



- Most oppressive conditions Saturday














Forecast Peak Apparent Temperature




























Event Summary

Hot temperatures combined with high humidity levels are expected to create dangerous heat conditions Friday, Saturday & Sunday with the most oppressive conditions expected Saturday.

Heat Advisories and/or Excessive Heat Warnings will need to be issued













Excessive Heat Criteria

HEAT ADVISORY is issued when dangerous heat conditions are expected.

- Heat Indices of 95 degrees or more for two or more consecutive hours for New York State excluding the Lower Hudson Valley, New York City & Long Island and for Vermont.
- Heat Indices of 95-99 degrees for 2 consecutive days or 100 to 104 degrees for any duration in New York State for the Lower Hudson Valley, New York City & Long Island and for Connecticut & Massachusetts.

EXCESSIVE HEAT WATCH/WARNING is issued when extremely dangerous heat conditions are expected.

Specifically for heat indices of 105+ degrees for two or more hours for New York State, Connecticut, Massachusetts and Vermont.
