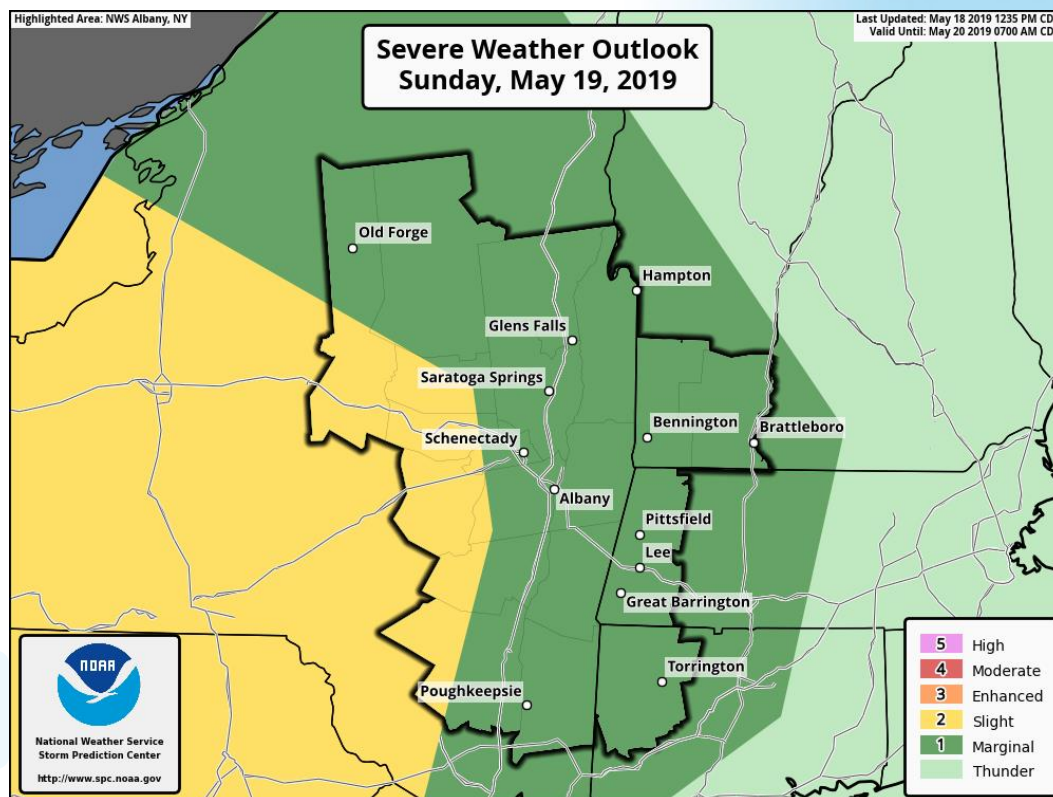


# Thunderstorms Likely Sunday into Monday – Some Could be Severe

What Has Changed?  
✓ First briefing

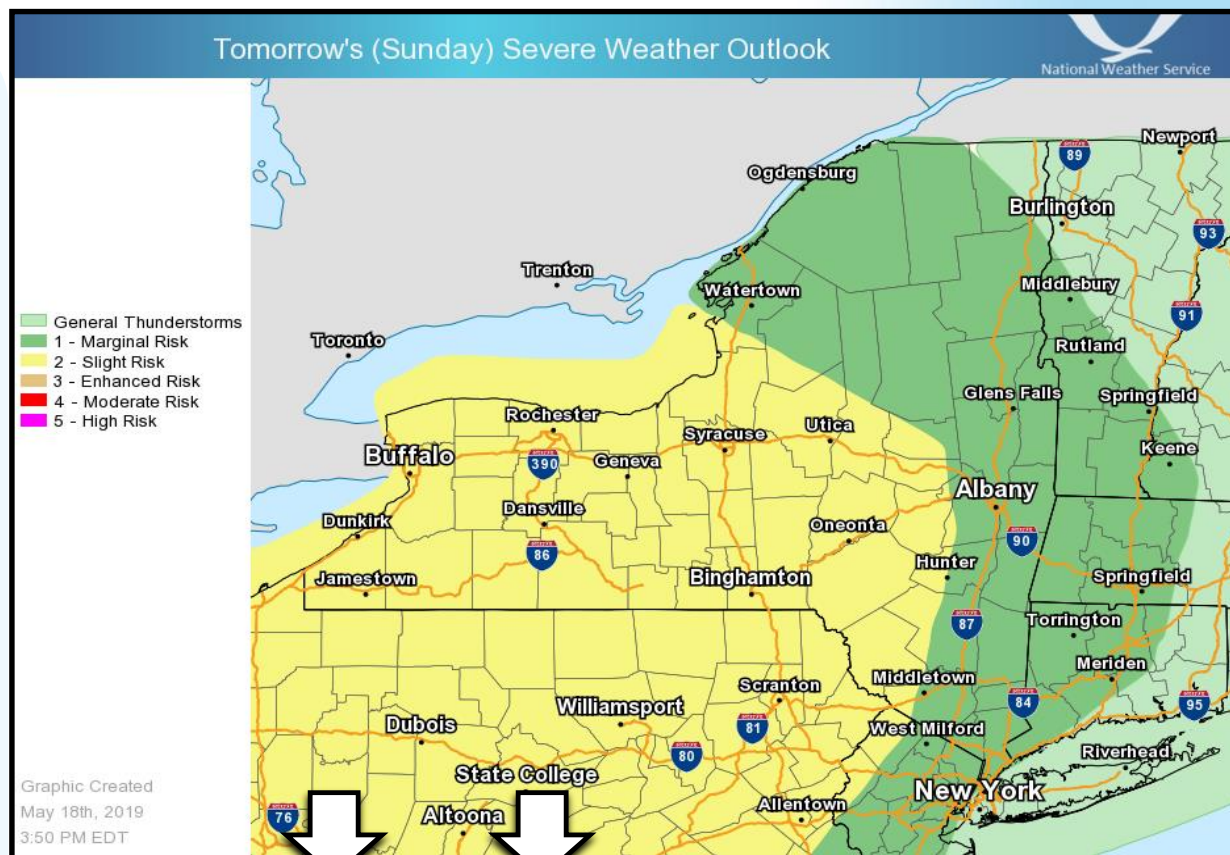


## Timing:

- ✓ Chance of storms late tonight into Sunday morning (not severe).
- ✓ Additional storms possible Sunday afternoon and evening. Some could be strong to severe.

## Impacts:

- ✓ Damaging straight-line winds to 60 mph

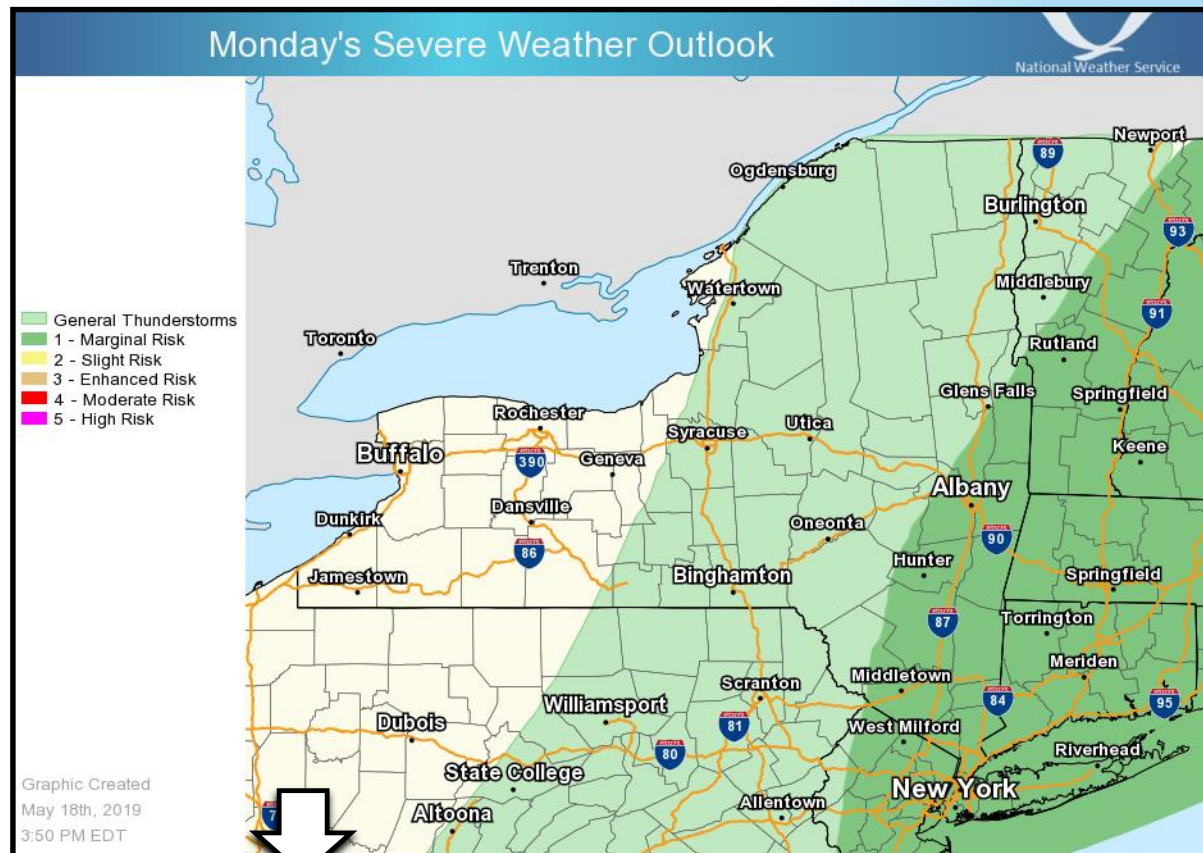


## Timing:

- ✓ Periods of showers and thunderstorms continue Sunday night into Monday.
- ✓ Isolated severe storms are possible Monday afternoon and evening.

## Impacts:

- ✓ Damaging straight-line winds to 60 mph

# Event Summary

## **A Few Rounds of Storms Sunday into Monday, Some Could be Severe**

✓ Confidence is low in terms of timing, location, and severity

- There is a chance of thunderstorms after 2 am tonight into Sunday mid-morning. These storms are not expected to be severe.
- Additional storms may redevelop Sunday afternoon into the evening. Some of these storms could be strong to severe, especially west of the Hudson River. The main threat is damaging wind to 60 mph.
- Periods of showers and thunderstorms will continue Sunday night into Monday. Isolated severe storms are possible Monday. The main threat will be damaging winds to 60 mph.
