


What Has Changed?

- Slight risk for severe weather for Sunday has expanded to cover much of the area.
- Slight risk area for heavy rain this evening is reduced to a marginal risk for the Catskills.





Event Summary

ONAL WEATHER SERVICE

Thunderstorms Expected At Times tonight through Sunday Confidence is <u>moderate</u> in terms of timing, location, and severity



Scattered to numerous thunderstorms are expected to move into the Catskills late this afternoon and evening, with more isolated coverage for the Capital District northward and eastward. Rainfall could be locally heavy, especially over the Catskills, between 6 pm and 10 pm.



Another round of thunderstorms is expected Sunday afternoon and evening. There is a slight risk of severe weather across most of the region. The main threats will be damaging winds and large hail.


