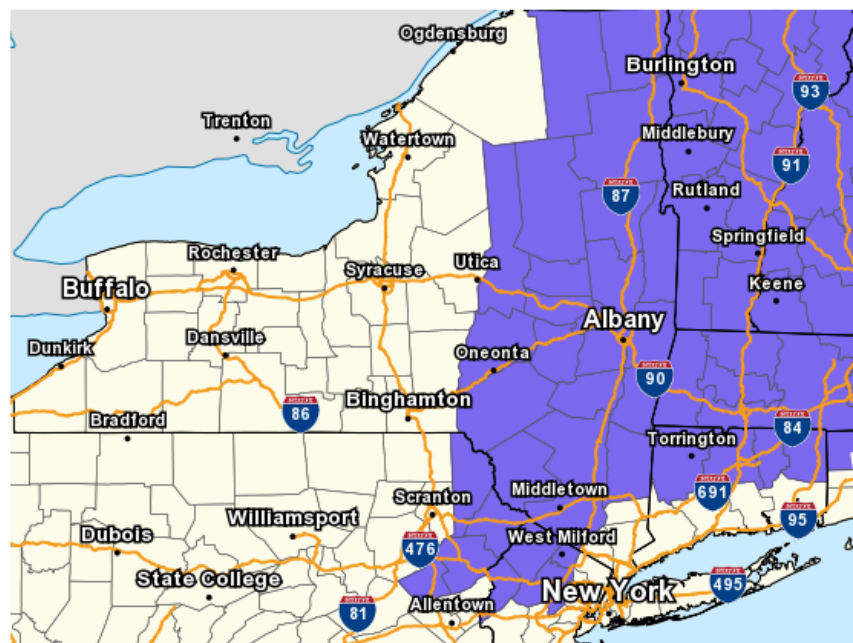
What Has Changed?

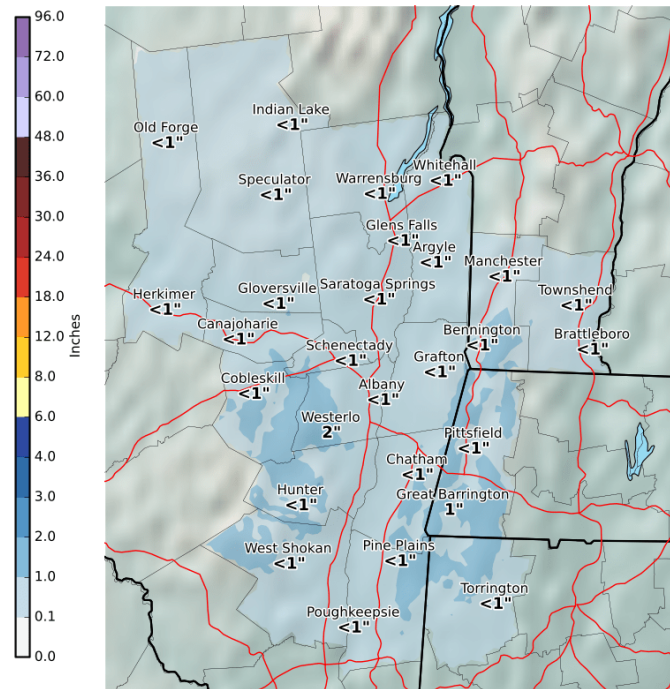
Main Points

Hazard	Impacts	Location	Timing
Ice 	<p>Possible slippery road conditions, including during the morning and evening commutes today and the morning commute Tuesday</p>	<p>Eastern New York and western New England</p>	<p>Through noon today from the Capital District southward</p> <p>Late this morning through Tuesday morning for areas north and east of the Capital District, including much of western New England</p>
Snow 	<p>Snow covered roads, reduced visibility and hazardous travel for the Tuesday morning commute</p>	<p>Most likely for higher elevations</p>	<p>Tonight into Tuesday morning</p>

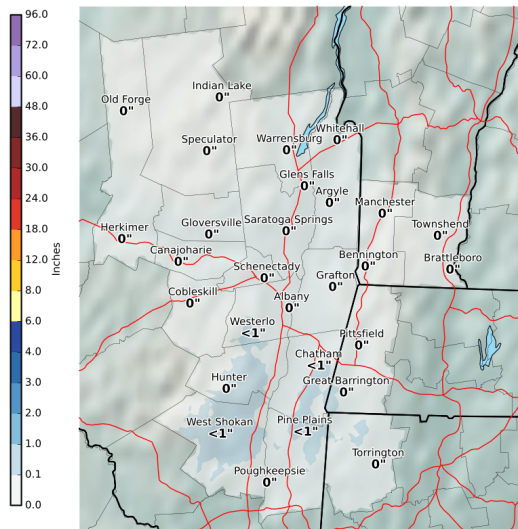

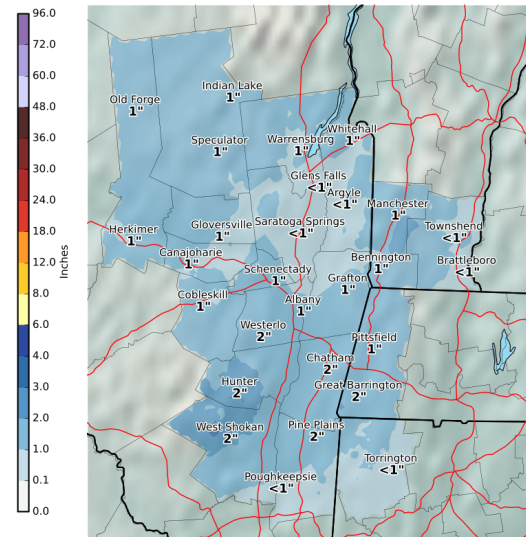

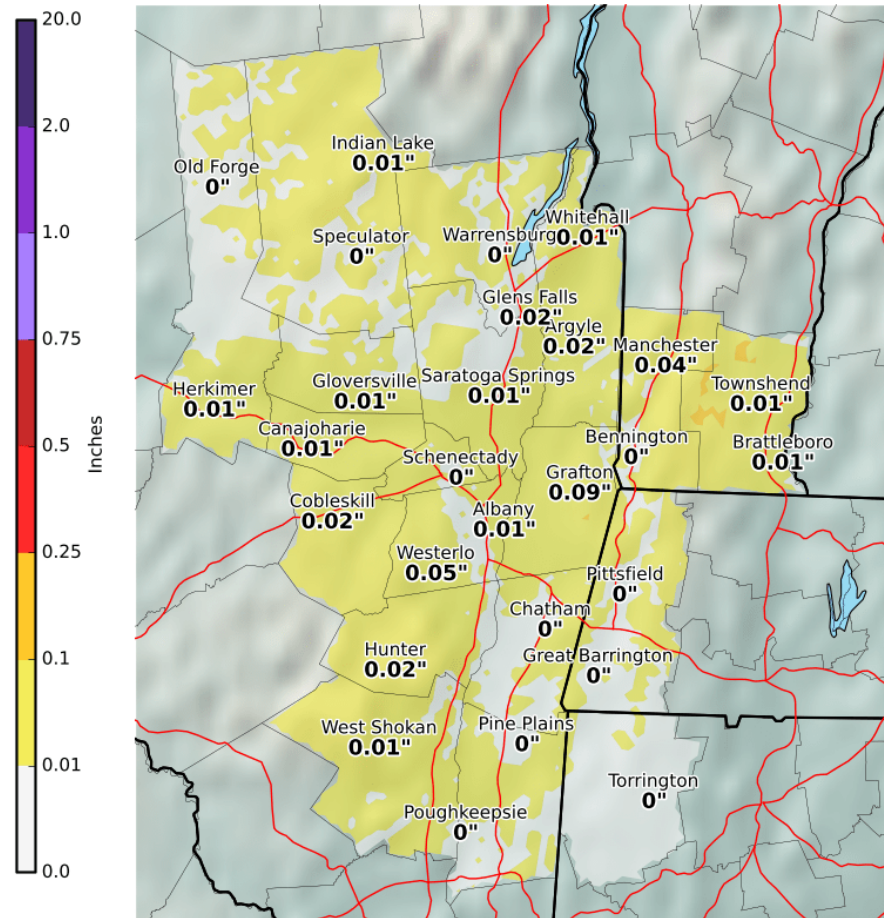

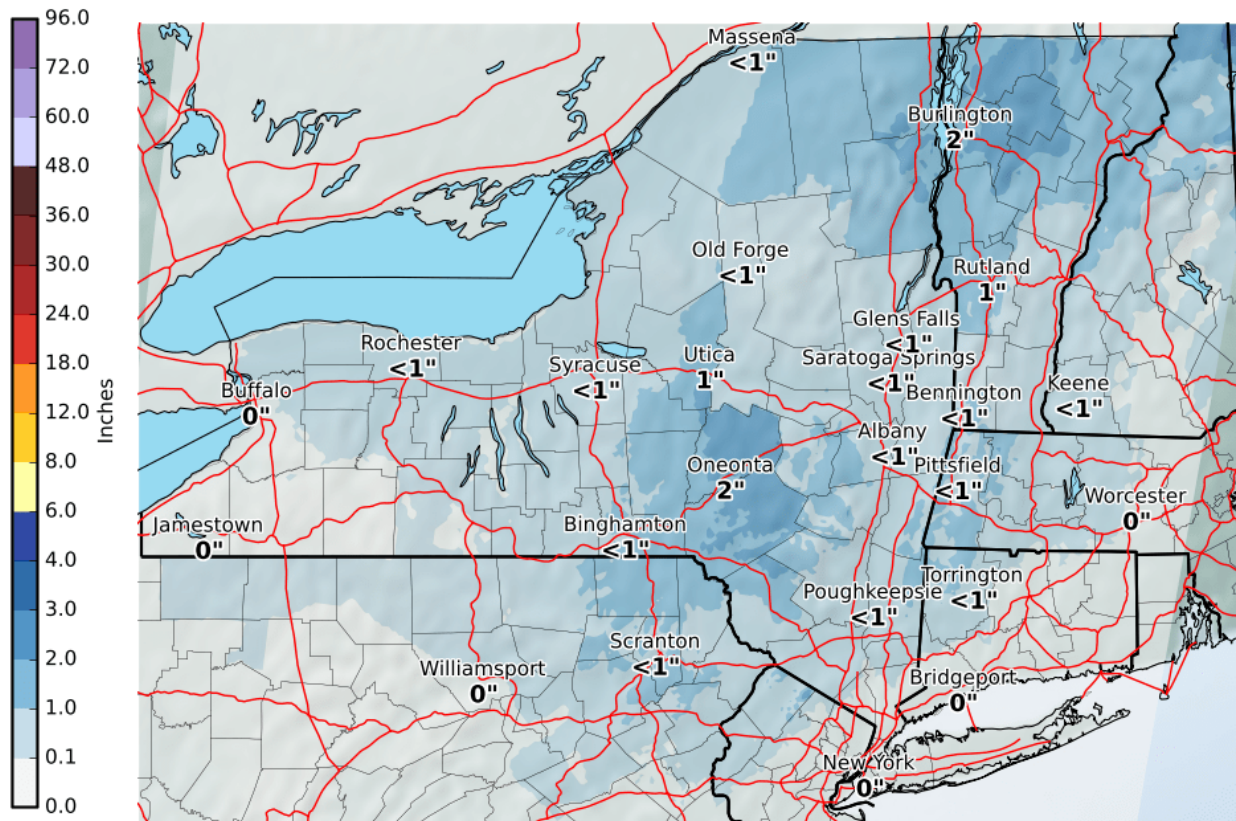
Impacts and Timing:

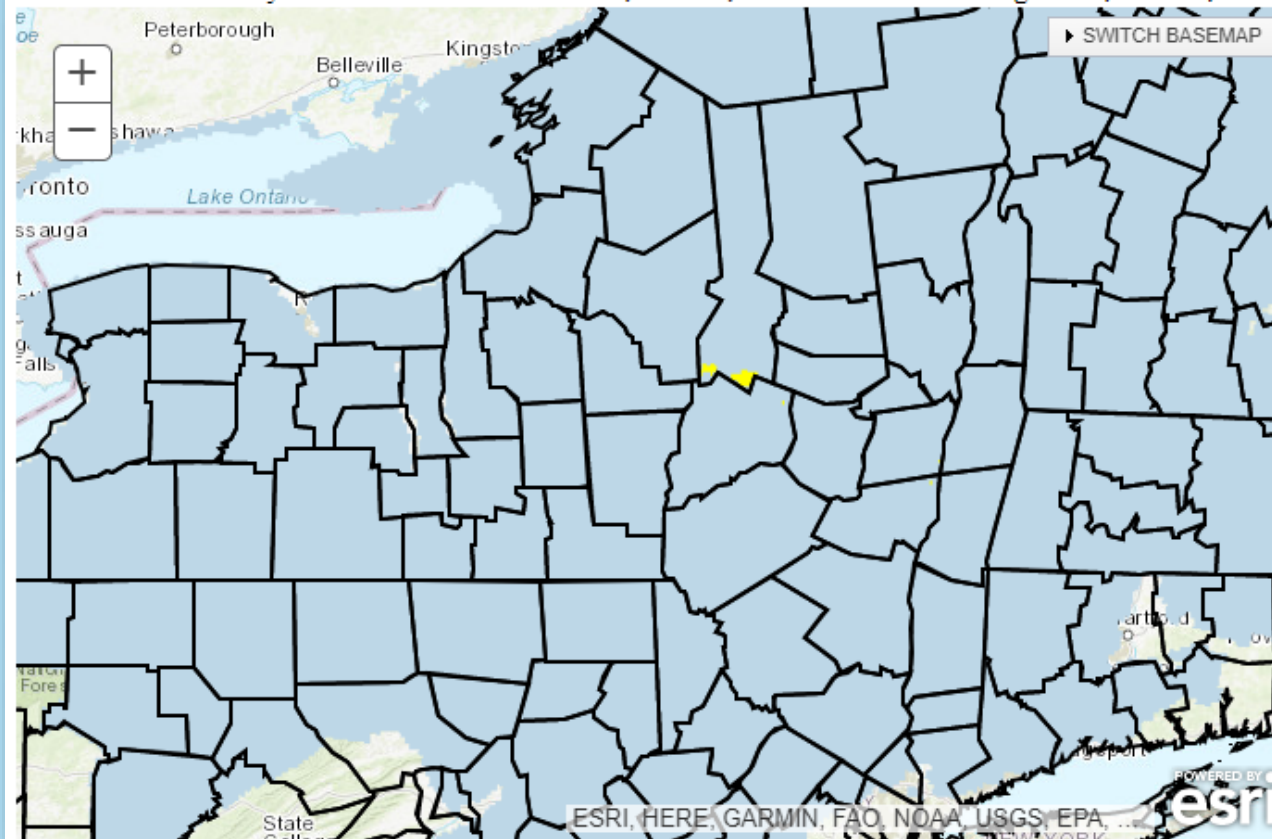

Expected Impacts and timing:

Snow covered roads and reduced visibilities with hazardous travel tonight into Tuesday morning. Best chance will be over higher elevations.

Potential Winter Storm Impacts

No Impacts

Impacts not expected.

Limited Impacts

Rarely a direct threat to life and property. Typically results in little inconveniences.

Minor Impacts

Rarely a direct threat to life and property. Typically results in an inconvenience to daily life.

Moderate Impacts

Often threatening to life and property, some damage unavoidable. Typically results in disruptions to daily life.

Major Impacts

Extensive property damage likely, life saving actions needed. Will likely result in major disruptions to daily life.

Extreme Impacts

Extensive and widespread severe property damage, life saving actions will be needed. Results in extreme disruptions to daily life.

Event Summary

A period of freezing drizzle is possible in eastern New York and western New England today. A light glaze of ice is possible, which could result in slippery travel including during the morning commute.

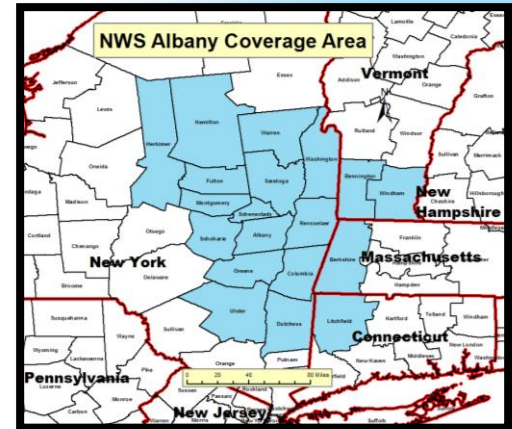


Precipitation will become steadier and heavier tonight. A wintry mix is expected, ending as snow especially over the higher elevations and areas. Some icing will be possible, as well as snow covered roads leading to hazardous travel this evening into Tuesday morning.
