




Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast


- ✓ Northwest winds begin to increase tonight.

Event Summary

ONAL WEATHER SERVICE

Winter Storm Warnings and Advisories Remain in effect to noon Saturday:



- WHERE: Warnings Southern Adirondacks, Eastern Catskills, Helderbergs, western Mohawk Valley, northern Taconics, Southern Green Mountains, and the Northern Berkshires Advisories: Central and eastern Mohawk Valley, Greater Capital Region, Lake George Saratoga Region, central Taconics, southern Berkshires, and the northern Litchfield Hills.
- WHAT: Heavy, wet snow will continue over the warning area tonight into Saturday morning, with snowfall rates up to an inch per hour possible. In the advisory area, rain will change back to snow this evening with additional wet snow accumulations possible.
- Warning Areas: An additional 2-6 inches with locally higher amounts of wet snow possible resulting in hazardous travel including during the evening commute.
- Advisory Areas: An additional 1-3 inches of wet snow tonight resulting in hazardous travel during the evening commute.
