Winter Weather Advisories expanded for areas north of the Capital District and now go through Tuesday morning. Advisories remain for Monday morning from the Capital District southward.



Snow	*	Snow covered roads, reduced visibility and hazardous travel for the Tuesday morning commute	Most likely for higher elevations and areas north of Albany including southern Vermont	Monday night and Tuesday













Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast thru Tuesday morning

Expected Snowfall


Event Total Snowfall








Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast










Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast Valid: 11/18/2019 01:00 AM - 11/19/2019 01:00 PM








Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast

Event Summary

Light freezing rain possible....

- Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: 4 am Monday to 10 am Tuesday



A period of light freezing rain is possible over much of eastern New York and western New England late tonight into Monday morning. A light glaze of ice is possible, which could result in slippery travel including during the Monday morning commute.



Precipitation will become steadier and heavier Monday night. A wintry mix is expected, ending as snow especially over the higher elevations and areas north of Capital District. Snow covered roads and hazardous travel are likely Tuesday morning.


