








### **Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast thru Tuesday morning**










#### **Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast**

Snow covered roads and reduced visibilities with hazardous travel tonight into Tuesday morning. Best chance will be over higher elevations.



# **Event Summary**

Freezing drizzle possible today. Wintry mix ending as snow tonight into Tuesday morning....

- Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: Tonight into Tuesday morning



Freezing drizzle is possible in eastern New York and western New England today excluding the Hudson Valley from the Poughkeepsie area up into the Capital District. A light glaze of ice is possible, which could result in slippery travel on untreated roadways.



Precipitation will become steadier and heavier tonight. A wintry mix is expected, ending as snow especially over the higher elevations and areas. Some icing will be possible, as well as snow covered roads leading to hazardous travel this evening into Tuesday morning.
