

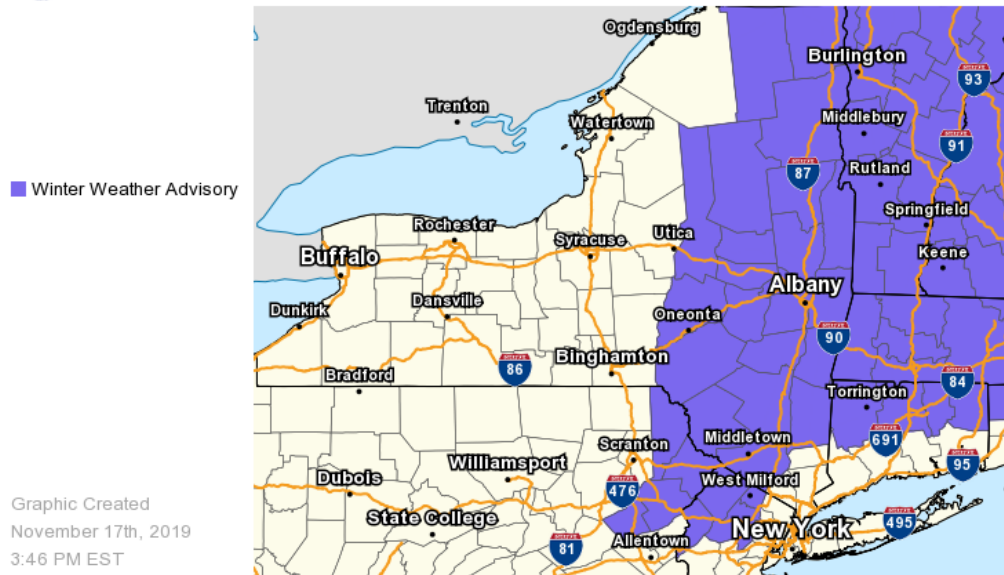
# Light Freezing Rain Possible Late Tonight into Monday Morning. A wintry mix ending as snow Monday night and Tuesday morning

## What Has Changed?

- ✓ Winter Weather Advisories expanded for areas north of the Capital District and now go through Tuesday morning. Advisories remain for Monday morning from the Capital District southward.

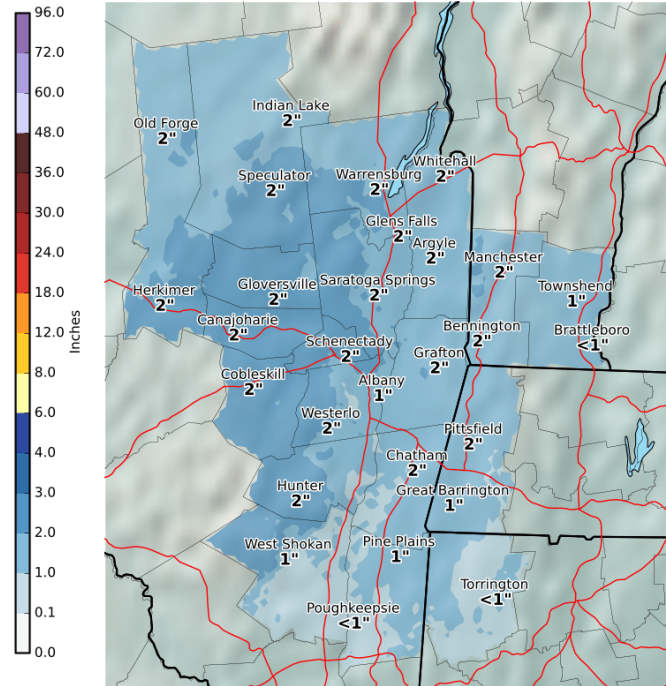

<b>Ice</b> 	<p>Possible slippery road conditions, including during the Monday morning commute</p>	<p>Eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>4 am to noon Monday from the Capital District southward.</p> <p>After 10 am Monday into Monday evening for higher elevations, areas north of the Capital District and southern Vermont</p>
<b>Snow</b> 	<p>Snow covered roads, reduced visibility and hazardous travel for the Tuesday morning commute</p>	<p>Most likely for higher elevations and areas north of Albany including southern Vermont</p>	<p>Monday night and Tuesday</p>

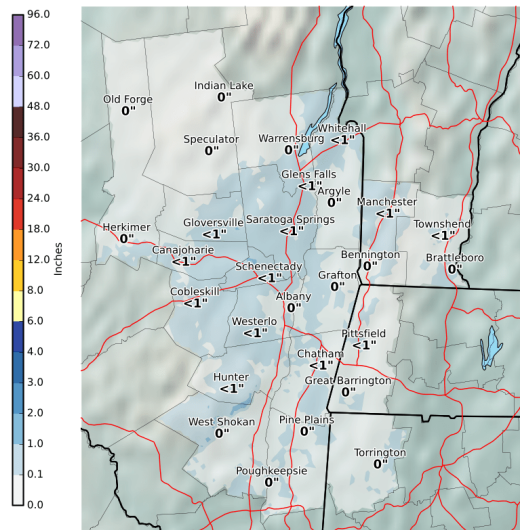

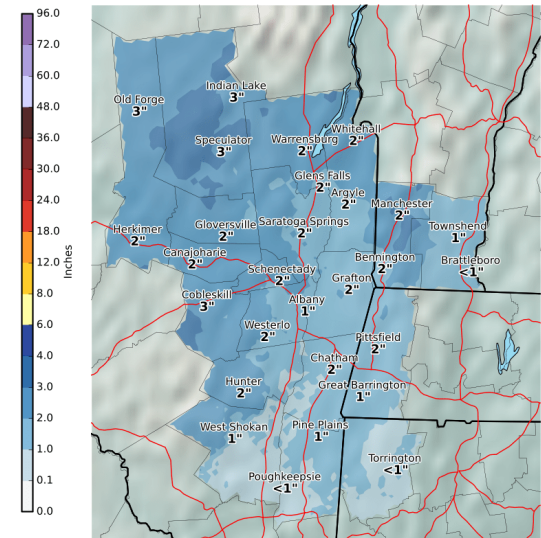
## Low End Amount

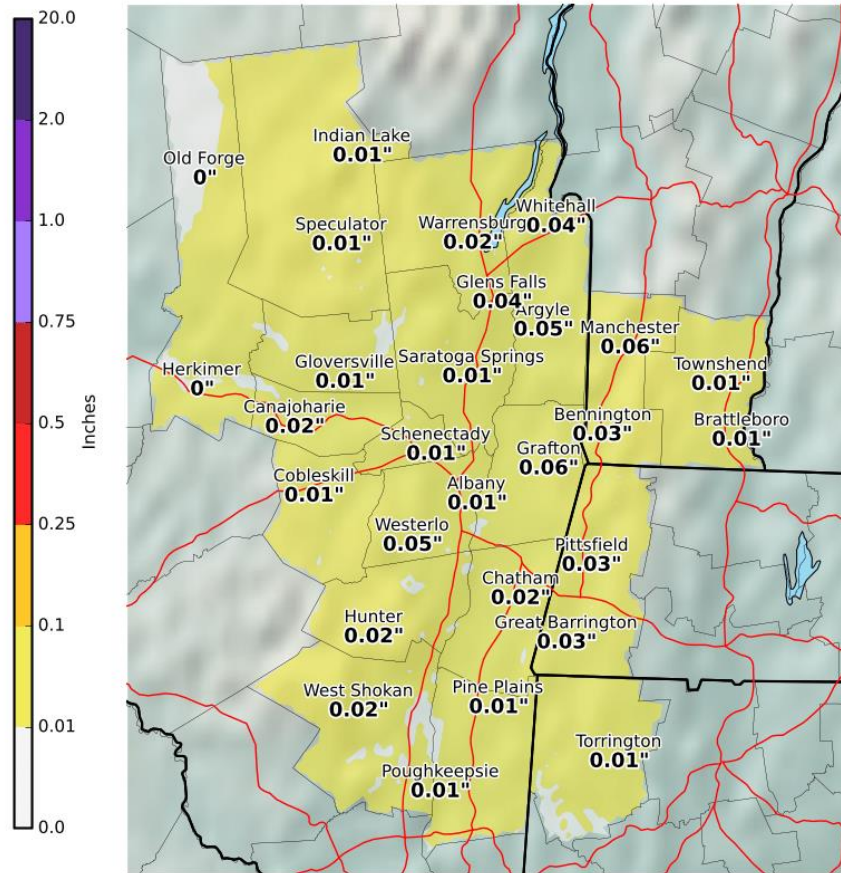

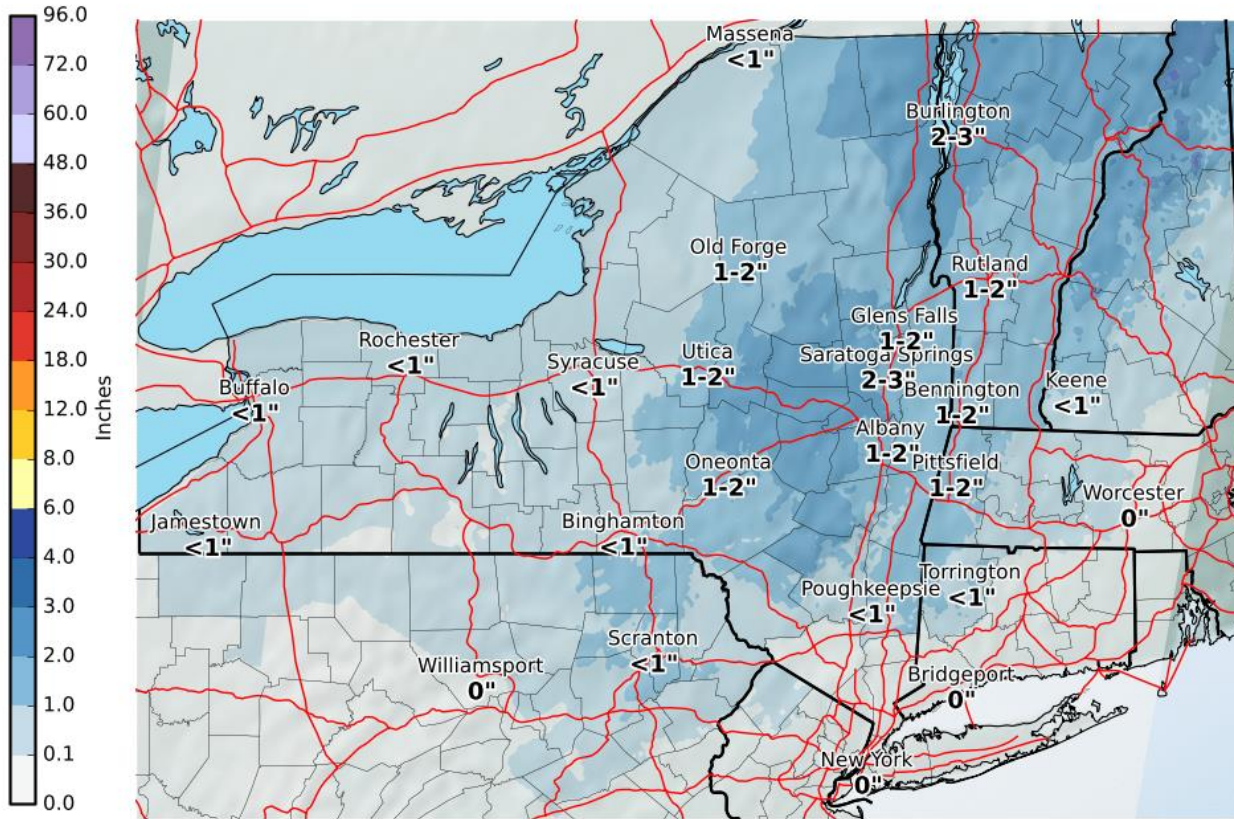

 Snow covered roads and reduced visibilities with hazardous travel Monday night and Tuesday morning. Best chance will be over higher elevations and areas north of the Capital District.



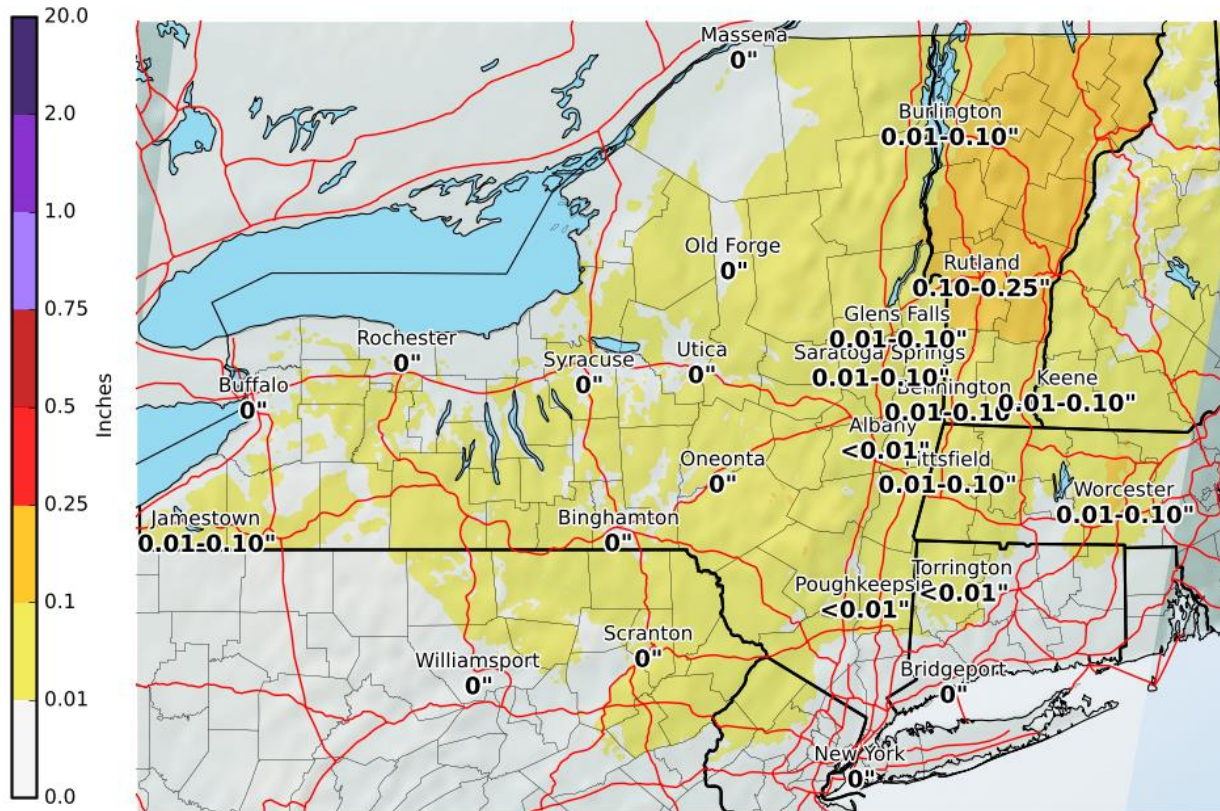

 A light glaze of ice is possible between 1 am and noon Monday, which could result in slippery road conditions impacting the Monday morning commute

# Event Summary

## Light freezing rain possible....

- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: 4 am Monday to 10 am Tuesday



A period of light freezing rain is possible over much of eastern New York and western New England late tonight into Monday morning. A light glaze of ice is possible, which could result in slippery travel including during the Monday morning commute.

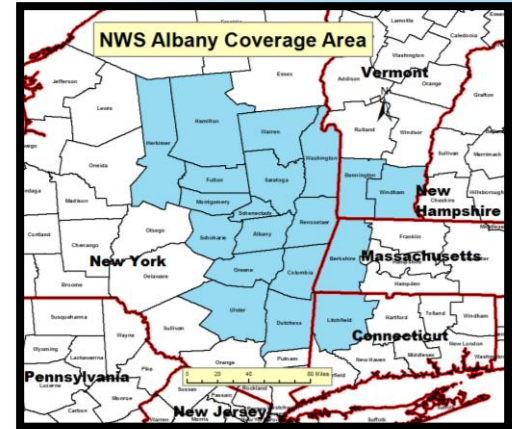


Precipitation will become steadier and heavier Monday night. A wintry mix is expected, ending as snow especially over the higher elevations and areas north of Capital District. Snow covered roads and hazardous travel are likely Tuesday morning.
