

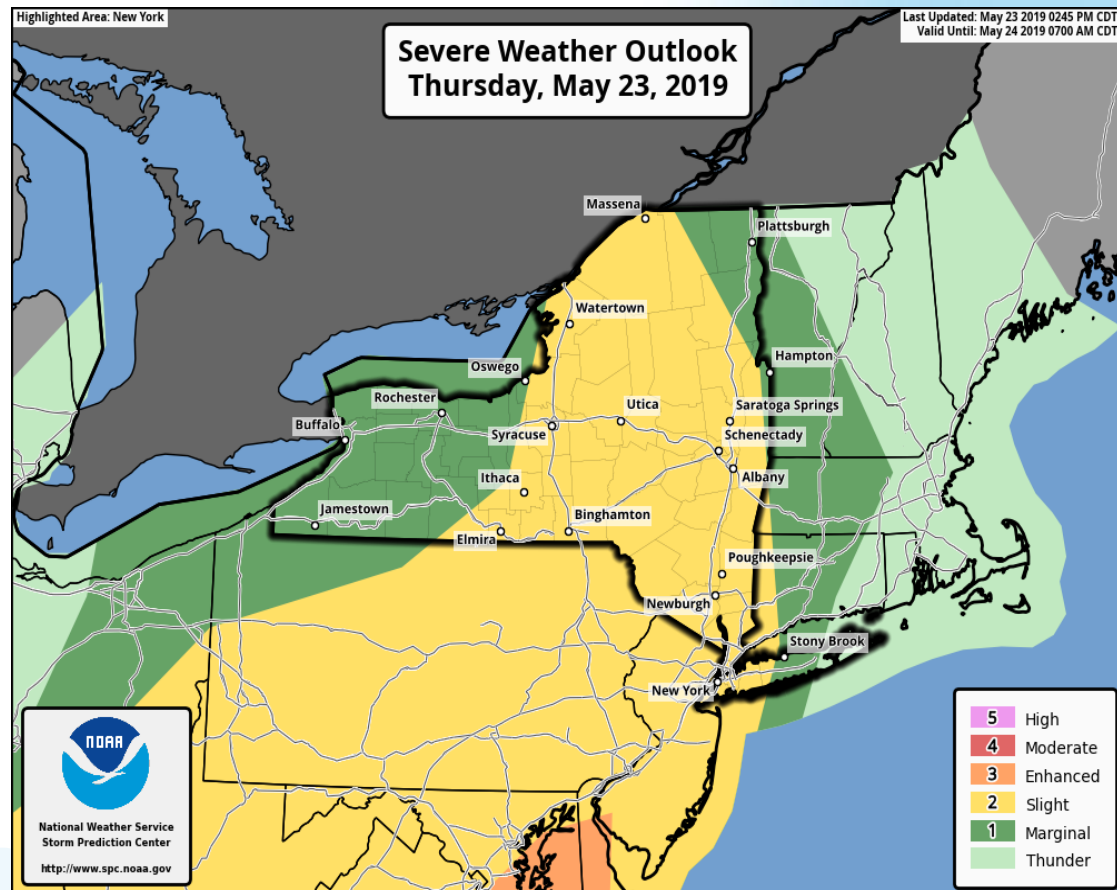
Severe Weather Possible This Evening

What Has Changed?

- ✓ Confidence for any severe weather has shifted later this evening between 8PM and 11PM



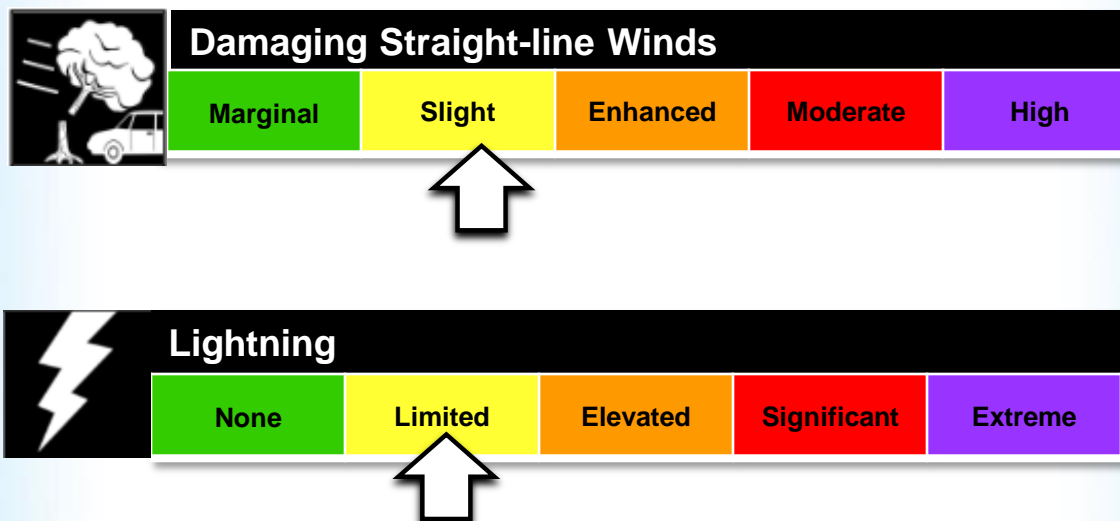


Main Point

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Wind 	<p>Downed trees and powerlines, and isolated structural damage associated with the strongest storms</p>	<p>All of eastern New York with greater confidence for areas west of the Hudson River.</p>	<p>This evening mainly 8 pm to 11 pm</p>



Local Summary of Greatest Impacts

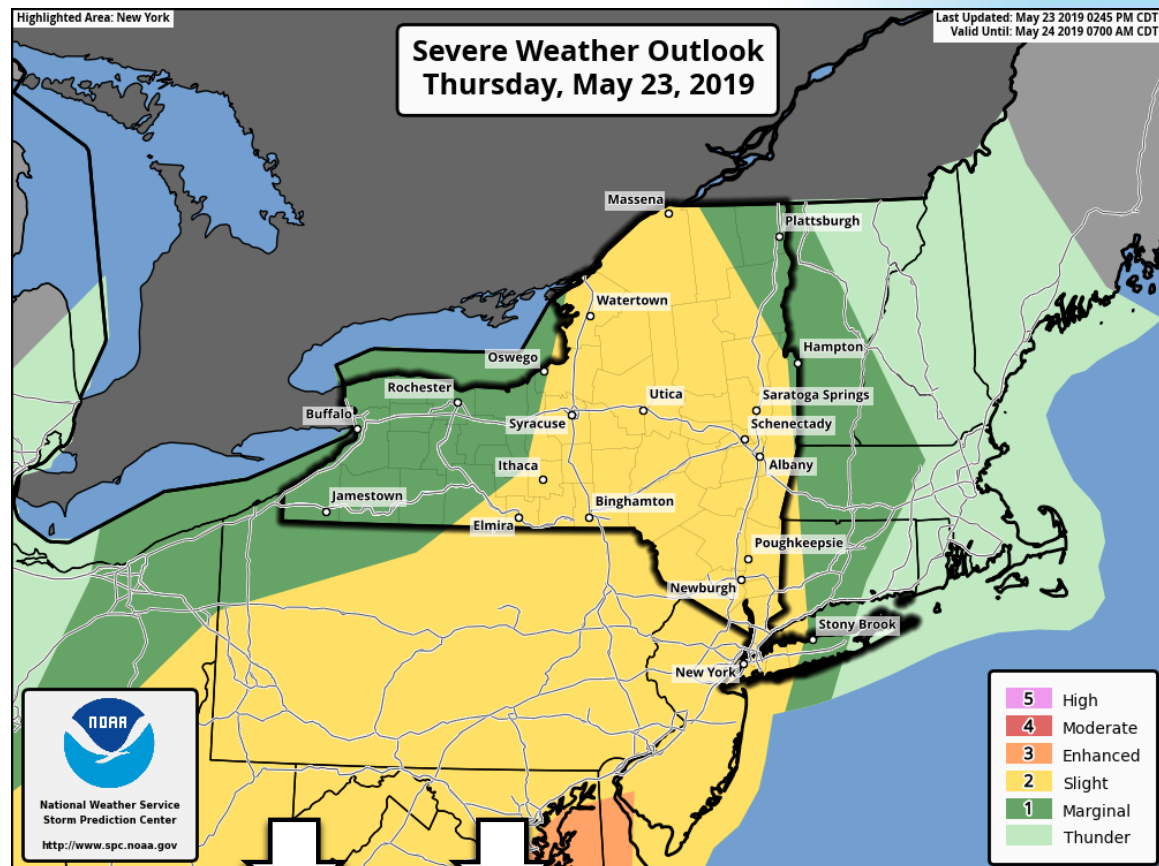


Threats:

- ✓ Damaging winds is the main concern

Timing:

- ✓ This evening (mainly 8 pm to 11 pm)
- ✓ Greatest risk area for severe weather west of the Hudson River

- 60% Probability

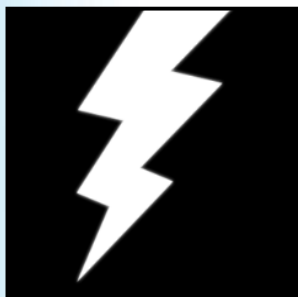

Event Summary

Strong to Severe Storms Possible This Evening (Main time window: 8 PM to 11 PM)

- ✓ Isolated to scattered severe thunderstorms are still possible but has shifted to be later this evening, mainly 8PM to 11PM. Areas in eastern NY, especially west of the Hudson River, have the better potential for severe weather. We have less confidence for severe weather in western New England, but it cannot be ruled out.
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: This early evening (mainly 8 pm to 11 pm).
- ✓ Main impacts from any severe thunderstorms looks to be damaging winds.



Severe Thunderstorm Watch - Severe thunderstorms are possible in and near the watch area. Stay informed and be ready to act if a severe thunderstorm warning is issued.

Severe Thunderstorm Warning - Severe weather has been reported by spotters or indicated by radar. Warnings indicate imminent danger to life and property.



A tornado WATCH means a tornado is possible.

A tornado WARNING means a tornado is already occurring or will occur soon. **GO TO YOUR SAFE PLACE IMMEDIATELY.**

Top Tip

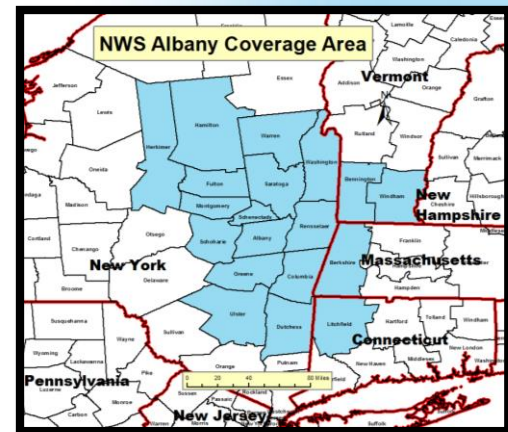
Identify a **safe place** in your home where household members and pets will gather during severe weather: a **basement, storm cellar or an interior room on the lowest floor with no windows.** **When Thunder Roars, Head Indoors! See a Flash, Dash Inside!**
