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


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24-hour Precipitation

2-5+ inches of rain has fallen through early this morning \checkmark **Continued run off of rainfall will result in flooding through today** \checkmark






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


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Maximum Wind Gusts



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Maximum Wind Gusts

- ✓ Sustained West winds 15 to 30 mph with gusts up to 50 to 60 mph today
- Strongest winds expected
 8 am through 4 pm today





Event Summary

- Confidence is high for flooding due to rainfall run off and high for strong/damaging winds
- ✓ Flooding will continue across the Mohawk River Basin, northern Hudson River Basin
- Wind gusts of 50 to 60 mph resulting in downed branches, trees and power lines resulting power outages and isolated structural damage
- Period of greatest impact:
 - Flood Watch: through 8 pm today
 - Wind Advisory: through 8 pm today
 - High Wind Warning: 5 am to 6 pm today (strongest winds 8 am to 4 pm)
