






Light Freezing Rain Possible Late Tonight into Monday Morning

What Has Changed?

Winter Weather Advisory issued for much of the area from late tonight through Monday morning















Main Points

lce		Possible slippery road conditions, including during the Monday morning commute	Eastern New York and western New England	1 am to noon Monday












Expected Ice Accumulation- Official NWS Forecast

Impacts and Timing:

✓ A light glaze of ice is possible between 1 am and noon Monday, which could result in slippery road conditions impacting the Monday morning commute



Event Summary

Light freezing rain possible....

- Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: 1am to noon Monday



A period of light freezing rain is possible over much of eastern New York and western New England late tonight into Monday morning. A light glaze of ice is possible, which could result in slippery travel including during the Monday morning commute.

Temperatures are expected to rise above freezing Monday by noon, ending the freezing rain threat. However, additional wintry mixed precipitation is possible again late Monday into Monday night, especially over the higher terrain. Additional winter headlines may be necessary.


