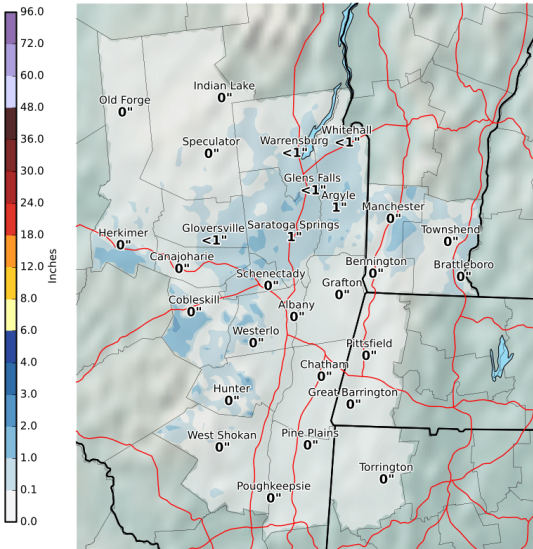

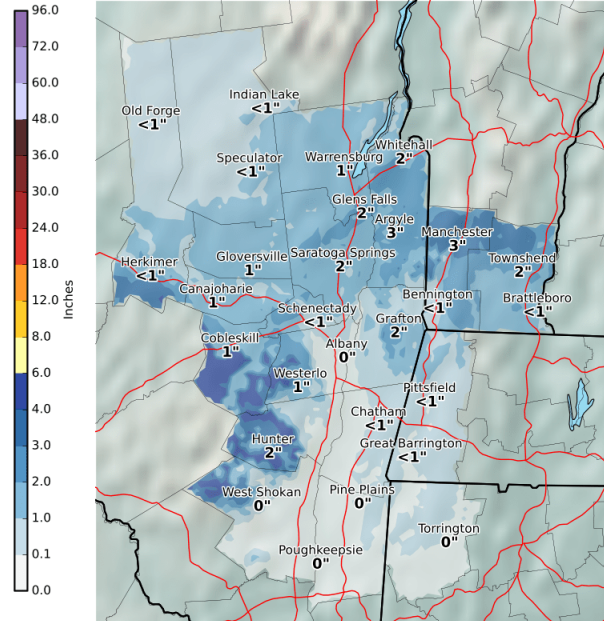

Expected Snowfall - Official NWS Forecast

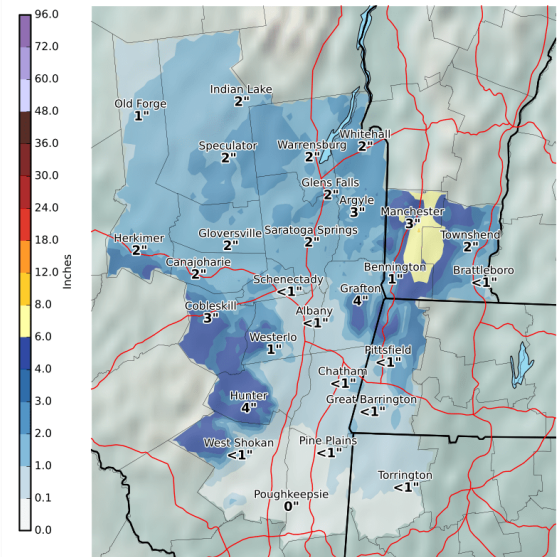

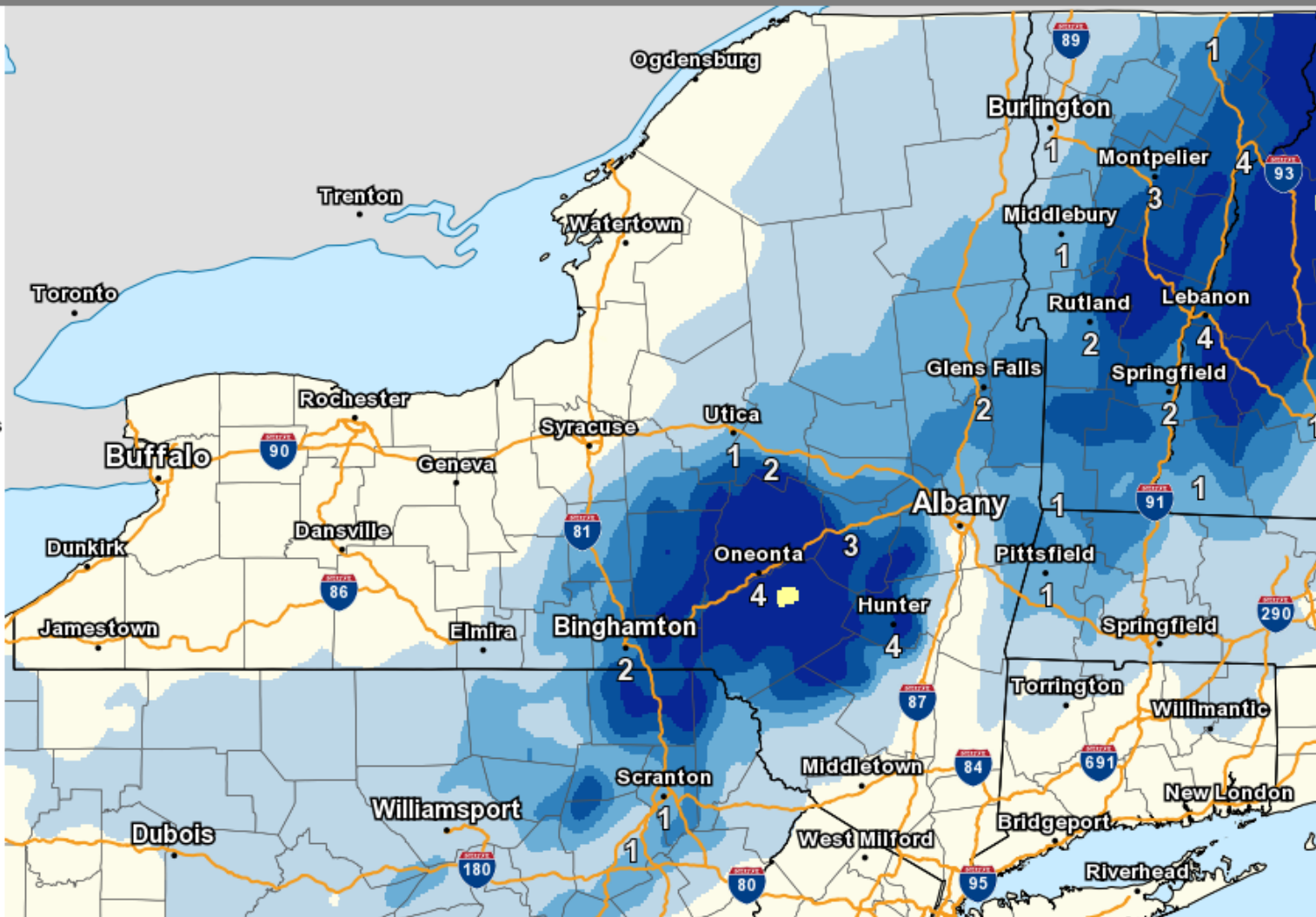

Valid Ending Tuesday November 26th, 2019 at 7 PM EST

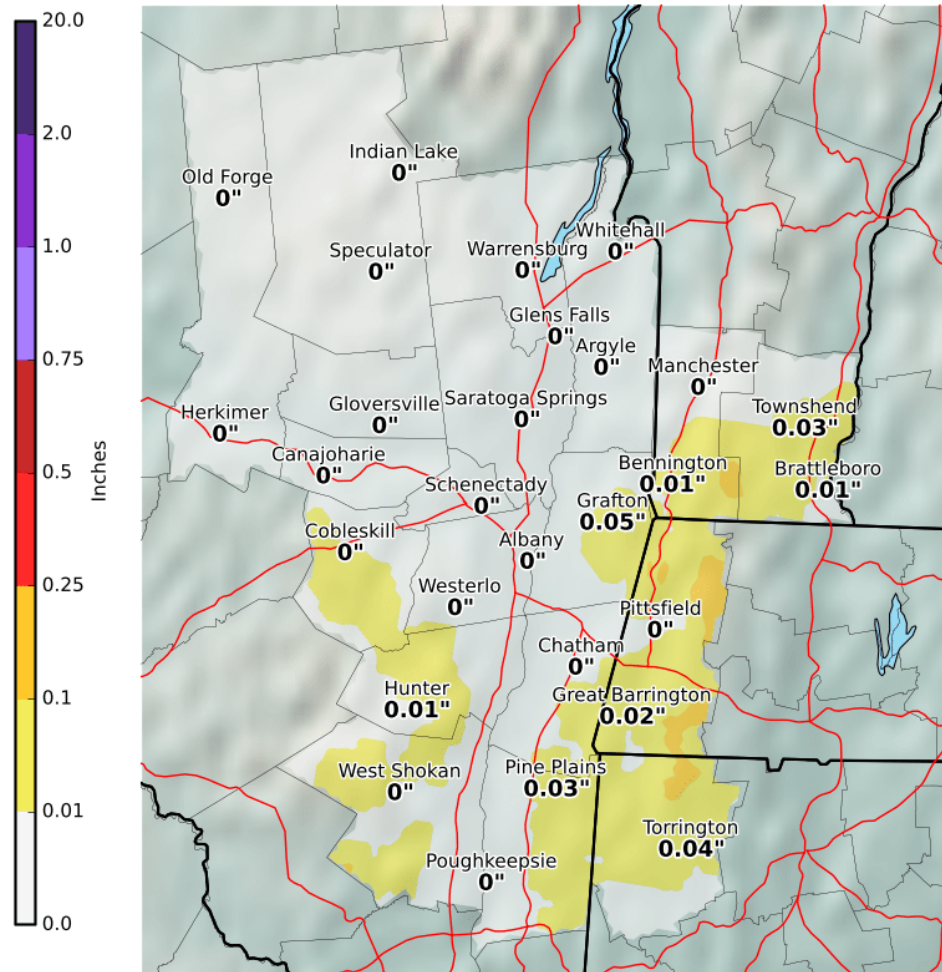

Event Summary

Snow or a wintry mix transitioning back to snow...

- ✓ Confidence is **MODERATE** that this event will occur and **MODERATE** on expected impacts
- ✓ Period of greatest impact: Through this afternoon



Snow and sleet changing to a mix of freezing rain and plain rain late this morning, then changing back to snow in the afternoon. 1 to 4 with isolated 6 inches of snow and sleet accumulation across the eastern Catskills, Schoharie Valley, central and northern Taconics of eastern New York, and western New England excluding southern Litchfield County.



A light glaze to a tenth of an inch of ice is possible in the same locations which will make untreated surfaces slippery and difficult to travel or walk on.
