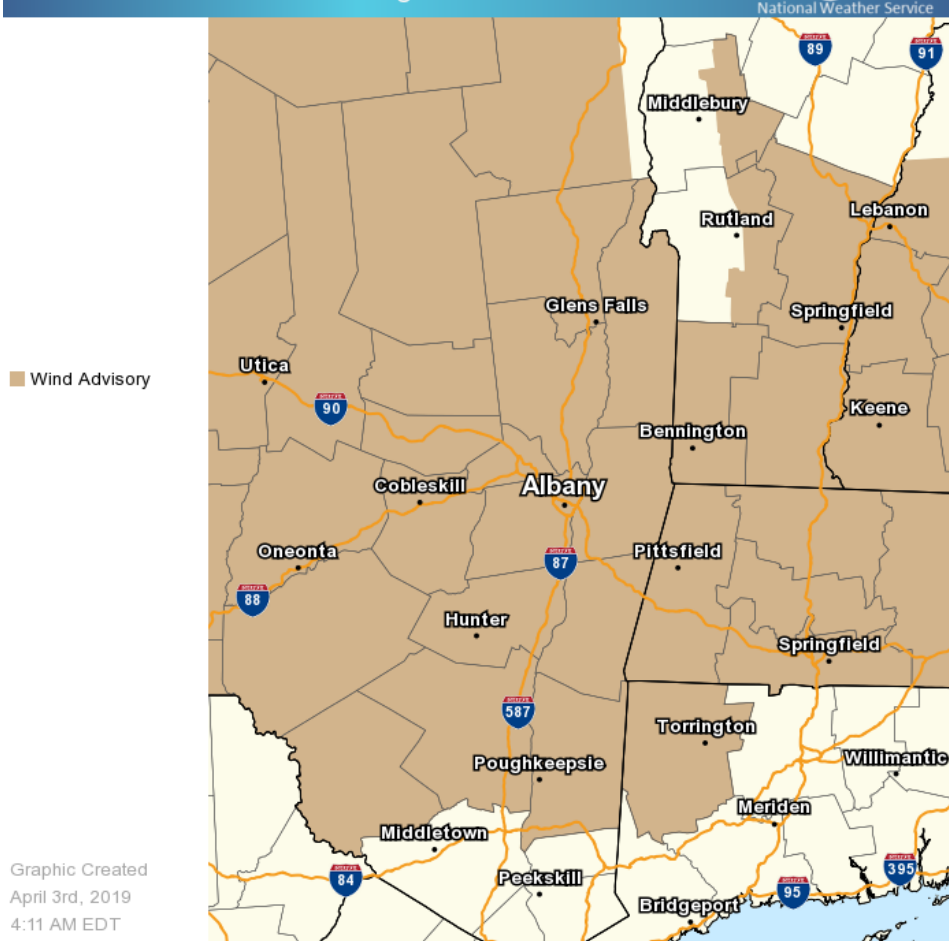

Wind Watches Warnings and Advisories

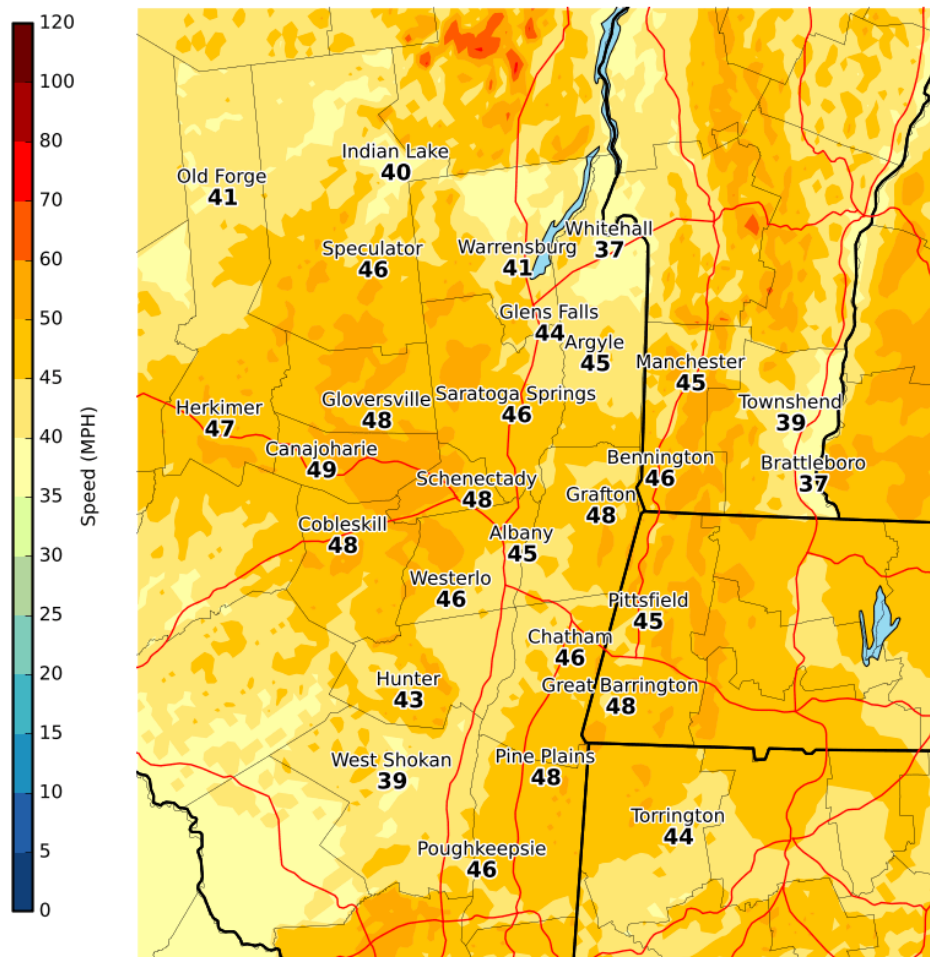


Main Points

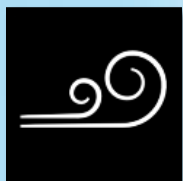

Event Summary

Wind Advisory in effect 2–10pm today:



- **WHERE:** All of eastern New York and western New England
- **WHAT:** Westerly winds will increase rapidly this afternoon, becoming westerly at 15 to 30 mph with gusts up to 55 mph. The wind could result in downed large tree limbs, some trees, and power lines leading to isolated to scattered power outages. Travel could be difficult for high profile vehicles.
- **CONFIDENCE:** High



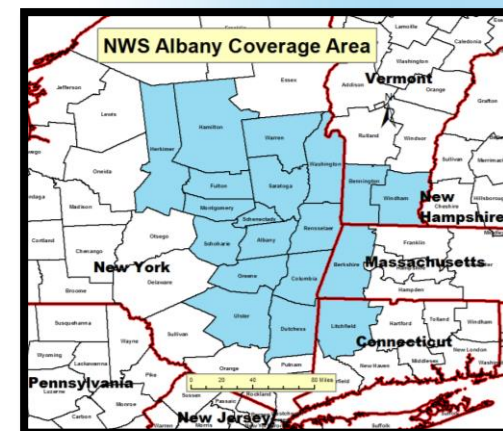
