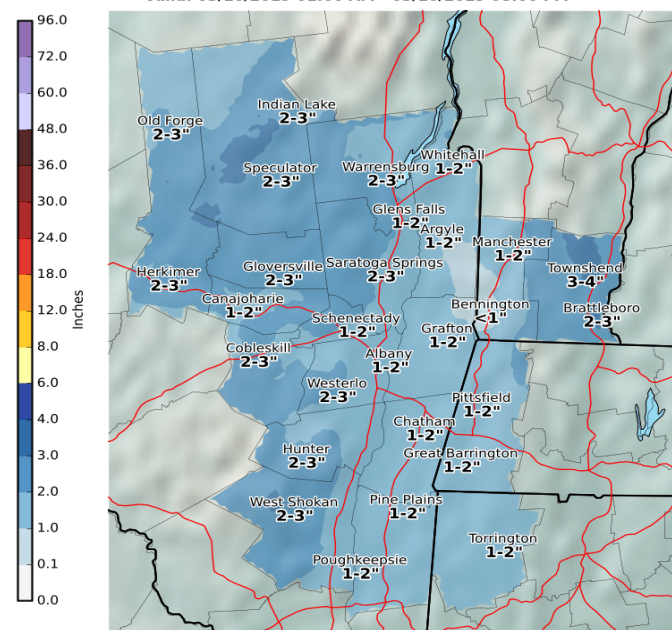

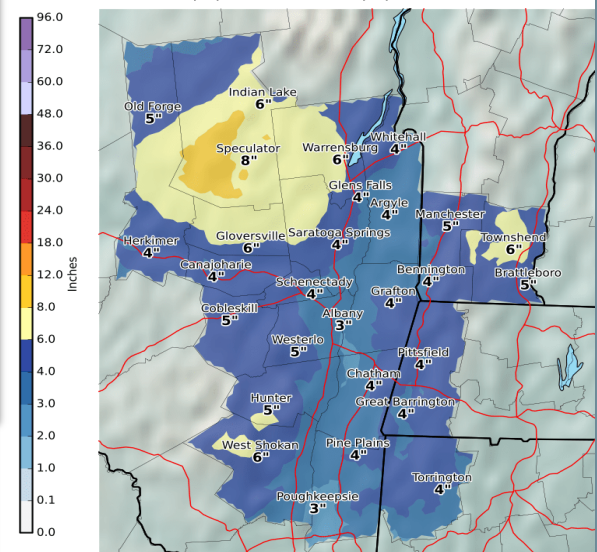
Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast

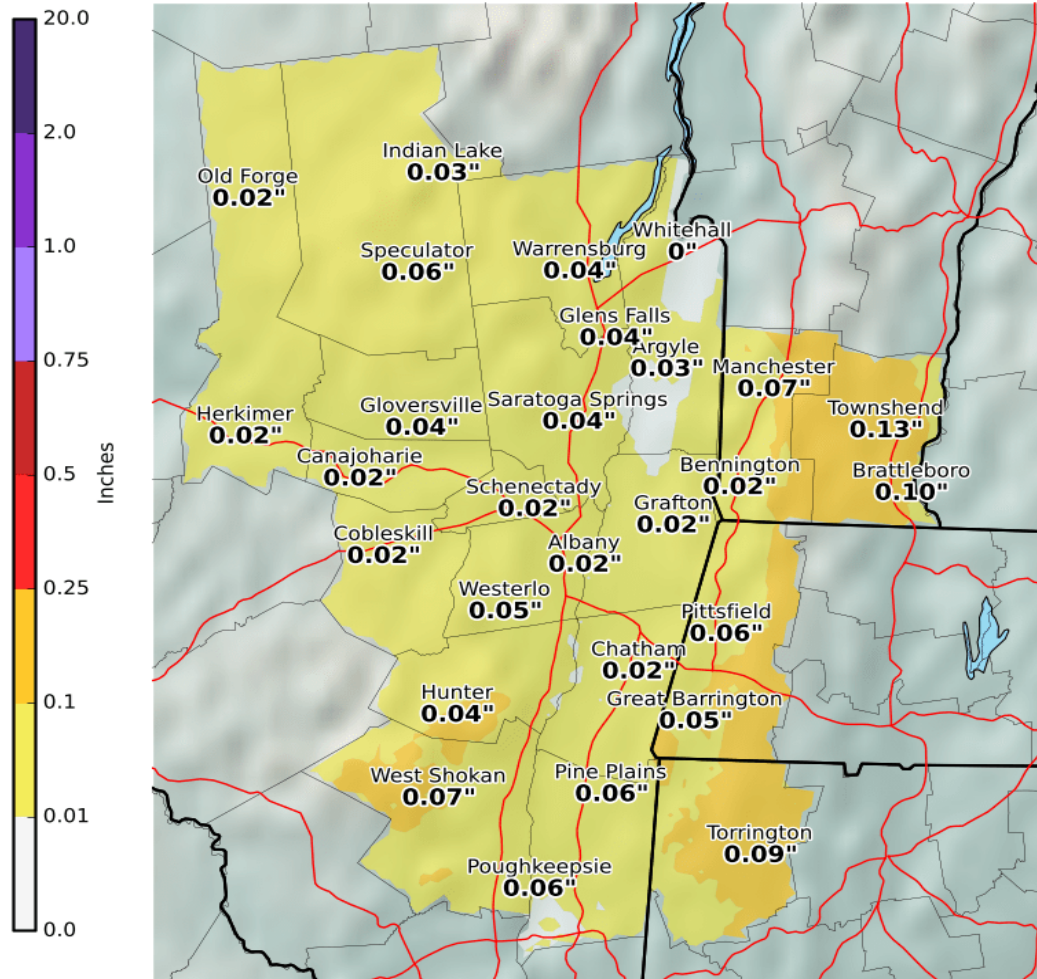

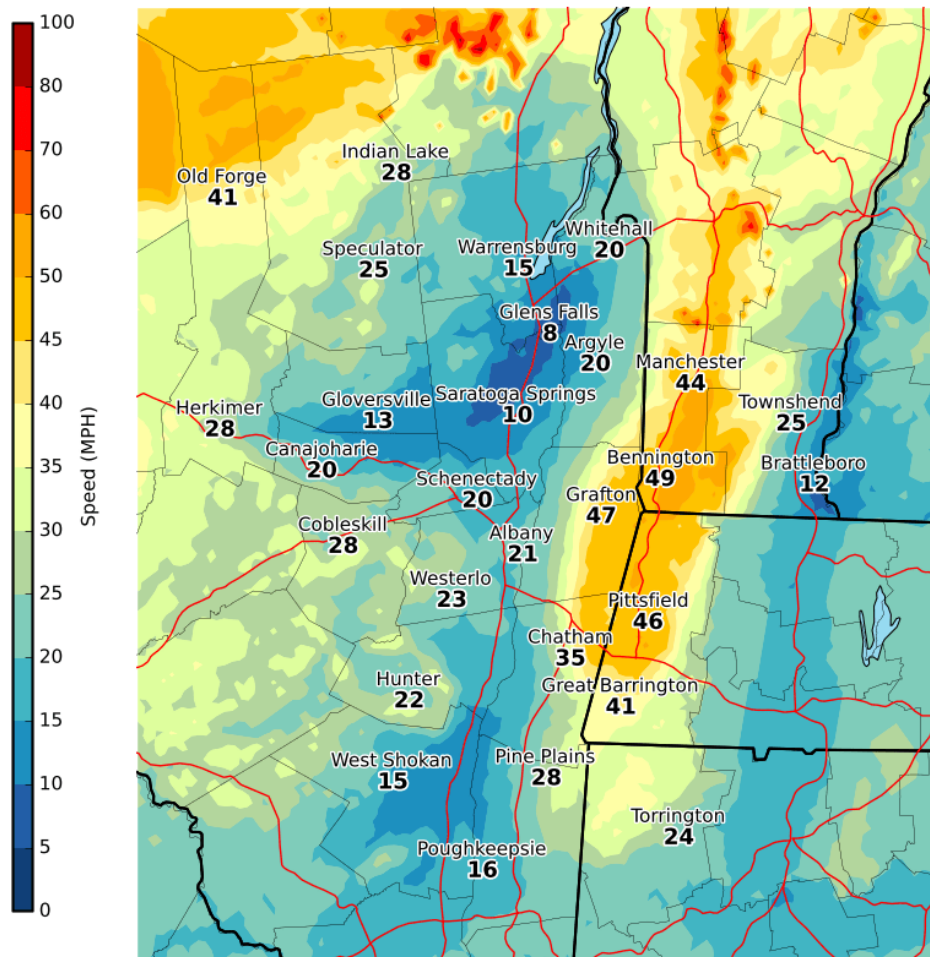

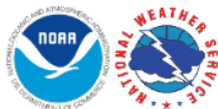
Peak Wind Gusts

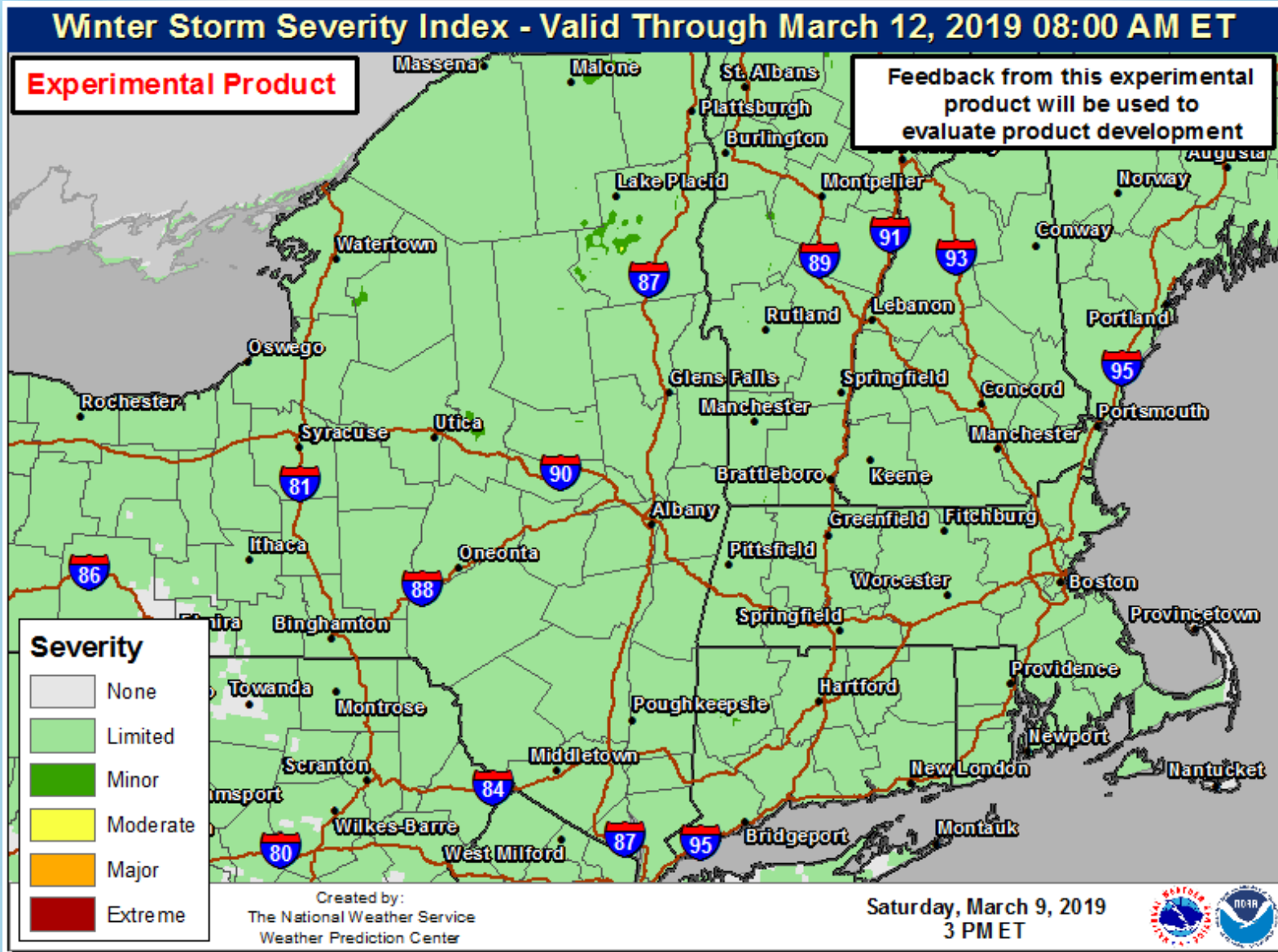

Event Summary – Late Tonight into Sunday

Winter Weather Advisory in Effect 4am to 1pm EDT Sunday:



- **WHERE:** Capital District, Helderbergs, Schoharie Valley, eastern Catskills, Mid Hudson Valley, Taconics, Litchfield County, and the southern Berkshires.
- **WHAT:** Light snow of 1–3 inches and a light glaze to a tenth of an inch of ice leading to hazardous travel conditions. The higher end of the range of snow and ice totals will be over the eastern Catskills and higher terrain of western New England.

Winter Weather Advisory in Effect 4am to 5pm EDT Sunday:



- **WHERE:** Southern Vermont and the southern Adirondacks, Mohawk Valley, Lake George Saratoga Region, and northern Berkshires
- **WHAT:** Light snow of 1–3 inches and a light glaze to a tenth of an inch of ice leading to hazardous travel conditions.

Wind Advisory in Effect 6am to 4pm EDT Sunday:



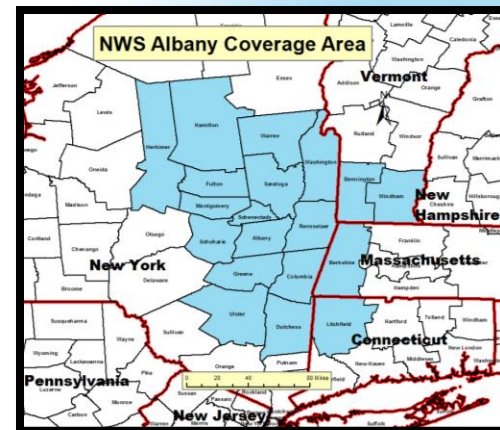
- **WHERE:** Western Adirondacks, northern and central Taconics, southern Green Mountains, and Berkshires
- **WHAT:** Southeast winds gusting to 50 mph could result in downed trees, large limbs, and powerlines and lead to isolated power outages
