

River Flooding	Runoff from snowmelt and forecast rainfall will result in significant rises and possible flooding	Upper Hudson River, Sacandaga River, Black River, Mohawk River, Hoosic River, Deerfield River, West River and tributaries	Late Sunday night through Tuesday.
Flooding	Urban, low lying and poor drainage flooding is possible	All of eastern New York and western New England	Late Sunday night through Monday morning.
Rainfall	Forecast rainfall amounts of 1-2"	All of eastern New York and western New England	Late Sunday night through Monday morning.
















Forecast Rainfall Amounts



Excessive Rainfall Outlook

Locally heavy downpours possible Sunday Night into early Monday morning which may cause localized urban & poor drainage flooding

Event Summary

- Confidence is MODERATE that this event will occur and MODERATE on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: Late Sunday night through Tuesday morning



Flood Watch Area: Runoff from snowmelt and forecast rainfall will result in significant rises on river and streams with possible flooding. River crests expected late Monday into Tuesday



Urban, low lying and poor drainage flooding is possible Sunday Night into early Monday morning (for all areas)



Forecast rainfall amounts of 1-2"
