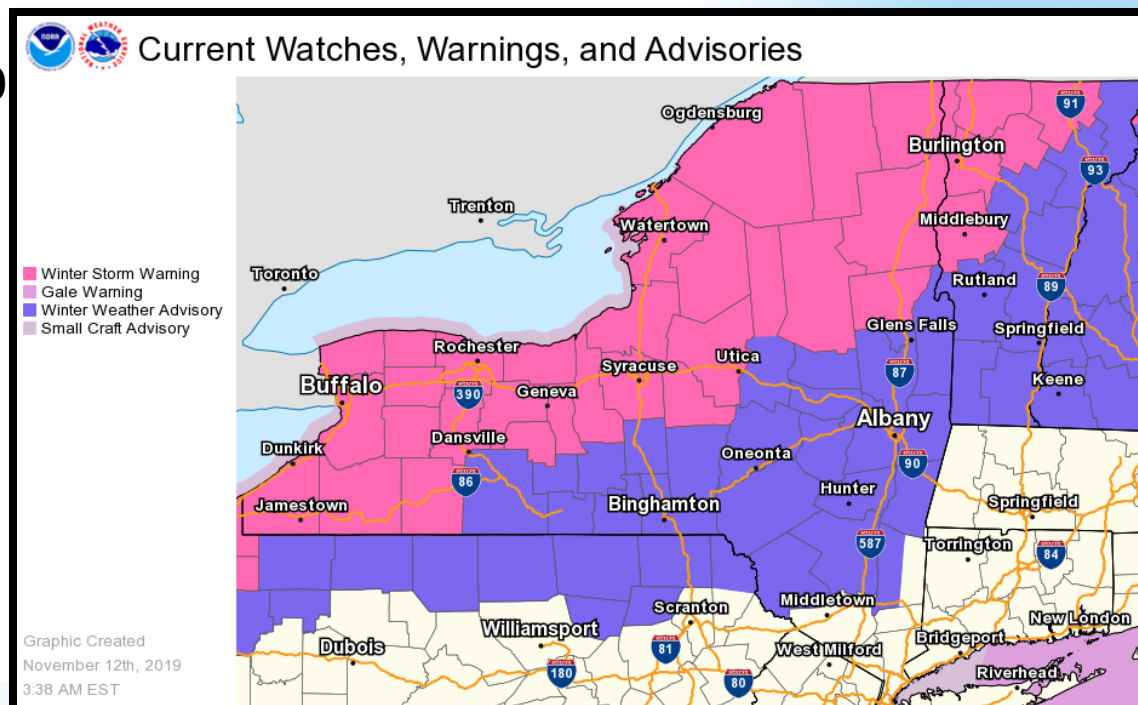


# Winter Storm Continues This Morning

- ✓ Winter Weather Advisories expanded further south & east across the region

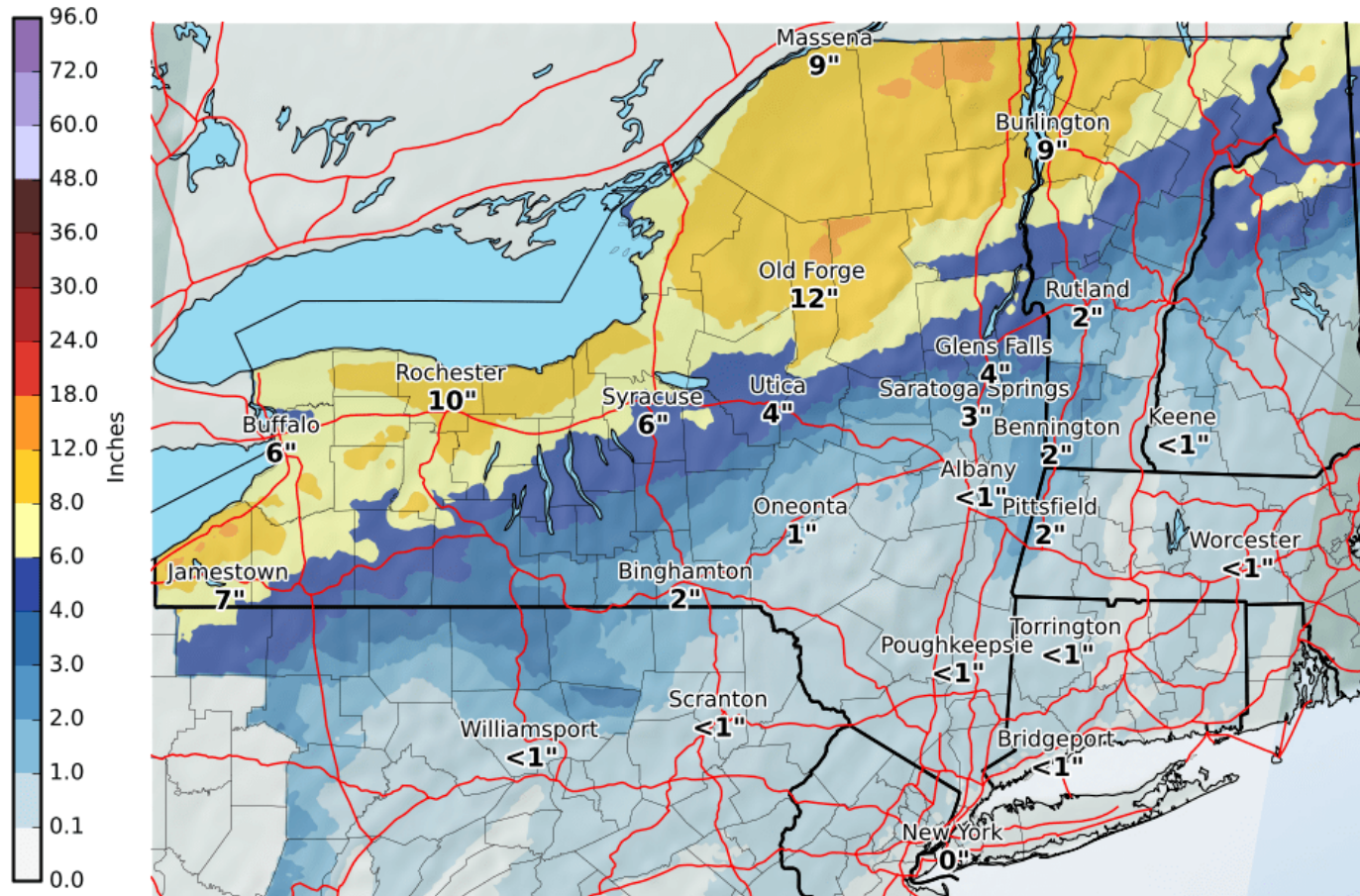

| <b>Snow</b>                 | <p>Hazardous travel conditions due to reduced visibility and snow covered roads.</p>  | <p>Western/southern Adirondacks 8-12", western Mohawk Valley/Lake George Region/southern Vermont 2-5", Capital District 1-3", Catskills/Hudson Valley/Berkshires/Litchfield County 1" or less.</p> | <p>Through This Morning</p>         |
| <b>Ice</b>                 | <p>Slippery roads &amp; walking conditions due to freezing rain. Rapidly falling temperatures today may also cause a freeze on area roadways with hazardous travel.</p> | <p>Up to 0.1" for all areas under a Winter Weather Advisory</p>  | <p>Through Early to Mid Morning</p> |
| <b>Cold Temperatures</b>  | <p>Record to near-record cold temperatures will increase risk of hypothermia and frostbite.</p>   | <p>All of eastern New York and western New England.</p>  | <p>Today through Thursday.</p>      |

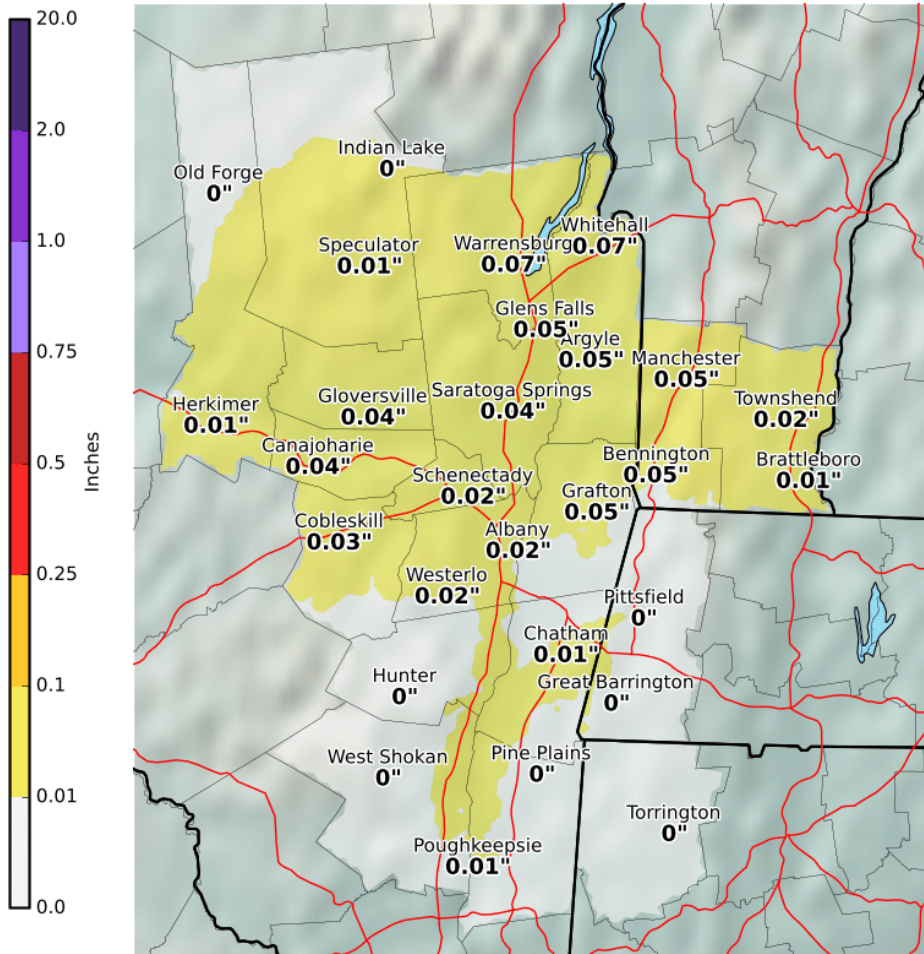

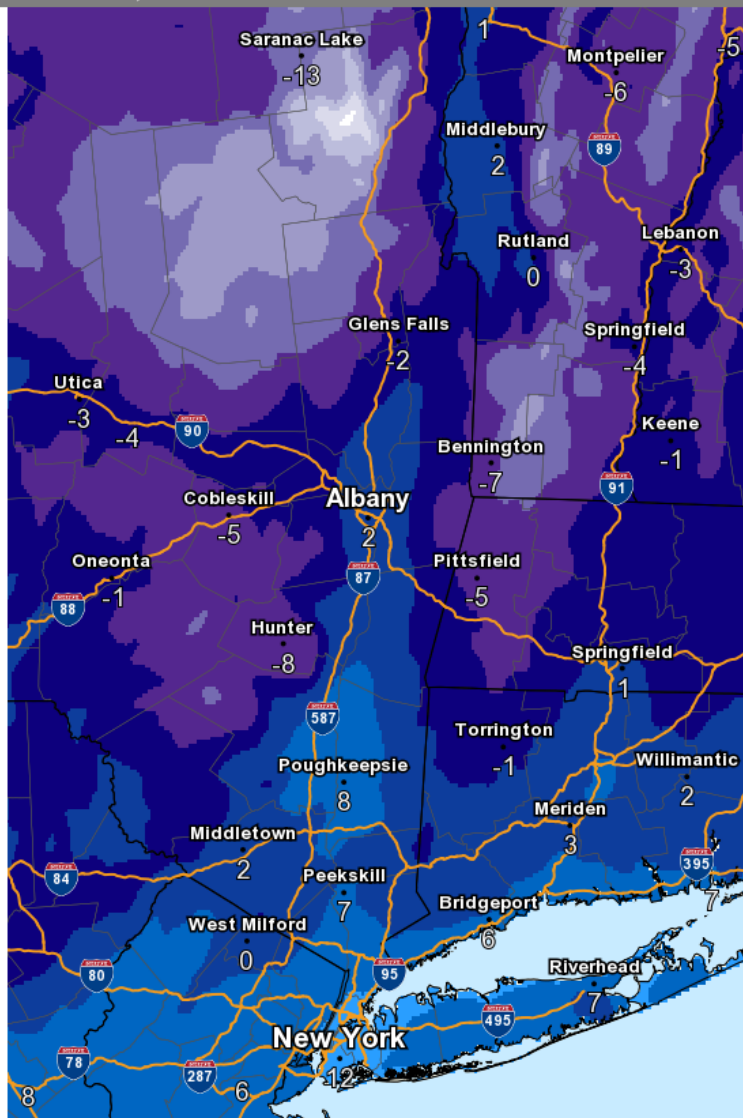
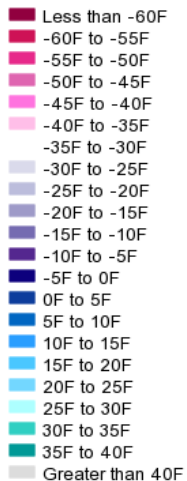

Valid Ending Friday November 15th, 2019 at 7 AM EST



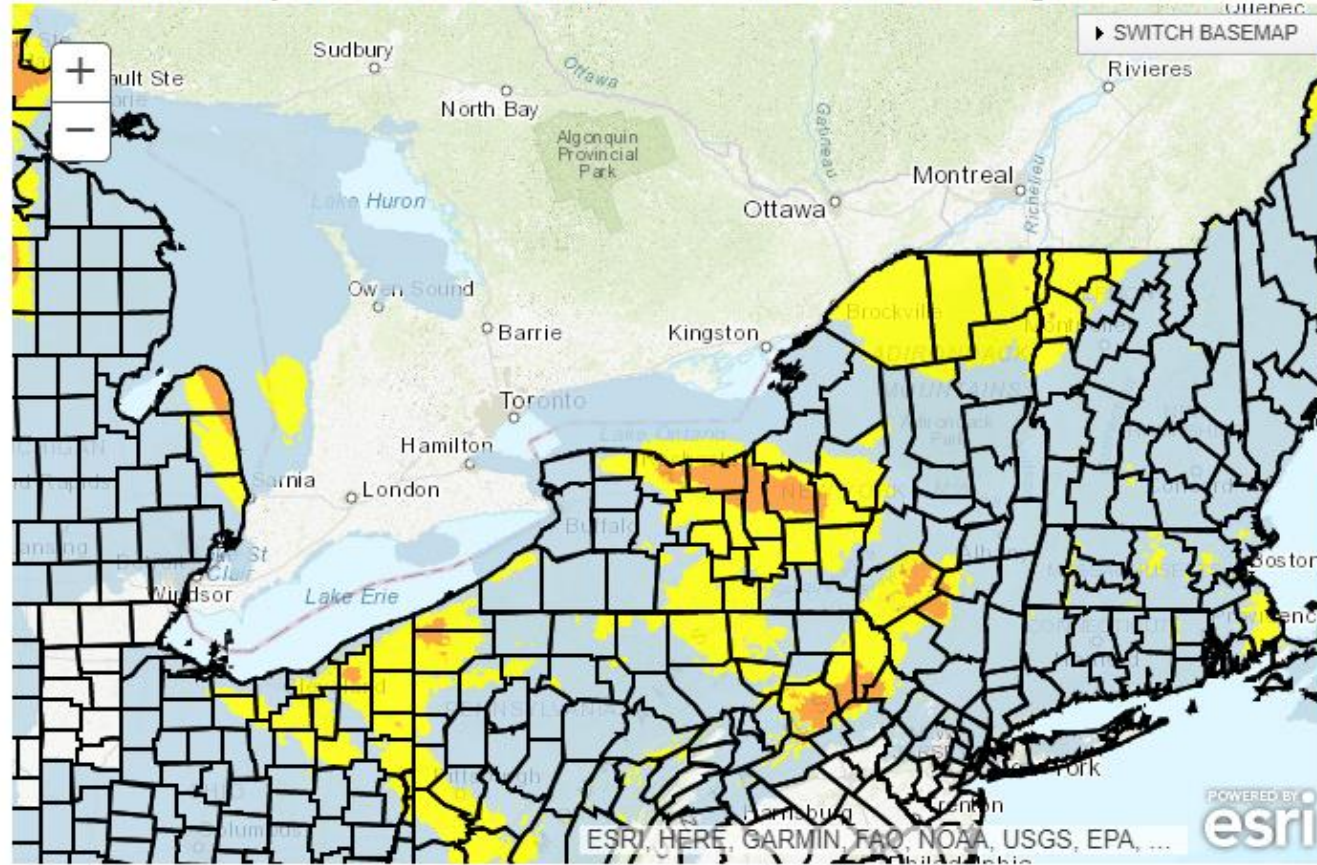
## Impacts and Timing:







- ✓ Cold temperatures and gusty winds will combine to result in minimum Wind Chill Values of 20 below zero to single digits.
- ✓ Coldest wind chills will be tonight into Wednesday morning.

# Winter Storm Severity Index

Winter Storm Severity Index - Effective From Tue, Nov 12, 2019 02 AM ET Through Thu, Nov 14, 2019 07 PM ET



| Potential Winter Storm Impacts  |  |
|---|--|
|  | <b>No Impacts</b><br>Impacts not expected.   |
|  | <b>Limited Impacts</b><br>Rarely a direct threat to life and property. Typically results in little inconveniences.   |
|  | <b>Minor Impacts</b><br>Rarely a direct threat to life and property. Typically results in an inconvenience to daily life.                                    |
|  | <b>Moderate Impacts</b><br>Often threatening to life and property, some damage unavoidable. Typically results in disruptions to daily life.                  |
|  | <b>Major Impacts</b><br>Extensive property damage likely, life saving actions needed. Will likely result in major disruptions to daily life.                 |
|  | <b>Extreme Impacts</b><br>Extensive and widespread severe property damage, life saving actions will be needed. Results in extreme disruptions to daily life. |

# Event Summary

## Winter Storm continues....

- ✓ **Forecasted snow & ice amounts still appear on track, with heaviest snow totals across the Adirondacks. Still, slippery conditions expected across much of eastern NY & western New England due to wintry precipitation & falling temps.**
- ✓ **Precipitation will be tapering off this morning.**



**Storm total snowfall of 8-12" in the Western/southern Adirondacks, 2-5" in the western Mohawk Valley/Lake George Region/southern Vermont, 1-3" in the Capital District, 1" or less in the Catskills/Hudson Valley/Berkshires/ Litchfield County.**

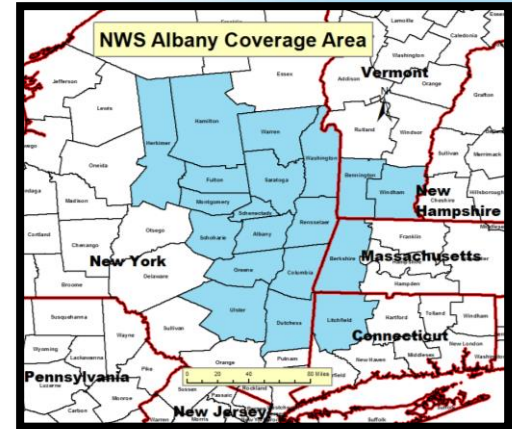


**Light ice accumulations of up to 0.1" across much of eastern New York & southern VT. Freezing of any wet surfaces may occur today as temperatures fall.**
