








Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast





Light icing this morning will lead to slippery travel for much of eastern New York and southern Vermont.
















Impacts and Timing:

- ✓ Cold temperatures and gusty winds will combine to result in minimum Wind Chill Values of 20 below zero to single digits.
- ✓ Coldest wind chills will be tonight into Wednesday morning.










Winter Storm Severity Index













Event Summary

Winter Storm continues....

- ✓ Forecasted snow & ice amounts still appear on track, with heaviest snow totals across the Adirondacks. Still, slippery conditions expected across much of eastern NY & western New England due to wintry precipitation & falling temps.
- Precipitation will be tapering off this morning.



Storm total snowfall of 8-12" in the Western/southern Adirondacks, 2-5" in the western Mohawk Valley/Lake George Region/southern Vermont, 1-3"in the Capital District, 1" or less in the Catskills/Hudson Valley/Berkshires/ Litchfield County.



Light ice accumulations of up to 0.1" across much of eastern New York & southern VT. Freezing of any wet surfaces may occur today as temperatures fall.
