





What Has Changed?

Winter Weather Advisory issued for eastern Rensselaer, Bennington, and northern Berkshire Counties






Most likely time of winter precipitation onset









Probabilistic Snowfall Forecast

Expected Snowfall




High End Amount

Event Summary

Light to moderate snow Friday....

- Confidence is HIGH that this event will occur and MODERATE on expected impacts
- Period of greatest impact: Friday morning to Friday evening
- ✓ Winter Weather Advisory in effect for eastern Rensselaer, Bennington, and northern Berkshire Counties from 10 am to 10 pm Friday

Light snow will spread west to east across most of eastern New York and western New England from 8–11 am, possibly impacting the morning commute in the Mohawk Valley.



The snow will end from west to east from 4–7 pm, but may impact the evening commute in some areas. The snow may linger later into the evening in the advisory area.

Snowfall rates of around ½ inch up to an inch per hour are possible, especially for areas along and north of I-90.
