





| Hazard    | Impacts  | Location  | Timing                      |

| Wind      | Downed trees and powerlines,<br>and isolated structural damage<br>associated with the strongest<br>storms      | Areas mainly west of the<br>Hudson River              | This afternoon and evening  |
| Lightning | Deadly cloud-to-ground lighting<br>is expected   | All of eastern New York<br>and western New<br>England | This afternoon and evening  |
| Flooding  | Isolated Flash Flooding will be<br>possible, especially where<br>storms repeatedly move across<br>a given area | All of eastern New York<br>and western New<br>England | This afternoon into tonight |


 Main threat: Damaging straightline winds








# **Storm Total Precipitation** (Today through Friday)



# Severe Thunderstorms and Heavy Rain possible this afternoon into tonight

✓ Confidence is moderate in terms of timing, location, and severity

- Scattered thunderstorms develop this afternoon and continue into tonight. Thunderstorms may contain locally heavy rainfall, which may produce isolated flash flooding, especially where multiple thunderstorms occur.
- There is a marginal to slight risk of severe weather for areas mainly west of the Hudson River, mainly for this afternoon and evening. The main threat is damaging wind.
