


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


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### Serecast Precipitation





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### **Forecast Rainfall**


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








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#### Maximum Wind Gusts Valid: 10/16/2019 02:00 PM - 10/17/2019 07:00 PM EDT

- Southeast winds 15 25 mph with gusts up to 45 mph possible tonight across the Taconics, Berkshires, NW hills of CT, southern Green Mountains tonight.
- ✓ Northwest winds 10 20 mph with gusts up to 45 mph expected across the entire region on Thursday.

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
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### **River Forecasts:**
