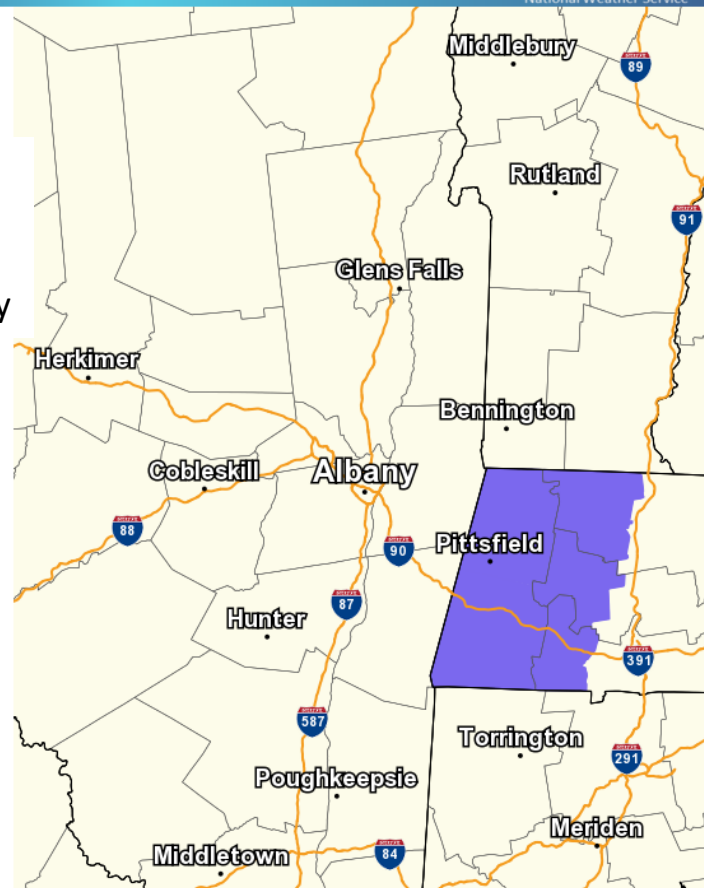

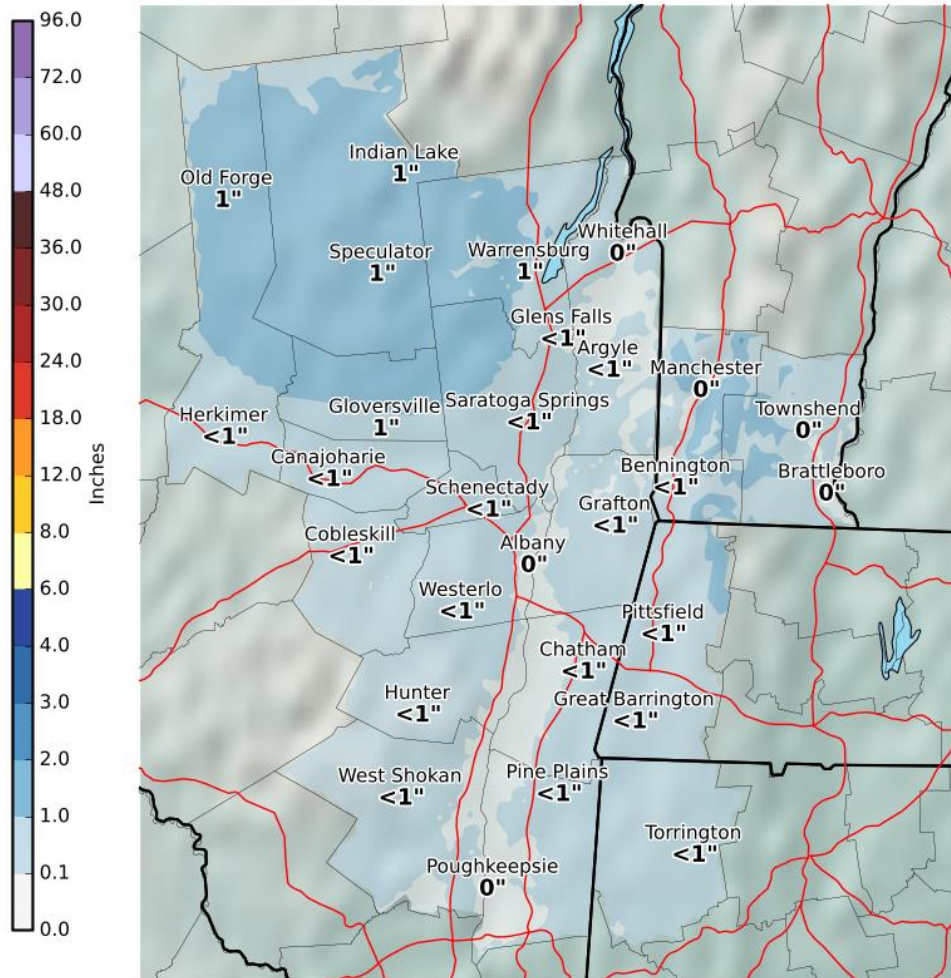

Timing

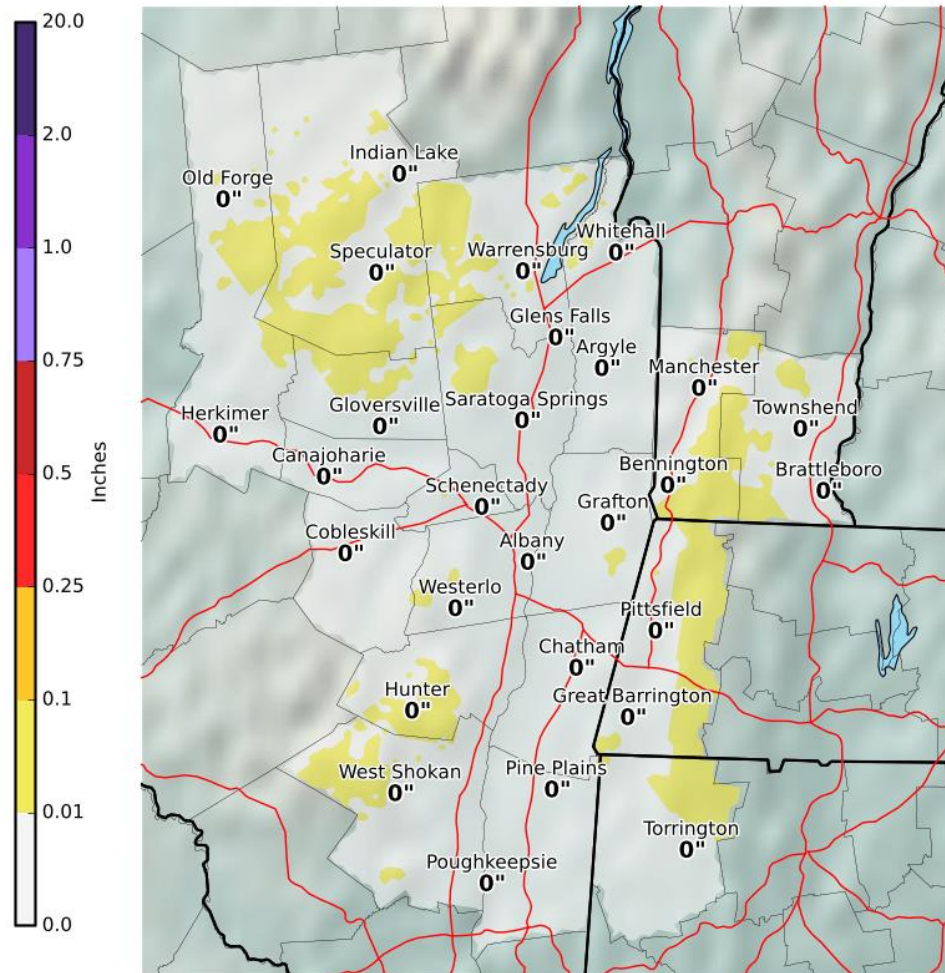
- Into this evening

Impacts

- Slippery spots where snow does accumulate on roadways and other surfaces
- Less than an inch mainly on grassy surfaces
- Locally up to around 2 inches across the southern Adirondacks and southern Green Mountains

Timing

- Freezing rain will become likely across the Berkshires mainly above 1500 feet this evening and continuing into the overnight hours

- Slippery travel conditions
- Light glaze of ice

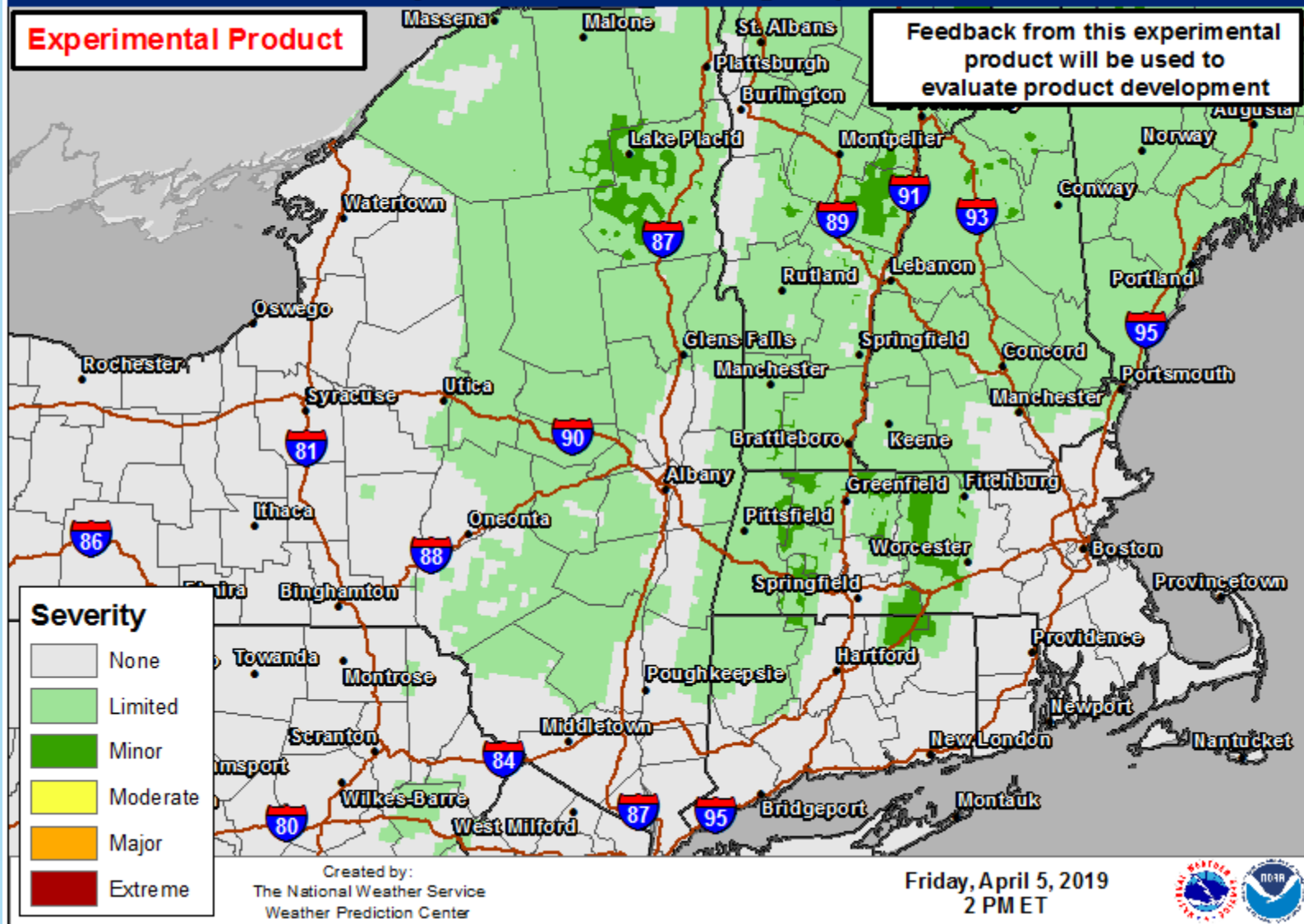

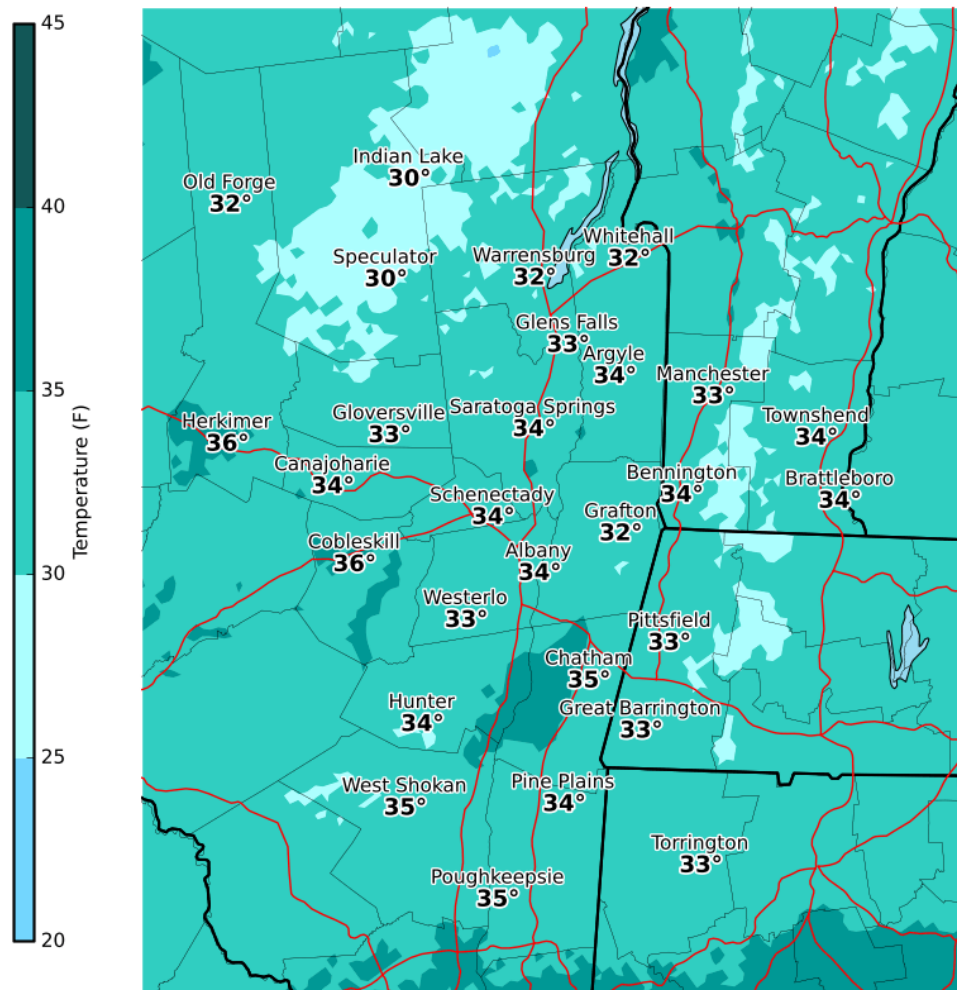
Winter Storm Severity Index - Valid Through April 08, 2019 08:00 AM ET

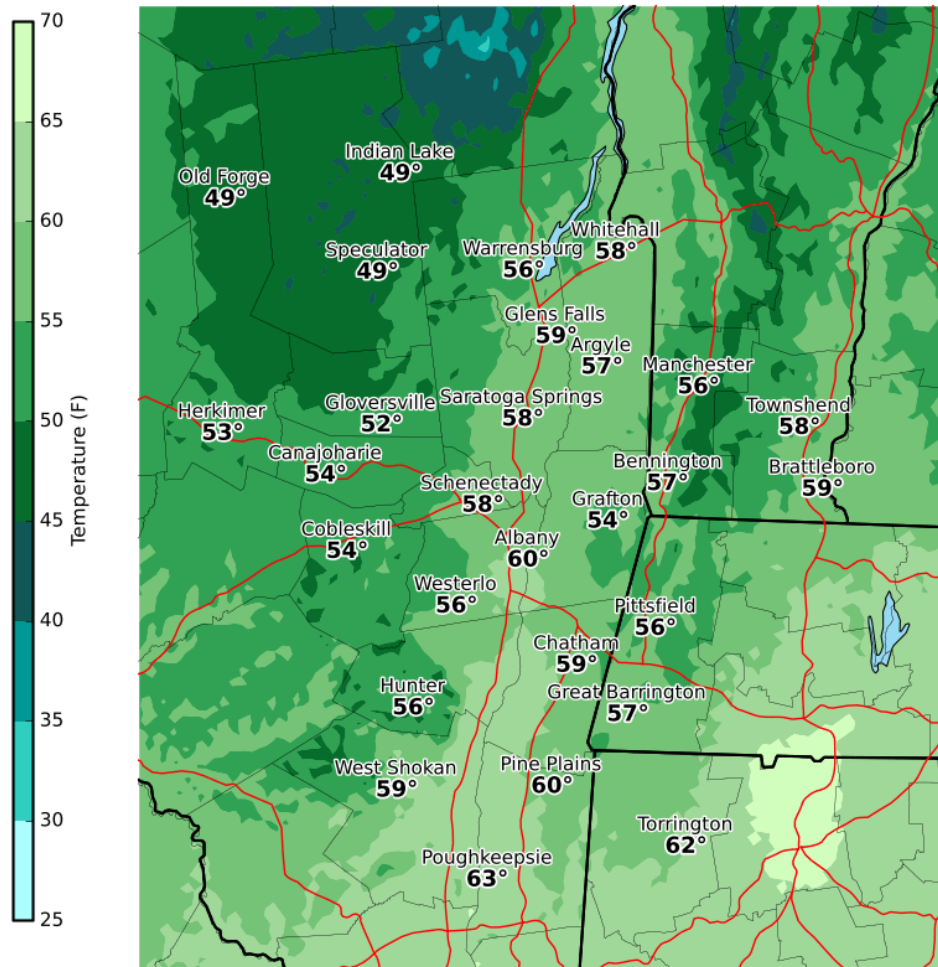
Low Temperatures Tonight

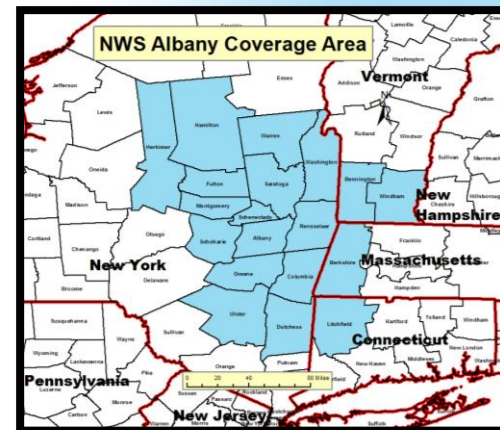
