


Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Snow	Hazardous travel conditions due to reduced visibility and snow covered roads.	Heaviest in the western/southern Adirondacks and western Mohawk Valley. Snowfall of 3 inches or less is possible from the I-90 corridor southward.	Today through Tuesday morning.
Ice	Up to a tenth of an inch. Rapidly falling temperatures on Tuesday may cause a freeze on area roadways with hazardous travel.	Possible over much of eastern New York, southern Vermont, western Massachusetts and northwest Connecticut.	This afternoon through tonight.
Cold Temperatures	Record to near-record cold temperatures will increase risk of hypothermia and frostbite.	All of eastern New York and western New England.	Tuesday through Thursday.

Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast




Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast Valid: 11/11/2019 07:00 AM - 11/12/2019 07:00 PM





Event Summary

- Winter Storm expected....
- Confidence is high that this event will occur with moderate confidence in expected impacts (where Warnings/Advisories are in effect)
- Period of greatest impact: Tonight Tuesday Morning

5 to 11 inches of snow is expected across the western/southern Adirondacks, southern Herkimer County and northern Washington County Monday into Tuesday morning. A few inches of snow may occur south of the Adirondacks. Snowfall from Albany southward will occur early Tuesday accumulating 2 inches or less.



Light ice accumulations of a tenth of an inch or less may occur from the Mohawk Valley and southeast Adirondacks to the mid and upper Hudson Valley, southern Green Mountains and Berkshires. Freezing of any wet surfaces may occur Tuesday as temperatures fall.


